



10TH INTERNATIONAL CONGRESS ON CYPRUS STUDIES HELD AT EMU



The Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) Center for Cyprus Studies (CSS) held the 10th International Congress on Cyprus Studies with the broad perspective of issues focusing on Cyprus between the 24th and 25th of April 2019 at the Rauf Raif Denktaş Culture and Congress Center. The event which commenced with an opening ceremony at 10:00 on Wednesday, the 24th of April 2019 featured a total of 46 papers being presented.

The opening ceremony of the congress was attended by Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus (TRNC) Parliamentary Speaker Teberrüken Uluçay, Republican Turkish Party MP, European Union (EU) Compliance Committee President and Council of Europe Parliamentary Assembly Member Armağan Candan as well as İnönü Mayor Ali Öncü.

In her opening speech that took place after a moment of silence and the national anthem, EMU Center for Cyprus Studies President and Vice Rector for Administrative and Technical Affairs Prof. Dr. Naciye Doratlı stated that 150 islands are located in the Mediterranean before noting that Cyprus is the third largest of these islands. Prof. Dr. Doratlı then underlined that Cyprus is a strategic island which has been home to many different civilizations. Prof. Dr. Doratlı went on to emphasize that EMU-CCS was founded in 1995 and that it has



been encouraging and carrying out research and publications on all topics relating to Cyprus, since its foundation. Prof. Dr.

Doratlı concluded by stating that a total of 46 research papers that were selected out of 60 will be presented at the congress. **Cont. p. 2**

EMU is Well-Respected in the TRNC and the World

In a speech of his own, EMU Rector Prof. Dr. Necdet Osam stated that EMU-CSS continues to take firm steps in light of EMU's mission to carry out research and make publications concerning regional and local topics. Underlining that EMU is a well-respected university in the TRNC and the world, Prof. Dr. Osam emphasized that this year EMU will be celebrating its 40th year.

Stating that the university promotes the TRNC and its culture in places all over the world, Prof. Dr. Osam underlined the importance of EMU featuring in 633rd place out of 25 thousand world universities. Highlighting that only 23 universities from Turkey, which is home to over 200 universities, could feature on the list Prof. Dr. Osam stated that EMU occupied 6th place amongst Turkish Universities featured on the list such as the METU and ITU. Also noting that EMU was ranked 111th amongst world universities under 50 years old, Prof. Dr. Osam relayed

that TRNC state representatives need to make the necessary contributions for the university to get to an even better place.

EMU is the Apple of the Academic Community's Eye

Speaking at the opening ceremony of the congress, TRNC Parliamentary Speaker Teberrüken Uluçay emphasized that the Center for Cyprus Studies' congress will contribute to both EMU and the TRNC. Indicating that the TRNC is 36 years old and EMU is 40 years old, Uluçay noted that EMU is an institution that provides world-class education and is the apple of the academic community's eye. Uluçay concluded by underlining that EMU fully deserves to occupy the position it is occupying on the World rankings. Highlighting that EMU is an institution which represents the country beyond its borders, Uluçay stated that it also contributes to the financial development of the TRNC. Emphasizing that EMU got to where it is today after 40 years of effort and devotion Uluçay noted that the work of the Center for

Cyprus Studies sheds light for management, students and academicians. Following the opening speeches, a presentation titled "Turkish Cypriots and the European Union" was delivered by guest speaker Republican Turkish Party MP, European Union (EU) Compliance Committee President and Council of Europe Parliamentary Assembly Member Armağan Candan.

This was followed by the presentation titled "Orthopedic Problems Seen in Cyprus" which was delivered by Dokuz Eylül University, Faculty of Medicine, Orthopedics and Traumatology Department academic staff member Prof. Dr. Hasan Havitçioğlu.

The first session of the conference commenced at 14:00, after the presentations of the main speakers. A total of 14 presentations took place during the first day of the congress in two concurrent sessions. Prof. Dr. Osam and Prof. Dr. Doratlı presented Candan a certificate of appreciation and a plaque whilst Prof. Dr. Havitçioğlu received his from EMU Communication Faculty, Department of Cinema and Television Chair Prof. Dr. Bahire Özad.

The Presentations Continued on the 25th of April 2019

Presentations continued with concurrent sessions on the 25th of April 2019, the second day of the congress. A total of 32 presentations took place in the first four sessions of the congress. The event came to an end with a closing panel during the final session of the congress.

