COLLECTIVE LABOUR AGREEMENT SIGNED WITH ACADEMIC PERSONNEL IN EMU



A Collective Labour Agreement concerning the academic staff working at the Eastern Mediterranean University has been signed as a result of the work carried out by EMU Academic Personnel Union and Board of Trustees. On 27 December 2019, the Collective Labour Agreement was signed at the Board of Trustees' Meeting Room at 10:30 a.m. by the President of the EMU Board of Trustees Erdal Özcenk, EMU Board of Trustees member Gülsün Korun. EMU Academic Personnel Union's Secretary General Assoc. Prof. Dr. Hamit Caner and by Sen. Inst. Mustafa Ipekcioglu as a witness. Among those present at the ceremony were members of the Board of Trustees Halil İbrahim Orun and Ersun Kutup and President of the EMU Academic Personnel Union Sen. Inst. Ulaş Gökçe and union representatives. The validity period of the said agreement will be

two years.

"We Exist If EMU Exists"

Speaking at the signing ceremony, President of EMU Board of Trustees Erdal Özcenk stated that the Collective Labour Agreement has reached to the point of signing after their collaborative efforts with EMU Academic Personnel Union for two months. President Özcenk added "Both EMU Board of Trustees and EMU Academic Personnel Union continued our work on the collaborative agreement with an awareness that 'We, as all stakeholders, exist if EMU exists'. We have never ignored the fact that if the employees are happy, the current work motivation will be at the highest level, which will further improve the quality of our university. I would like to thank all colleagues at EMU Board of Trustees and EMU Academic

Personnel Union's Executive Board for their constructive attitude during the Collective Labour Agreement discussions and all administrative staff who helped with the writing of the text. I hope this agreement brings utmost benefit to the EMU Family."

"EMU is a Modern Institution of Higher Education"

President of EMU Academic Personnel Union Sen. Inst. Ulaş Gökçe said "Today, a collective labour agreement has been signed for the fourth time between our union and EMU Board of Trustees. A Collective Labour Agreement is a contract signed by civilized people. Civilized people sign and adhere to this agreement. In a modern educational institution, the relations between the employer and the employee are defined and carried out through legal texts. For this reason, today we are once again announcing to the whole country what a modern university EMU is. There are many universities in our country. We hear that the payment of social insurance and provident fund premiums and even salaries of our colleagues working at these institutions are not done regularly. As the employees of an institution who has the only collective bargaining agreement system in our country, we are well aware of the value of our university in this context." The ceremony ended after the signing of the Collective Labour Agreement.

Attending the ceremony was Nicosia's Turkish Ambassador Ali Murat Basceri, 28th Commander Brigadier of Mechanism Division Taner Uysal, President of the Atatürk Research Centre Prof. Dr. Adnan Sofuoğlu, EMU Rector Prof. Dr. Necdet Osam and Gazimağusa Chief of Police Ahmet Beserler, as well as society representatives, of representatives non-governmental organizations, Elazığ İzzet Paşa Foundation established by Medical Major Nihat İlhan, the Municipality of Elazığ, Bizim Külliye Magazine representatives, students and members of the press. The ceremony which was broadcast live on channels BRT 3 and DAÜ TV were viewed in Turkey and Azerbaycan.

"It Is The Symbol Of Our Struggle To Exist"

Republic of Turkey's Atatürk Supreme Council for Culture, Language and History, Atatürk Research Centre's central presidency and EMU-ATAUM since June, who together have been making preparations, began the panel by standing in silence and singing the Turkish National Anthem. The panels opening speech was made by EMU-ATAUM president, Assist. Prof. Dr. Turgay Bülent Göktürk, who stated that 21-25 December has a special meaning for Turkish Cypriots, elaborating that "These dates, that are defined as the National Struggle and Martyrs' Week, are the symbol of the Turkish Cypriot struggle for equality and sovereignty, in other words, the struggle for existence. These are the dates where the price was paid for us to live here freely, peacefully and prosperously today."

"We Have No Intention in Allowing The Genocide To Be Forgotten"

In his speech, Prof. Dr. Mustafa Necmi İlhan, the son of Medical Major Nihat İlhan, whom was murdered along with his family during the Kumsal raids, stated "Today we are together to understand the struggle of existence of Turkish Cypriots once again and to explain this to the future generations. We have not forgotten the torture and genocide of our fellow citizens in the face of my father, martyred family and the Turkish Cypriots, and we have no intention of allowing it to be forgotten. Malazgirt to Çanakkale, the fight against terrorism in Cyprus, the many veterans and martyrs that they gave, Anatolia and Cyprus are the only homelands they have ever known. We have no other place to go, and we have no intention of leaving this land."

