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EMU RECTOR PROF. DR. NECDET OSAM FEATURES AS A GUEST ON MASDER'S FAMAGUSTA TALKS

Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) Rector Prof. Dr. Necdet Osam featured as a guest on the Famagusta Walled City Association's (MASDER) "Famagusta Talks" event which took place at 10:30 on the 23rd of November 2019. A different "Famagusta Talks" event is held every Saturday. Speaking at the event which took place at MASDER's head office, MASDER President Rıfat Yalınç expressed that they are very happy to be hosting EMU Rector Prof. Dr. Necdet Osam whilst indicating that they are in collaboration with EMU on a number of different projects.



EMU Rector Prof. Dr. Necdet Osam started the talk by providing the guests with information about EMU. Touching upon the stream of students, accommodation, academic achievements, mission and vision, financial affairs, international success and projects Prof. Dr. Osam highlighted the importance of the flow of students to the country. Indicating that the uncertain number is currently around 85 thousand students Prof. Dr. Osam stated that the students of every university are included in this number

"EMU Is Being Preferred More"

Prof. Dr. Osam went on to underline that especially in recent years EMU is being preferred by Turkish Cypriot students. Proving a reminder that EMU is an internationally successful university, Prof. Dr. Osam stated that in 2019 there was a decrease in the number students that were placed via the Assessment Selection and Placement Center (ÖSYM) for the other big four universities in the TRNC whilst there was a 12.8% increase from last year for EMU. Moving on to accommodation, Prof. Dr. Osam indicated that there are five EMU dormitories with







a total capacity of 1,331. Noting that there are some issues with some of the privately-owned campus dormitories Prof. Dr. Osam stated that the judicial process has started in order to terminate their contracts.

Prof. Dr. Osam also addressed the university's academic and scientific publications whilst

highlighting their importance. Clarifying the university's functional agreements and memberships Prof. Dr. Osam indicated that they have ongoing academic projects. Prof. Dr. Osam provided extensive information about these projects such as the joint project being ran with the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus (TRNC) Ministry of Health.

EMU-FLEPS CONTINUES IN-SERVICE TRAINING



The Eastern Mediterranean University Foreign Languages and English Preparatory School (EMU-FLEPS) continues its inservice training with the EDMODO course. EDMODO is a classroom management

tool, designed for education with strong security settings and as a social network. This educational platform is specially designed for teachers-students-parents, where teachers can invite students to their groups, write messages to them, share lesson documents, and create homework assignments and quizzes. The EDMODO course aims to contribute to English teachers' professional development as they will learn ways to integrate online training tools into their face-to-face instruction. The course will take 4 weeks and participants will receive an EDMODO certificate at the end of the course.

EMU senior instructor and EDMODO trainer Turan Değirmencioğlu and EMU-FLEPS instructor and professional development unit coordinator Asst. Professor Dr. Ayşegül Sallı are conducting the course. The trainers stated that they are pleased to be offering the course and that they are planning to offer the EDMODO course to English teachers working in other schools in the future.

EMU-FLEPS STARTS THE "AUTHENTIC LEARNING IN THE 21ST CENTURY" CERTIFICATE PROGRAM

The Eastern Mediterranean University Foreign Languages and English Preparatory School (EMU-FLEPS) has started the certificate program titled "Authentic Learning in the 21st Century". The 9-weeklong course, organized by the EMU-FLEPS Teacher Training and Professional Development Unit in collaboration with the 21st Century Skills Special Interest Group aims to engage language teachers at EMU-FLEPS in a practical and handson learning environment where technology and pedagogy are amalgamated.

First of its kind

Emphasizing the need for both teachers and learners to be ready for rapid changes brought about by developments in the 21st Century, course instructor Asst. Prof. Dr.



Ildeniz Özverir stated: "In order to meet these demands, our course highlights the importance of 21st Century skills, such as collaboration, problem solving, critical thinking and digital literacy, whilst aiming to build know-how and confidence. In short, we hope to encourage course participants to reflect on the principles of authentic learning and to promote the active use of these skills in their own classroom contexts." The course is first certificate program organized within EMU-FLEPS using only its own resources since the early 2000's.



KISMET'S ACHIEVEMENTS INCREASE



The short-film "Kısmet" which was sponsored by the Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) and directed by Doğuş Özokutan and Vasvi Çiftcioğlu has been accepted for the anthology of the "Certamen Internacional De Cortos Ciudad De Soria" (Soria International Short Film Fest – SOIFF) which is one of Spain's most important short film festivals. Therefore, Kısmet is one of 55 short films that will be featured at the 21st anniversary of the international festival which will be taking place in Soria, Spain between the 17th of November and 1st of December 2019. The said festival is of extra importance as it is accredited by "GOYA" which is Spain's

most prestigious cinema award. Kısmet will be the only film produced in North Cyprus to compete in a festival that acts as a preliminary round for "GOYA" which is known as Spain's Academy Awards. In the beginning of November Kısmet was also screened at the Spanish festival "Mostra de Curtas Vila de Noia" (Short Film Showcase Vila de Noia) which is also accredited by GOYA.

The Directors Were Invited to Spain

Since its world premiere on the 18th of October 2018, Kısmet has been accepted on the anthology of 36 international festivals and it has been screened in 41 different countries.

Kısmet's directors Doğuş Özokutan and Vasvi Çiftcioğlu have been invited to Spain for the Soria International Short Film Fest where they will be participating in a range of activities. Exactly one year ago, Kısmet achieved another first in Turkish Cypriot cinema, by being nominated for the Audience Award at the 'Leeds International Film Festival', which is a qualifying film festival for the OSCARS and BAFTA Awards. Kısmet also won the Audience award at the 9th Brazil Cinefest International Film Festival in December 2018.

The Visual Effects Were Made at EMU

The short film portrays a dad whose will that asks for him to be cremated leaves his wife and son with an impossible mission. The visual effects of the film were handled by EMU Department of Visual Arts and Visual Communication Design (VACD) Vice Chair Firat Tüzünkan. The film's scriptwriter and co-director Doğuş Özokutan is a master's student at VACD whilst the film's other co-director Vasvi Çiftcioğlu is a PhD student at the Communication Faculty.