PHYSIOTHERAPY AND REHABILITATION SYMPOSIUM COMMENCES IN EMU



EasternMediterraneanUniversity, Faculty of Health Sciences, Department of Physiotherapy and Rehabilitation's '1st National Eastern Mediterranean Physiotherapy and Rehabilitation Symposium' commenced at Mustafa Afşin Ersoy Hall at 9:00 a.m. on Friday, 26 April 2019.

The symposium, which started with a moment of silence and the national anthem, continued with a mini concert by EMU Faculty of Education, Department of Fine Arts Education, Music Teaching Program academic staff members Choir Conductor Erkan Dağlı and Pianist Atakan Sarı and opening speeches. EMU Department of Physiotherapy and Rehabilitation academic staff member and symposium chair Prof. Dr. İnci Yüksel stated that it is now a necessity to share and exchange information in order to follow the developments in science and technology. Emphasizing the need to constantly work and renew information to keep up with this rapidly changing scientific era, Prof. Dr. Yüksel added that "We have to keep the soil of scientific creativity moist". In a speech of her own, EMU Health Sciences Faculty Dean Prof. Dr. Mehtap Malkoç Professor Dr. underlined that EMU Health Sciences Faculty has gained a great momentum in a short period of time and that

their main objective is to take the field of health sciences in the country to further levels. Prof. Dr. Malkoç also stated that their primary target is educating health scientists who will serve for the processing, sharing, and holistic evaluation of information and ultimately its use for the benefit of the society.

In his address, EMU Rector Prof. Dr. Necdet Osam stated that the organization of this symposium by the Faculty of Health Sciences is of great importance for EMU. Expressing that EMU's visibility in the field of health has increased greatly, Prof. Dr. Osam also expressed his hope that this symposium would be moved to the international level in the following years. Providing information on EMU's successful achievements, Prof. Dr. Osam also talked about the international research currently conducted by EMU Health, Medicine and Pharmacy Faculties. At the end of his speech, Prof. Dr. Osam thank everyone who contributed to the organisation of this symposium.

Taking place under the main theme 'Innovations in Orthopedic Physiotherapy and Rehabilitation', the symposium started with a session titled "The Collaboration of Orthopedics and Physiotherapy" and chaired by Prof. Dr. Bülent Atilla. The

symposium then continued at 11:00 a.m. with a panel titled "New Approaches in the Treatment of Anterior Cruciate Ligament Injuries" chaired by Prof. Dr. Halit Pınar and Prof. Dr. Filiz Can Sempozyum. In the panel, Prof. Dr. Halit Pınar talked about "Anterior Cruciate Ligament Reconstruction", Assoc. Prof Dr. Aydan Aytar provided information on "The Importance of Prevention and Proprioception in Anterior Cruciate Ligament Injuries", Prof. Dr. Filiz Can delivered a session titled "Innovations in the Rehabilitation of Anterior Cruciate Ligament Injuries" and Prof. Dr. Defne Kaya presented information on "Return to Sport after Anterior Cruciate Ligament Injuries".

The event continued at 2:00 p.m. with a conference chaired by Prof. Dr. Nihal Ekici Gelecek and Expert Phys. Şahveren Çakartaş. During the conference, Dean of Faculty of Health Sciences Prof. Dr. Mehtap Malkoç delivered a presentation titled "Cardiopulmonary Rehabilitation Approaches after Orthopedic Surgery". The conference continued with a panel titled "Ankle Ligament and Tendon Injuries".

During the session chaired by Prof. Dr. Ali Öznur and Dr.

Asın Yürükler, Prof. Dr. Ali Öznur delivered a presentation titled "Evaluation and Surgical Approaches", Assist. Prof. Dr. Berkiye Kırmızıgöl talked about "Conservative Treatment in Achilles Tendon Injuries", Prof. Dr. Zafer Erden provided information on "Functional Rehabilitation in Ankle Ligament Injuries" and Assist. Prof. Dr. Yasin Kurt talked about "Foot and Ankle Orthosis".

On the second day of the symposium expert academic staff members will be offering panels under the titles of "Spine: Disc Pathologies", "Current Approaches in Knee Arthroplasty", "Current Approaches in Patellofemoral Pain Rehabilitation" and "Athlete Shoulder and Rehabilitation". The second day will finish with oral presentations.

