## MINISTRY OF HEALTH, EMU AND THE COMMITTEE ON MISSING PERSONS IN CYPRUS TURKISH CYPRIOT MEMBERS OFFICE SIGN A CO-OPERATION PROTOCOL

Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus (TRNC) Ministry of Health, Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) and the Committee on Missing Persons in Cyprus Turkish Cypriot Members Office signed a co-operation protocol on February 20th 2019, Wednesday (10:00) at the Ministry of Health about researching the hereditary traits of kidney diseases. Minister of Health Dr. Filiz Besim, EMU Rector Prof. Dr. Necdet Osam and the Committee on Missing Persons in Cyprus Turkish Cypriot Members Office representative Gülden Plümer Küçük signed the protocol.



During the signing ceremony, Dr. Filiz Besim underlined the significant increase observed in the country during the latest years and that this issue had also attracted the attention of experts from the University of London College (UCL). Dr. Besim noted that the aim was to determine the concentrated areas of kidney diseases, informing families, creating awareness and bringing the studies on a

wider range. Dr. Besim also expressed her happiness about hereditary kidney disease related research being jointly run by UCL, EMU and Nicosia Burhan Nalbantoğlu State Hospital Nephrology Department. Gülden Plümer Küçük stated that TRNC would gain its international connections with science and that these developments would open many

doors for the Turkish Cypriots. In his speech, Prof. Dr. Osam expressed his happiness about EMU's contribution to this research project and mentioned the existence of an agreement between EMU and UCL on academic studies. Furthermore, he said that in accordance with the vision of the Ministry of Health, EMU would continue to do its part for society.

## IMPORTANT REPRESENTATION FROM EMU DEPARTMENT OF ARCHITECTURE AT INTERNATIONAL COMPETITION

The contest aimed to significantly decrease the natural disaster risks and losses for people and businesses; also for the economic, physical, social, cultural and environmental existence of societies and countries; along with the risks and losses that may pose threats for their well-being and subsistence. The theme of the contest was determined by considering the aforementioned topics.

The said contest was held in three different categories, namely projects developed by students, projects developed and to be realized by design professionals and projects developed by design professionals but will not be put into practice. The top three projects received awards and all short-listed projects were given the opportunity to be included in an exhibition or to be published.



Some scenarios like fire, flood, tsunami, earthquake, drought, whirlwind, areas with a landslide tendency, refugee camp and urban areas housing refugees were proposed for the participants' projects. Each team worked on a different scenario from a different part of the world and created their own programmes. They focused on creating a better form of recycling that will either include a flexible design that takes place at any stage of the disaster risk management cycle, or creating a design to surpass its predecessor.

The contest received a total of 60 applications from around the world and the evaluations were done by expert academicians and pragmatists of urban planning, landscape design, disaster risk management, humanitarian architecture and shanty settlements. During the first stage of evaluation, each project was evaluated by at least 5 experts and 29 projects were chosen in 3 different categories.

During the final stage of the competition held in Lisbon, the final evaluations were performed and the winners were announced. ## WORLD-FAMOUS CHEFS TO TEACH IN EMU

Students of Eastern Mediterranean University Tourism Faculty, Gastronomy and Culinary Arts Department are quite excited to hear the news of prominent chefs teaching in their faculty. The famous chefs, who are all experts in their own fields, have started to teach in EMU during the 2018-2019 Academic Year Spring Semester. Chef Murat Bozok, who worked for two years with Chef Gordon Ramsay, a world-famous professional who has a total of 13 Michelin Stars worldwide, received a proposal to work in France from famous French Chef Joel Robuchon, master of Gordon Ramsay who tallied up the highest number of Michelin Stars in the world. Bozok then returned to Turkey and opened his own restaurant called "Mimolett". Currently, along with his TV program "Signature Dishes", Bozok provides consultancy services to many different restaurants. During the 2018-2019 Academic Year Spring Semester, Bozok will be sharing his expertise and accumulation with the students of EMU.

### Leaders of their Chosen Fields

Chef Fikret Özdemir is another famous professional who will be teaching in EMU. Fikret Özdemir, who started his professional career in Swiss Restaurant Du Chato, after studying for 18 months in gastronomy in France, worked as a culinary chef in Frankfurt, Hamburg and Istanbul branches of Marriott Hotel chains. Özdemir also worked at Sheraton Grand Istanbul Ataşehir branch as a chef, culinary chef and executive chef. Özdemir, who speaks French, Portuguese, German and English, has also authored a cookbook titled "A Journey of Taste and Culture from Kahramanmaraş to Lisbon".

