The certificate ceremony took place on January 24th 2019, Thursday (14:30) at the Activity Centre. In accordance with analysis result based topics, the EMU Personnel Office Directorate - In-Service Training Unit organises annual training and update programs for the personnel. In the 2017 - 2018Academic Year, 13 in-service training sessions were held, namely Conflict Management, Emotional Intelligence, Art of Knowing People, Website Management of SharePoint, Advanced Excel Applications, Training the Trainer, Secrets of Giving Feedback, Image Management in Work-life, Communication, Decision Making Techniques, Problem Solving Skills, Work Safety

and Health Training (Cleaning Services); and Cleanliness and Hygiene Training (Cleaning Services). 474 administrative and 157 Cleaning Services Unit personnel; 631 in total, participated in these training sessions.



## INTERNATIONAL EMU STUDENT WRITES THESIS IN TURKISH

Despite Turkish not being her mother tongue, Parastoo Younesian from Iran, a graduate student at Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) Faculty of Health Sciences, Physiotherapy and Rehabilitation Department (in Turkish - with Thesis), showed great courage and devotion; and successfully wrote her thesis in Turkish. With EMU Physiotherapy and Rehabilitation Department Chair Asst. Prof. Dr. Ender Angın as her supervisor, Younesian successfully completed her thesis titled "The Effects of Aqua Bicycle Training for Knee Arthroplasty Implemented Patients on Pain, Joint Range of Motion, Muscle Strength, Physical Performance, Balance and Life Quality: A Comparative Study".

#### **EMU Rector Extends Congratulations**

EMU Rector Prof. Dr. Necdet Osam received Parastoo Younesian, who significantly contributed to literature with her observational study on early Aqua bicycle training after Total Knee Arthroplasty. During the meeting on January 23rd 2019, Wednesday at 15:30, Younesian presented her thesis to Prof. Dr. Osam, who congratulated Younesian for her success and courage; and stated that he was deeply pleased with her thesis. Younesian's work is the first thesis written in Turkish by an international student at EMU Faculty of Health Sciences, Department of Physiotherapy and Rehabilitation.

#### 76 Subjects Participated in the Post-Arthroplasty Study

76 individuals, with knee arthroplasty implementations, participated in the study of this thesis that evaluates the effects of Aqua Bicycle training in their treatment. 38 subjects were in the Aqua Bicycle training group and 38 individuals were in the 'classic home exercise' group. The study proved that a 4 week-long Aqua Bicycle training was more efficient compared to the classical home exercises and that despite the existence of significant improvements in the control group, the Aqua Bicycle training had more efficiency.





### **EMU STUDENTS RECEIVE AN AWARD FOR THEIR PROJECT**

A project prepared by Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) School of Business and Finance, International Trade and Business English-medium undergraduate program students Burak Bilgen and Ali İşlek, School of Computing and Technology, Computer Technology and Information Systems undergraduate program student Hasan Kumbur and Cyprus Social Sciences University, Faculty of Law student Halilcan Okutan received an award.

In the "TRNC Inter-University Entrepreneurship and Innovative Idea Competition" organised for the first time in the TRNC through the contributions of the Cyprus Social Sciences University Project and Development Center (KİSBÜ-PARGEM), Turkey's Nicosia Embassy Development and Economic Cooperation Office and the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus (TRNC) Ministry of Education, EMU students have been awarded the second prize with "Intelligent Automation Project: Diğren". The students received their awards on January 23, 2019 at a ceremony held at the Social Sciences University of Cyprus.

#### **Solutions for Problems were Provided**

Burak Bilgen received the award on behalf of the team. During the event which brought together young entrepreneurs from universities in Cyprus with the most acclaimed projects, students also had the opportunity to interact with many business professionals. In line with the competition criteria requesting the participants to present a solution to a problem or an unfulfilled need through the use of local resources in the TRNC, the projects were presented to the members of the jury by the competition teams.