Prof. Dr. Özge Çakır will be delivering information on "Tai Chi Applications in Orthopedic Rehabilitation" and Prof. Dr. Nur Tunalı will be holding a workshop titled "Reflexology".

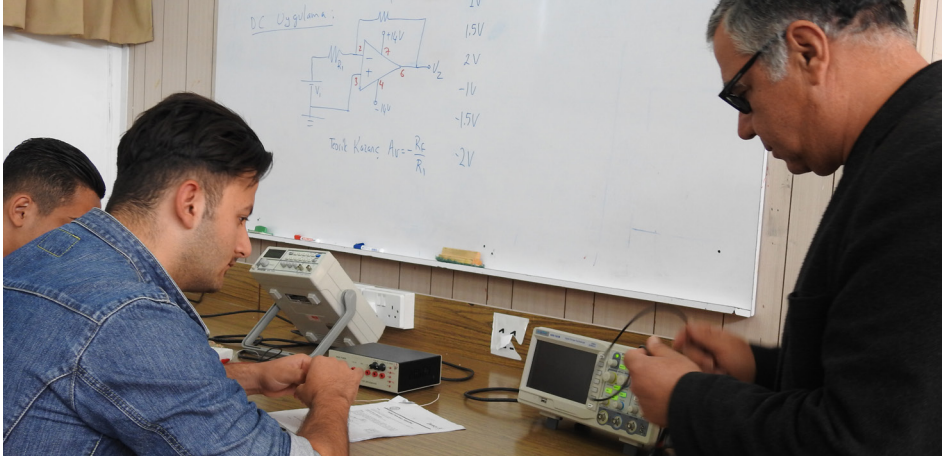


Talk Was Delivered

EMU-SCT OFFERS APPLIED TRAINING PROGRAM FOR THE STUDENTS OF DR. FAZIL KÜÇÜK VOCATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL OF INDUSTRY



Students of Dr. Fazıl Küçük Vocational High School of Industry participated in an applied training program at Eastern Mediterranean University, School of Computing and Technology (SCT). Accompanied by academic staff and their teachers, the students designed a computer-aided circuit in the electronic laboratory by using the ISIS and ARES programs used in circuit design. Students who worked in virtual environment by simulating the electronic circuit and printed circuits designed in computer environment, also printed their designs on the copper plaque by using the state-of-the-art LPKF Laser and Electronics PROTOMAT S63 model. The students also got familiarised with the profession of “Biomedical Device Technician” through carrying out applied experiments in the field of Biomedical Device Technologies. In the experiments conducted in this area, some applications were made by using KL-730 Biomedical Measurement

Training Set. The device is designed to enable students to learn to perform specific measurements on the circuit and to detect simple physiological signals through practical operations. In addition, students can clearly understand the electrical characteristics of sensors and transducers following completion of experiments. KL-730 has 12 modules including Electromyogram Measurement, Electrocardiogram Measurement, Ventilator Respiratory Sensing, Electroencephalogram Measurement, Electroretinogram Measurement, Electrocardiogram Measurement, Blood Pressure Measurement, Doppler Ultrasound Blood Velocity Measurement, Pulse Measurement, Body Impedance Measurement, Photoplethysmography Measurement, TENS and Breathing Flow / Vital Capacity Measurement. The sensors and inverters used in the device include pressure transducers, infrared photocouples, voltage meters, temperature sensors, surface

electrodes, double element inverters, and pneumatic inverters. Each module has multiple test points for varying bandwidth and booster gain. In this way, students understand the relationship between the physiological signals and the phase of each circuit.

With the help of the methods used to display the output signal, the students;

- 1-monitored the real time representation of the 128 X 64 LCD display of the main device and related physiological parameters, such as heart rhythm, breath rate, and so forth.
- 2- displayed the physiological signals in the Digital Storage Oscilloscope (DSO) channel.
- 3- with the embedded 10-bit A / D converters (2.4 Kbits / s) they turned the physiological signals into digital forms and watched the transfer from real-time signals to the computer via USB port and transfer to store.

