EMU HOSTS THE 4TH INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE ON BANKING AND FINANCE PERSPECTIVES







Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU), Faculty of Business and Economics, Department of Banking and Finance held the "4th International Conference on Banking and Finance Perspectives" which commenced with an opening ceremony

at the Rauf Raif Denktaş Culture and Congress Center at 10:00 a.m. on Thursday, 2 May 2019. One of the top 250 Programs in the World

In a speech of his own EMU Rector Prof. Dr. Necdet Osam indicated that the university is about to celebrate its 40th year. It features in the 101-150 band of the 2019 Times Higher Education Young University Rankings. In addition, our university's Faculty of Business and Economics is one of the top 250 programs in the world in the field of Business and Economics". 80 Presentations Were Delivered

The event started following the opening speeches with the presentation of one of the keynote speakers of the event, worldrenowned scholar Prof. Dr. Thorsten Beck (Cass Business School, London). In his presentation, Prof. Dr. Beck talked about "Bank Resolution in Practice: Empirical Evidence." As a scholar whose work has been cited 54000 times, Prof. Dr. Beck has also worked as a consultant at the research departments of the World Bank, the European Central Bank, and the Bank of England. The conference then continued with the second keynote speaker Prof. Dr. Duc Khuong Nguyen's (IPAG Business School, Paris) talk on "On the Network of Global Currencies". Prof. Dr. Nyguen is a scholar who has important research on emerging markets, energy economics and finance. The conference continued on Friday, the 3rd of May 2019. The latest research on banking and finance following the global financial crisis as well as opportunities and risks on the global financial market were discussed.

The two-day Conference on Banking and Finance Perspectives hosted 15 parallel sessions during which 80 presentations were delivered by academicians from 25 different countries. Efficient monetary policies that central banks need to implement in in times of financial market fluctuations, volatility models, the importance of inspection and overseeing, Islamic banking, micro finance and capital markets, capital structure of firms, economic development and energy economics were among the discussion topics of the conference.

At the 'Air Signing' event, a 15-meter Atatürk signature will be secured with helium balloons and appear in the sky over the EMU Yasin Düşüner Stadium during the National Struggle Week.

Again, on the same dates, depending on the weather conditions, a Sea Signing event will be held at emu Beach Club.
