

The Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) is going to be accepting students to the Fine Arts Department operating under the Education Faculty for the 2019-2020 Academic Year with a special skills test. The single-stage test will be administered between 10:00 and 16:00 on the 28th and 29th of May 2019 at the Department of Fine Arts Education.

During the special skills test which is comprised of written and practical components candidates will be asked to perform various music related skills such as 5 single voice hearing-repeating, 5 double voice hearing-repeating; major, minor, numerical cords, 2 four-voice hearing-repeating, 7-chords, melody hearing-repeating, repeating 2 melodic sentences with 2 motifs and tonal, playing a musical piece



and the national anthem with an instrument.

During the interview, candidates will also be asked questions about their past music education as well as their individual and academic qualities. TRNC nationals who have finished their high-school education can

100th Year Youth Walk

The 100th anniversary of 19 May 1919 celebrations came to an end with the "Recreating Ata's Signature on Land" and "100th Year Youth Walk" events which took place on Sunday, 19 May Commemoration of Atatürk Youth and Sports Day. At 15:00 students used their bodies to make a frame for Atatürk's signature at the EMU Yasin Düşüner Stadium. This event was also attended by EMU Rector Prof. Dr. Necdet Osam. At 19:19 on the same day the "100th Year Youth Walk" commenced from the Atatürk Square. Famagusta District Governor Kemal Serpal, EMU Health Sciences Dean Prof. Dr. Mehtap Malkoç, Commander Ali Koruk, EMU-ATAUM Executive Board Members, academic staff, EMU and Famagusta high school students also participated in the said walk.

Significantly High Attendance

The events commenced with a moment of silence for martyrs and the national anthem, followed by a speech from EMU-ATAUM President Asst. Prof. Dr. Turgay Bülent Göktürk. Asst. Prof. Dr. Göktürk indicated that the date of May 19, 2019 has a special meaning as it is the 100th anniversary of "19 May 1919 which is when Mustafa Kemal Ataturk stepped down to Samsun and launched the Action Phase of our National Struggle which was the commencement of national sovereignty. Victory was reached on the 9th of September with the liberation of İzmir. Asst. Prof. Dr. Göktürk indicated that another reason why it is a special day is because it is the day which is often accepted as Atatürk's birthday. The parade walk during which a number of anthems were chanted by those participating in the walk and the Famagusta public that were encountered on route commenced after Asst. Prof. Dr. Göktürk's speech was completed. The walk came to an end at the city center along with EMU-ATAUM's 100th anniversary of the Natinal Struggle celebrations.

Eastern Mediterranean University Faculty of Health Sciences and Turkish Emergency Medicine Association will be organising "2nd TRNC Ambulance Rally and Emergency Services First Aid Symposium". The symposium will be taking place at Mustafa Afşin Ersoy Hall at 9:00 a.m. on Tuesday, 28 May 2019 with the support

of the Paramedics Association and Cyprus Turkish Paramedics. During the three-day symposium, emergency medicine personnel will be discussing scientific issues and common problems. Following the opening speeches, the following presentations will take place: "Emergency Health Services in the TRNC", "General State of Health

Services", "State of Emergency Services in Hospitals", "122 Ambulance Services", "Trauma", "First Approach to Trauma Patient", "Nursing Approach in Trauma Patient", "Communication in Emergency Health Services", "Emergency Cases Panel 1", "Approach to Dyspnea Patient" and "Approach to Stroke Patient".

The symposium will continue on Wednesday, 29 May 2019 with the following presentations: "Heart Attack", "Diagnosis in Heart Attack", "Treatment of Heart Attack", "Emergency Cases Panel 2", "What is Triage? How is it applied?" and "Approach to Sepsis Patient". The symposium will come to an end after an award ceremony.

TRNC 2nd Ambulance Rally on 27 May

Within the scope of the symposium, at 9:00 a.m. on 27 May 2019, 2nd TRNC Ambulance Rally will be held at EMU Health Sciences Faculty. Despite the fact that the word 'rally' reminds us of the teams speeding with their vehicles on roads, in the ambulance rally, the paramedics will compete against each other using their knowledge and intervention skills. In this competition, the teams will walk to the stations placed at certain points on the campus and intervene in the cases determined by the scenarios. The aim in the said competition is not to finish a task faster than others but to complete it without mistakes.

Courses will be Offered

In addition to the symposium, various courses will be offered at Faculty of Health Sciences. On 27 May 2019, courses on Triage and TYD/İKYD, on 28 May 2019, courses on EKG and vascular access through USG, and on 29 May, patient carrying and stabilisation courses will be offered to those interested. "DISASTER RISK REDUCTION FOR PEOPLE WITH SPECIAL NEEDS WORKSHOP" HELD IN EMU









"Disaster Risk Reduction for People with Special Needs Workshop" organized with the collaboration of Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) Architecture Faculty, Famagusta Municipality and Famagusta Special Education Center was held on the 17th of May, 2019 at 09:30 at Arkın Palm Beach Hotel. The workshop focused on issues such as the reduction of the risks experienced by the people with special needs in an event of disaster, and setting a data base. At the end of the workshop, a future action plan preparation was also dwelled on.