“The Important Role of Vocational Education in Solving the Unemployment Problem”

In a statement of his own, Director of EMU-SCT Prof. Dr. Mustafa İlkan emphasized that besides the common basic problems, the main problem of education countrywide is that there is no policy of transition to higher education based on orientation and the importance of vocational education not reaching the desired levels. Stating that through practices as such, vocational high schools aim to provide a new motivation for their students, Prof. Dr. İlkan emphasized that the vocational education in the TRNC should be redesigned in terms of its position within the educational system. Prof. Dr. İlkan also emphasized the project of making the vocational high schools-vocational schools chain compulsory. Prof. Dr. İlkan added that they are ready for voluntary participation in every platform where vocational education will be discussed. Prof. Dr. İlkan also mentioned that vocational education plays an important role in the solution of the unemployment problem, which is the main problem of the country’s young generation. Professor Dr. İlkan concluded his statement by stating that they are ready to contribute to all activities in this area with the understanding of serving to the young generation of the country.

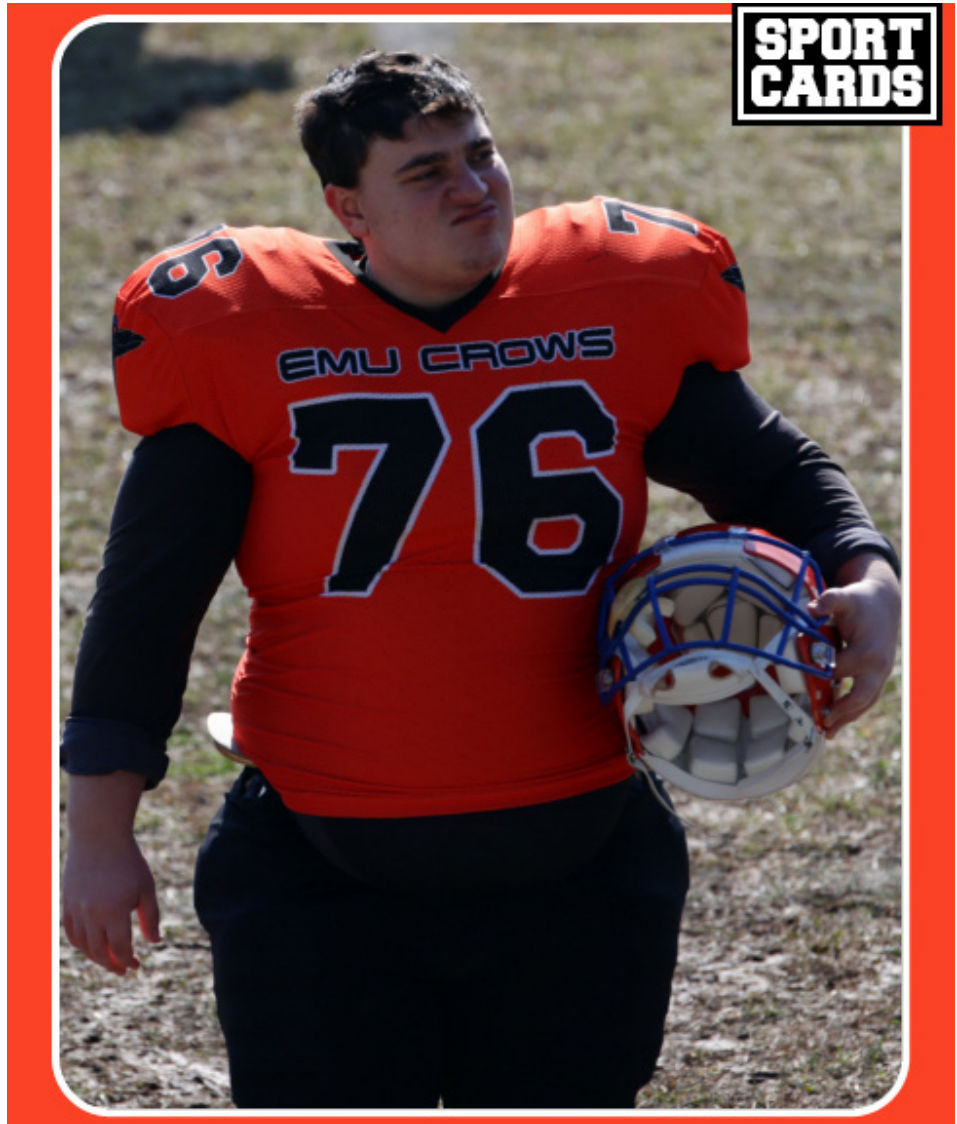