In his speech, EMU Rector Prof. Dr. Necdet Osam stated that he doesn't like the month of December, however this has nothing to do with the cold weather. He explained it is because during this month that the Turkish Cypriot people were subjected to an incomparable massacre. Prof. Dr. Osam continued "I was born in 1961 and in 1963, I was put in the position of an immigrant. With the 1974 peace operation, we began to experience more freedom. Our childhood went by talking about when Turkey would

come to the island. We would look forward to the Turkish Regiment's day of change; maybe one of our soldiers' hats would fly during the change so we could wear a piece of that glorious uniform. At this moment in time, a soldier from Gazianteps hat is in my room." Prof. Dr. Osam further advised "We are announcing one more time from here to the world, our loyalty to our motherland. Turkish Cypriots will never end their struggle to exist and will continue to exist forever."

Cyprus History In All Of Its Dimensions Has Been Reflected

In his speech, President of the Turkish Republic Atatürk Research and Application Prof. Dr. Adnan Sofuoğlu enlightened the attendees on Cyprus history post 1571. Following the 2nd World War, with the 12 islands that were in the hands of Italy handed over to Greece, the possibility of Cyprus being given to Greece was emphasized, and the Cyprus issue was more seriously on the agenda. "In fact, considering its geographical and physical values, the island of Cyprus is part of Anatolia" he further explained. Prof. Dr. Sofuoğlu talked about subjects such as the 1950 Zurich Agreement and the 1960 establishment of the Republic of Cyprus, opposing the Greek constitutional order, the Turkish 1974 Peace Operation that pushed organisation of the Bloody Christmas events while the Greek and Greek Cypriots followed the "Akritas Plan" policy, in all of their dimensions.

Mehmet Güder, Mayor Municipality, said "This is the result of an epic resistance that the soldiers and the Mujahideen gave shoulder to shoulder at the expense of their lives. Today, we observe that the threat to the Turkish Cypriots is persistently pursued by the Greeks and global collaborators. Turkey's Cyprus cause is an indispensable case. As homeland and guarantor country, we will continue to stand by Cyprus and Turkish Cypriots as in the past. Together we paid heavy prices, but the Turkish Cypriot will never and will never be alone on this island".

"Turkish Cypriots Will Live Forever and Free"

Nicosia's Ambassador of the Republic of Turkey Ali Murat Başçer of Nicosia expained, "the events of December 1963 is known in history as 'Bloody Christmas'. This is our 56th year. What happened in December 1963 was a turning point for the Turkish people living on this island. As İsmail Tansu described in his beautiful book, 'In actual fact no one was actually sleeping.' But in 1963, the activities of the EOKA organization surfaced. The events of 1963 were the beginning of the struggle that showed that the Greek Cypriot-Greek persecution would not be submitted to. During the 1960 Republic of partnership, the Greeks regarded the Turks as a minority. They even put it openly and said, 'If you don't accept this, then let's deal with this with guns and we will eliminate you' thus putting the Akritas Plan into



action. Makarios stated that this agreement would be a springboard for ENOSIS. The responsibility that fell to the Turkish community was to stay united and together against this mentality, and with the support of Turkey, to endure and resist. It wasn't easy. It's been a long process. The struggle that started in December 1963 and ended with the happy Peace Operation in July 1974, was the guarantee that the Turkish Cypriots would live independently on this island forever. We as the Turkish Nation do not live with a sense of revenge. But our future generations need to be equipped with a sense of history. The amount of honor we have for not having this revenge is insufficient" he explained.

The Program Continued In Two Sessions

The ceremony, under the management of the Atatürk Research and Application Centres central presidency continued in two sessions. The panel included; Assist. Prof. Dr. Turgay Bülent Göktürk's "The Massacre Experienced by the Turkish Cypriots During the Historical Process," Dr. Ayşe Şebnem İlhan's "Biography of Medical Major Nihat İlhan,"

President of the Mujahideen Association Yılmaz Bora "Why 21st December 1963," Ambassador Ahmet Zeki Bulunç's "The Greek Cypriot-Greek Duo's ENOSIS Genocide and the War of Existence of the Turkish Cypriot People," Prof. Dr. Necip İlhan's "The İzzetpaşa Foundation and Medical Major Nihat İlhan's Services" Ex



President of the Mujahideen Association Vural Türkmen's "One Critical Night," and teaching staff Süheyla Göktürk's "The Barbarian Museum through the Eyes of the Visitors," that were presented on the day.

