EMU FACULTY OF ARTS AND SCIENCES IS AMONG THE BESTS WORLDWIDE

Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) Faculty of Arts and Sciences, which has the only Physics and Chemistry Departments within the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus (TRNC) and one of the two Mathematics Departments in the country, has once again proven its quality by becoming one of the world's bests.

In addition to its leading position in the TRNC, with its strong and prominent academic staff members, the Faculty has been ranked within the 501-600 band in the UK based higher education ranking board Times Higher Education's (THE) 2019 World University Rankings in the "Physical Sciences" category through the contributions of the Physics, Mathematics and Chemisty Departments operating under the said faculty. With the aforesaid ranking, EMU Faculty of Arts and Sciences is now 5th amongst the universities of Turkey.

Dean of EMU Faculty of Arts and Sciences Prof. Dr. Mehmet Ali Özarslan emphasized that the faculty's recent success in THE rankings, together with the successful achievements in the Nature Index rankings in the last 3 years, is the most important indicator of the quality of the education offered at the high standards in the Faculty, and emphasized that the faculty will maintain its outstanding success.

Over 4000 Graduates

EMU Faculty of Arts and Sciences is one of the three faculties established in 1986 when the Institute of High Technology was converted into a state university under the name of Eastern Mediterranean University. Students who have graduated from the faculty, which boasts an elite group of alumni reaching 4000 in number, continue their academic studies and careers successfully in a wide geography ranging from America to Australia, from Europe to Asia and to Africa. The Physics and Chemistry Departments, which were founded in 1989, have two important tasks in EMU and cater for the demands in these areas. The Physics and Chemistry departments also offer the students master's programs with thesis requirements and doctoral degree programs. On the other hand, Mathematics Department, which has the only English-medium Actuarial



Science Program both within Turkey and the TRNC, also offers study opportunities in different areas including Mathematics and Computer Science undergraduate program, Information Systems non-thesis master's program, Applied Mathematics and Computer Science master's program with thesis requirements, Mathematics PhD. program and Applied Mathematics and Computer Science PhD. program.

Prof. Dr. Gökhan İzbırak, EMU Department of Industrial Engineering Chair, unlike people's assumptions, Industrial Engineers and Business Engineers are not stationed in factories producing all kinds of products, but are also in the service sector (consultancy, transportation, logistics, finance, banking, hospitals, branding, software, tourism, education, telecommunication, marketing, human resources etc.), construction and extraction (extraction of petroleum, natural gas, mine etc.) firms and they contribute by helping the firms produce more and high quality products/services with lower costs.

Eastern Mediterranean University's ABET accredited (an accreditation only 5 universities have in Turkey) (abet.org) Department of Industrial Engineering enables its successful students to get Mechanical Engineering or Business Administration diplomas through its double major program. Since 1998, the year when Industrial Engineering and Business Engineering programs produced their first graduates, graduates of the aforesaid programs have been positioned

at managerial positions at national and international firms active in production, service, construction and extraction sectors. These graduates are admitted into post-graduate programs at world-famous universities such as MIT and Cambridge, are able to graduate from those programs with honours and continue their careers as academicians.

Who is Ziva Ediz Gürsan?

Ziya Ediz Gürsan graduated from Eastern Mediterranean University, Industrial Engineering Department in 2006 and after his military service, started his career in 2007 at the Revenue Management Department at SunExpress Airlines, an associated company by German Lufthansa and Turkish Airlines. Receiving a promotion every year, Gürsan became the Revenue Management Manager of SunExpress airlines in 4 short years and continued in this position for another 3. In 2014, he transferred to AtlasGlobal Airlines and was stationed in Tbilisi as the Country Manager of Georgia. After a successful work period of 2 years, Ziya Ediz Gürsan was appointed as the Pricing Manager at AtlasGlobal's Headquarters in İstanbul. EMU DR. FAZIL KÜÇÜK MEDICINE FACULTY CELEBRATES 14TH MARCH MEDICINE DAY



Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) Dr. Fazıl Küçük Medicine Faculty organised a series of events within the scope of 14 March Medicine Day. Eastern Mediterranean University's young doctor candidates, accompanied by academicians, laid a wreath on Atatürk statue at EMU Atatürk Square at 8:30 a.m. on Thursday, 14 March 2019. The ceremony commenced with a moment of silence and the national anthem. Addressing the

students in participation, EMU Dr. Fazıl Küçük Medicine Faculty academic staff member Assist. Prof. Dr. Bülent Sezgin talked about the importance of 14 March Medicine Day.