The workshop organized by EMU Education Faculty under the coordinatorship of Assoc. Prof. Dr. Sibel Dinçyürek hosted total of 75 participants consisting of the representatives of TRNC Ministry of Health, Ministry of Education and Culture, Ministry of Labor and Social Security, Ministry of Tourism, Civil Defence Organization and universities. The event commenced with

the music recital performed by the Education Faculty, Fine Arts Education Department, Music Teaching Program students. During the opening speech, Famagusta Special Center Education Director Emirali Evcimen stated that the event was organized to discuss the needs of a very special group of people as well as to set a course for such needs. Evcimen also added that the Famagusta Special Education Center has been caring about the education, needs necessities of people with special needs but the concept of disaster risk reduction for people with special needs is a whole new topic.

EMU Vice Rector for Student Affairs Prof. Dr. Sonuç Zorlu Oğurlu held the floor following Evcimen's speech and mentioned that it is vital for everyone to create awareness in any aspect of their lives. Prof. Dr. Oğurlu continued her speech by saying; "We have many steps to take by the reason of being a small

community. Therefore, we should act as a one". Moreover, Prof. Dr. Oğurlu expressed EMU's pleasure in supporting the event.

Famagusta Mayor İsmail Arter was also among the speakers during the workshop. Arter started his speech by expressing Municipality's excitement on the workshop and continued his words by emphasizing the need of taking precautions for natural disasters as they generally happen unexpectedly. According to Mayor Arter, the importance of the workshop is once more urged on when the latest flood disaster is taken into consideration. Arter ended his speech by stating the need of setting an action plan in collaboration with all units in light of the data gathered from the workshop.

During the speech made by TRNC President Mustafa Akıncı's spouse Meral Akıncı, Mrs. Akıncı expressed her excitement and underlined the significance of the workshop on

taking a first step in the island towards the issue of disaster risk reduction for people with special needs. Meral Akıncı expressed her wish on workshop to be a starting point for setting a course regarding "disasters and special needs" and, emphasized the need for being prepared for possible natural disasters. Mrs. Akıncı also touched on the importance of the statistical analysis which is to be gathered by the virtue of the workshop, as the number of people affected from the natural disasters remains unknown. Akıncı wished a successful and fruitful workshop to all.

Following the opening Yıldız Technical speeches, University Architecture Department staff member Prof. Dr. Aslı Sungur and Assist. Prof. Dr. Ayten Düzkantar from Anadolu University Research Institute for People with Disabilities made presentations. After the presentations, workshop continued with study groups.

Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) Faculty of Law, in collaboration with EMU Law Club operating under the Social and Cultural Activities Directorate, organised a symposium entitled "Individual Application to the Constitutional Court: Recent Developments". The symposium's opening ceremony took place at Mustafa Afşin Ersoy Hall at 9:30 a.m. on Thursday, 23 May 2019. The symposium hosted important names both from the TRNC and the Republic of Turkey.

Delivering an opening speech at the event opening, EMU Faculty of Law Dean Prof. Dr. Metin Gürkanlar welcomed all participants and provided information on 'Individual Application to the Constitutional Court'. Extending his gratitude to all those who supported the organisation of the event, Prof. Dr. Gürkanlar wished all participants a fruitful event. EMU Vice Rector for International Affairs and Promotion Prof. Dr. Cem Tanova was also present at the event opening.

The symposium's first session took place under the moderatorship of EMU Faculty of Law academic staff member Prof. Dr. Turgut Turhan. In the first session, Prof. Dr. Sultan Tahmazoğlu Üzeltürk talked about "The Historical Development of Constitutional Complaint", Prof. Dr. Fazıl Sağlam provided information on 'The scope of the European Convention on Human Rights Foreseen for Individual Application: What does it mean?', Assoc. Prof. Dr. Tolga Şirin talked about 'The Normative and Distinctive Problems of the

Constitutional Court's Individual Application (Constitutional Complaint) Mechanism', and Faculty Member Dr. Gülay Arslan Öncü presented information on 'The Rule of Execution of Ordinary Laws on Individual Appeals to the Constitutional Court'.

The second session took place under the moderatorship of the Retired Member of the Constitutional Court of Turkey Prof. Dr. Fazıl Sağlam. During the said session, the following presentations took place: Prof. Dr. Osman Doğru "Right to Life and Prohibition of Torture", Assist. Prof. Dr. Bezar Eylem Ekinci "To see Gender Inequality in the Interpretation of Fundamental Rights and Freedom", Assist. Prof. Dr. Nazime Beysan "From the Perspective of Gender Inequality, Married Woman's Last Name and Constitutional Court's Judicial Opinion", and Prof. Dr. Gülriz Uygur "Domestic Violence in the Constitutional Court's Judicial View". At the end of the sessions, the participants were presented plaques of appreciation for their contributions and support.

The Symposium Continued on 24 May 2019

The event continued with presentations which took place on Friday, 24 May. The second day of the symposium was attended by TRNC Chief Justice of the Supreme Court Narin Ferdi Şefik and EMU Vice Rector Prof. Dr. Sonuç Zorlu Oğurlu. During the first session which was chaired by the President of the TRNC Supreme Court Şafak Öneri,

Prof. Dr. Hakan Bilgeç's "Freedom of Commercial Expression in Constitutional Court Rulings Given as a Result of Individual Application". The symposium ended after a discussion session.




FAMOUS ACTRESS NEBAHAT ÇEHRE MEETS WITH STUDENTS FROM EMU


"It is Life That Raises Us"
