Indicating that the “Communication Professionals of the Future” competition is comprised of four categories (radio broadcasting, television broadcasting, news broadcasting and internet broadcasting) Özdemir highlighted that students can apply for the categories which they are interested in.

EMU Communication Faculty Vice Dean / New Media and Journalism Department Chair Assoc. Prof. Dr. Metin Ersoy stated that they are proud to be hosting a long-established institution like TRT at the university, whilst expressing that the workshops will provide important opportunities for Communication Faculty students. Prof. Dr. Ersoy also added that they have been informed about TRT competitions

EMU TO OFFER ENGLISH LANGUAGE TEACHING MASTER'S PROGRAM IN NICOSIA



Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) Faculty of Education, Department of Foreign Language Education, English Language Teaching Master's program will be offered in Nicosia. According to a statement released by EMU Education Faculty, Foreign Language Education Department, the opening of the MA program in English Language Teaching in Nicosia, which is currently being offered in EMU, is intended to provide convenience to prospective students living in and around Nicosia, especially to those may have difficulty in traveling to Famagusta due to work commitments or transportation problems. The courses will be held between 18:00 and 21:00 in the aforesaid program. The venue of the master's program in Nicosia will be announced soon.

Same Application Requirements

The same conditions must be fulfilled for applications to the MA Program in English Language Teaching to be offered in Nicosia. Those wishing to apply must have a bachelor's degree and meet the admission requirements of the Department of Foreign Language Education in EMU. Accordingly, the documents required to be submitted by the applicants, are the official transcript of the courses taken at the undergraduate level, a four-year undergraduate program

diploma taken from a university or any other equivalent institution, English proficiency score documents, three letters of recommendation for non-EMU graduates, photocopies of passport or ID card and a passport size photograph (6 cm x 5 cm). All documents must be in English. The language requirements are as follows: minimum 80 from TOEFL (IBT), minimum 6.5 from IELTS, minimum 58 from PTE Academic, minimum 90 from EMU FLEPS English Language Stage II Exam and minimum 66 from YDS/ YÖKDİL.

EMU WALKS TO RAISE AWARENESS ABOUT CHILD ABUSE



The Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) Communication Faculty, Department of Public Relations and Advertising organized a walk to raise awareness about child abuse under the umbrella of the EMU Community Involvement Centre. The said walk commenced at EMU's main entrance on the 10th of December 2019 and ended with a press briefing at the Atatürk Square. EMU Communication Faculty, Department of Public Relations and Advertising Chair Assoc. Prof. Dr. Anıl Kemal Kaya stated that the walk took place in silence to raise awareness. A number of placards were also held throughout the walk. At the end of the walk, Department of Public Relations and Advertising Vice-Chair Asst. Prof. Dr. Umut Ayman made a press briefing highlighting the importance of the 10th of December, Human Rights Day. Asst. Prof. Dr. Ayman invited everyone to be sensitive about child abuse.

The press briefing of the EMU Department of Public Relations and Advertising read: "Today, we all came together as the EMU family to draw attention to the forms of child abuse that take place in many countries. Child abuse is one of the most dangerous social problems that harm the future of societies. Therefore, the people who were gathered today in front of EMU's main gate, are all sensitive to the problems that took place in our society recently. Thus, we as the Public Relations and Advertising Department, think that it is our responsibility to raise our voices

against child abuse. That is why we organize the awareness walk within EMU's campus to raise our voice against all forms of child abuse which have been taking place not only in our own society but all over the world. Child abuse or violence against children includes forms of violence, i.e. physical, sexual and/or psychological maltreatment against people below the age of 18, whether perpetuated parents, peers, caregivers, or strangers.

"Protect Your Child Protect Your Future!"

Nowadays, because everyone is too focused on their own lives, they are not aware of what is going on in their environment. Unfortunately, child abuse is not far away from us. Therefore, everyone needs to react to these problems in society and make an effort to do something to eliminate them. Families have many responsibilities to prevent child abuse. Who is Somer Sivrioğlu?

Somer Sivrioğlu was born in İstanbul,

Turkey. His passion for food developed at a young age in his grandmother's kitchen and mother's restaurant.

After graduating from Bilkent University's Department of Tourism and Hotel Management he became a restaurateur with his mother. Aged 25, he travelled to Sydney, Australia for a master's in Business. After being a chef and administrator at numerous restaurants in Sydney, in 2007 he established his dream project Efendy inside of an old mansion in Balmain. Sivrioğlu is both the owner and chef of Efendy, which has been awarded numerous regional and national awards. Efendy is one of the most important representatives of the Turkish cuisine in Australia.

In 2015, one of Sivrioğlu's dreams became a reality after his cookbook Anatolia was published in Australia, England and

America. The book was also translated into three languages (German, Dutch and Turkish). The book won many awards including the "International" Award of the International Association of Culinary Professionals (IACP).

In 2016, Sivrioğlu opened his second restaurant Anason, in the prestigious Barangaroo suburb of Sydney. For the last two years he has been a jury member on Masterchef Turkey. Sivrioğlu and his crew represented Turkish cuisine at the first season of Australia's Chef's Line cooking show where they finished first. Since 2007 when he opened Efendy, Somer Sivrioğlu, his restaurants and his book have received a total of 45 awards. He has represented Turkish cuisine in 10 different international conferences.