During the afternoon session, state artist Mustafa Turan, Elazığ Bizim Külliye magazine's Editor in Chief Nazım Payan and Charicaturist Osman Suroğlu were featured. The Elazığ İzzet Paşa Vakfı, Elazığ municipality and the Bizim Külliye Magazine that were established by Medical Major Nihat İlhan, were attended by representatives of around 40 people to take place at the memorial ceremony.

Elazığ Bizim Külliye magazine published thir 82nd issue in December, with the section "Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus Literature, In Memory of Medical Major Nihat İlhan and his Martyred Family" featured." In this magazine, the articles of many Turkish Cypriot artists and historians were given place to. This particular issue was distributed to all the attendees at the panel. The Cyprus related charicatures prepared by Charicaturist Osman Suroğlu, were printed in Photoblock form and exhibited in th EMU Central Lecture Halls on the day of the panel. Additionally, the projects prepared by EMU students in relation to the Turkish Cypriot Struggle for Existence, were presented to the attendees at the panel.



EMU'S COMMEMORIAL PROGRAM FOR MARTYRS CONTINUES AT THE MUSEUM OF BARBARISM





A visit was made to the Barbarism Museum on Tuesday, 24 December 2019 in scope of a panel and a commemoration ceremony titled "In Memory of Major Nihat İlhan and His Martyred Family: Turkish Cypriots' Struggle for Existence and Kumsal Raid". Hosted by the Eastern Mediterranean University, the said panel is organised in collaboration with the Turkish Republic Atatürk Supreme Council for Culture, Language and History, Atatürk Research Center and EMU Atatürk Research and Application Center (EMU ATAUM).

Present at the commemoration ceremony which took place at the Museum of Barbarism at 10:30 a.m. were Turkish Republic Ambassador to Nicosia Ali Murat Başçeri, TRNC Deputy Parliamentary Spokesperson Zorlu Töre, Commander of Security Forces Altan Er, EMU Rector Prof. Dr. Necdet Osam, T.R Supreme Council for Culture, Language, and History, Atatürk Research Center Chair Prof. Dr. Adnan Sofuoğlu, EMU ATAUM Chair Assist. Prof.

Dr. Turgay Bülent Göktürk, children and family of Major Nihat İlhan, whose children and spouse were martyred in Kumsal raid, Elazığ İzzet Paşa Foundation and Elazığ Municipality and Bizim Külliye Magazine representatives, representatives of combat associations, organisations and schools and military officials. At the ceremony during which a moment of silence, national anthem and volley salute were performed, wreaths were laid on the monument.

During the ceremony Şehit Ertuğrul Primary School student Belgin Çelikesmer read a poem and Cyprus Turkish Forces Infantry Commander Raif Akgün, the Association of Martyrs' Families and Disabled Veterans, Culture Branch Chair Kadir Okyar and Nihat İlhan's son Prof. Dr. Mustafa Necmi İlhan delivered speeches.

In his speech, Prof. Dr. Mustafa Necmi İlhan said "We, as a family, suffered four casualties, while the Turkish Cypriots lost hundreds. Long live our homeland". Prof.

Dr. İlhan added that they will continue to support the Turkish Cypriots in their struggle for existence. Following the speeches, Turkish Republic Ambassador to Nicosia Ali Murat Başçeri and EMU Rector Prof. Dr. Necdet Osam laid flowers on the monument and visited the museum.

A Visit to T.R. Ambassador to Nicosia

Following the ceremony, the aforesaid representatives paid a visit to the Republic of Turkey's Ambassador to Nicosia Ali Murat Başçeri. During the visit, Ambassador Başçeri congratulated the representatives of the institutions that organised such a successful event and underlined the essence of conducting such activities more frequently. Rector Prof. Osam stressed that they are always ready to host activities as such. The program came to a close after the visits of the guests from Turkey to the war cemeteries in Boğaz, Muratağa, Sandallar and Atlılar Şehitlikleri.