Stating that the establishment of the first medicine faculty founded with western ideology was on 14 March 1827, Assist. Prof. Dr. Sezgin added that, "In 1919 when Istanbul was under attack, medicine

students organised a meeting to protest the occupation forces. They told the commander of the occupation forces that the meeting was going to be organised to celebrate the first anniversary of the foundation of their faculty as 14 March Medicine Day. This tradition was observed to date. Throughout the world, there is no concept of 'Medicine Day'. It is only special to our country". Assist. Prof. Dr. Sezgin added that the Medicine Day is highly important in bringing the health problems of the country on the agenda and acting as a platform for the solutions offered by our doctors against these problems. 14 March Medicine Day is also vital in highlighting the issues and problems pertaining to the personal rights of the health personnel.



100 Trees in 100 Years

After the ceremony, students and academicians of EMU Dr. Fazıl Küçük Medicine Faculty went to the area where tree planting would take place. Students planted 100 trees, symbolising the 100th anniversary of the Medicine Day, in the area allocated to the faculty as Dr. Fazıl Küçük Medicine Faculty Grove.



EMU DR. FAZIL KÜÇÜK MEDICINE FACULTY CELEBRATES 14TH OF MARCH – MEDICINE DAY



Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) Dr. Fazıl Küçük Medicine Faculty Dean Prof. Dr. Nahide Gökçora released a statement on the occasion of the 14th of March, Medicine Day, which reads as follows:

"14th of March is of vital importance for the health sector. Medicine Day is observed annually on the 14th of March to denote the struggles experienced by the healthcare professionals and also to emphasize their contributions to science and community. 14th of March 1827 is regarded as the beginning of the modern medicine education in Turkey. The first ever celebrated Medicine Day in Turkey was in 1919 by the medical students opposing the forces occupying Turkey at the end of World War I. This year, the Medicine Day is to be celebrated for the 100th time is an indicator of fight against captivity. It is a day of respect for healthcare professionals who try their best today to save the lives of people whatever the conditions are. The celebrations in other countries are held on significant dates regarding medicine.

Working in healthcare is not a profession it is a lifestyle. Enjoying life, respecting the ones that are different and, working selflessly with a discipline for a lifetime are essential features of such a lifestyle.

We do not only provide medical training for our students who come from 17 diferent nations but also provide opportunities for them to share their own cultures with fellow students as well as helping them acquire important skills such as tolerance, empathy, communication skills, stress management, future planning and support. EMU Faculty of Medicine educates its students by prioritising the modern and most recent methodologies applied in the field of Medical Education. Last year for the first graduates of our faculty, we planted an olive tree for each graduating student. This

year, we are planting trees in our faculty within the scope of the Medicine Day.

Our university's joint project with the TRNC Ministry of Health, launched with the support of Turkey's Nicosia Embassy Aid Committee as well as Department of Cancer in Turkey, has been successfully carried out. Within this framework, the draft act regarding "Mandatory Cancer Declaration" has been presented to be discussed in the Council and, the Cancer Monitoring, Guidance and Education Center (KİDEM) and National Cancer Council (UKDK) have been formed. Moreover, this year, we have organized various extensive courses in order to raise awareness on the matter. Therefore, we are planning to announce the very first data on cancer registries on Cancer Week, 1-7 April.

Today, the local and global magnitude of healthcare services has increased the numbers and characteristics of the qualifications expected from medicine faculty graduates. As a result of the annual increase in the effects of globalization, Medicine Faculties are obliged to raise healthcare professionals that are able to find solutions for local and national health problems of the society. EMU Medicine Faculty that acts within this framework of awareness and responsibilities has 14 different competencies (ranging from evidence based medicine practices to group work as well as humanitarian values) offering its students a rich and broad education program. The competencies expected from a Medicine Faculty graduate includes being confident, able to develop empathy, humane, honest, respectful, careful, professional, an advocate for health, a team member, an advisor, an administrator and leader, a scientist and lastly, a communicator. Vigorous efforts are made in order to provide both local and international opportunities for students to improve themselves. We should never forget that life is a gift for humans and we, humans, shall honour and prosper. I extend my best wishes to all on the occasion of 14 March Medicine Day."