Chef Tolgar Mireli, who served in the Department of Gastronomy and Culinary Arts at EMU Tourism Faculty in the past, is at again EMU to offer courses after a short break. He took up his first task in a 7-star hotel in Dubai called Al Muntaha by Burj Al Arab Hotel. He then worked with 2 Michelin star Chef Björn Alexander Panek for two years and also had a chance to work with 3-Michelin star Chef Michel Roux in Le Gavroche in London. He then had a chance to work with one Michelin star Chef Gary Danko in San Fransisco for a period of one year and then he worked in Frankfurt as a Sous-Chef in Le Val d'Or and Bistro d'Or restaurants of Johann Lafer, Europe's



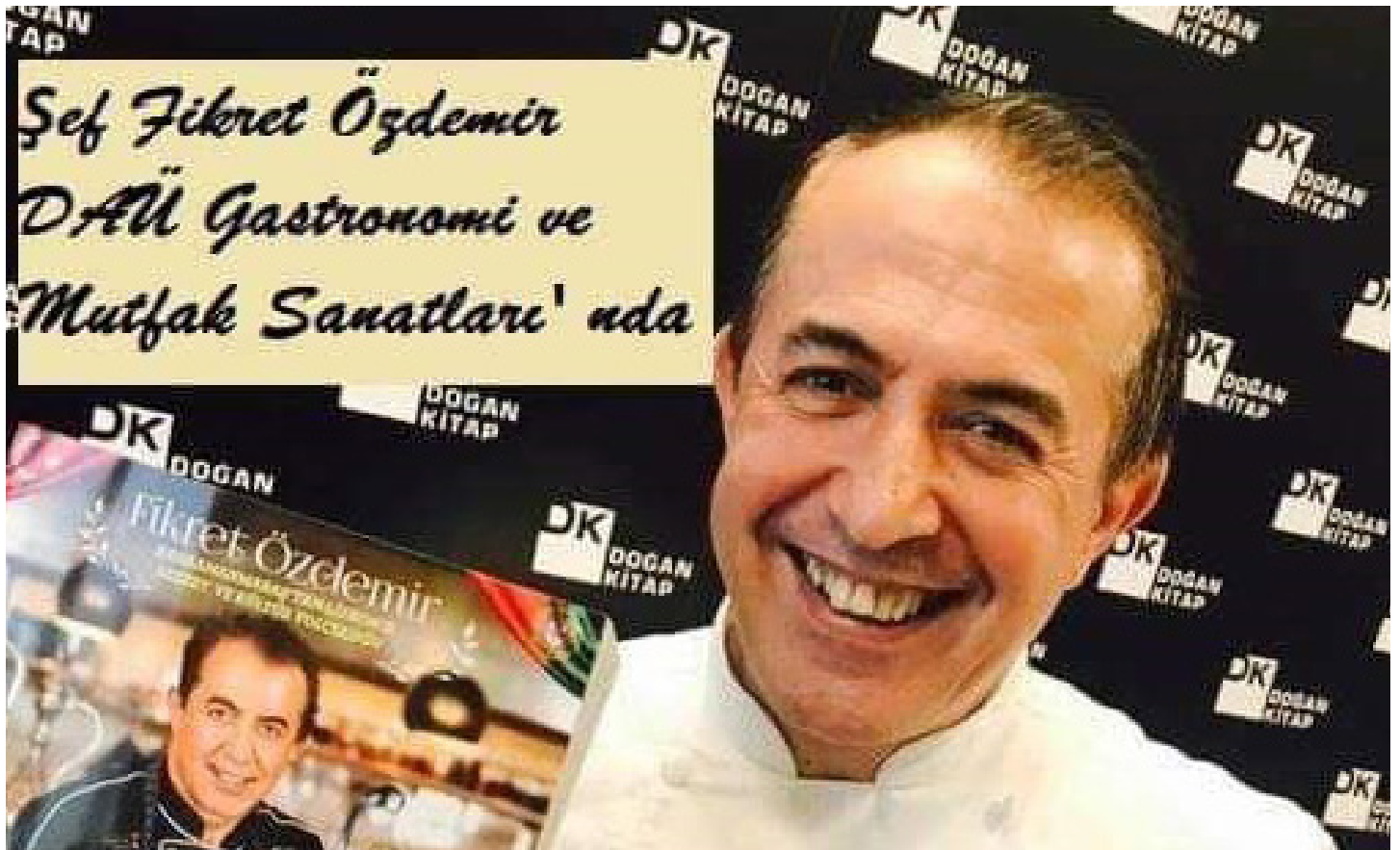


most famous TV chef. At present, he is still involved in the preparations for the opening of his own restaurant in Turkey.

Chefs from 16 Michelin-starred restaurants participated in the 4th Gastromasa Conference which took place in 2018.

On 4 March 2019, students of Güzelyurt Turkish Maarif College, Kurtuluş High School, Güzelyurt Vocational High School, Cengiz Topel Vocational High School of Industry, and Lefke Gazi High School from Morphou and Lefke regions

will be participating in the workshops. On 5 Mart 2019, students of İskele region high schools, namely, Bekirpaşa High School, İskele High School of Trade, Erenköy High School, Karpaz Vocational High School and Cumhuriyet High School will benefit from the aforesaid workshops. On 11 March 2019, students from high schools located within the Nicosia district will attend the workshops.
