UK-based Times Higher Education (THE), one of the most reputable publishers of the worldwide university rankings, announced "The World's Best Young Universities Rankings 2019" (also known as 'Under 50 Rankings'), featuring the list of the world's best universities under the age of 50. In the said rankings, Eastern Mediterranean University is once again the only university from the TRNC. EMU is also amongst the top five universities from Turkey. It is ranked fourth amongst Turkish universities after Sabancı University, Koç University and Bilkent University. EMU is followed by Atılım University which obtained fifth place amongst Turkish universities.

THE uses the performance indicators of teaching quality, scientific research, citations, international outlook and income from the industry when compiling their 'Under 50 Rankings' which was announced on their official website. These are the same performance indicators applied for the THE World University Rankings. As

formerly announced, EMU has the quality of being the only university from the TRNC to feature on the 2019 Times Higher Education World University Rankings. It was among 1100 universities that were featured on the rankings. EMU was placed in the 601-800 band.

EMU REPRESENTED AT THE 20TH ANNIVERSARY CEREMONY OF THE BOLOGNA PROCESS



The Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) was represented by Rector Prof. Dr. Necdet Osam at a ceremony which was attended by more than 150 Rectors from 80 different countries. An academic procession including the Rectors commenced at 16:00 on Monday, the 24th of June 2019. The Rectors then attended a ceremony at the Palazzo Re Enzo to celebrate the 20th anniversary of the Bologna Process. The Bologna Process is a series of ministerial meetings and

agreements between European countries to ensure comparability in the standards and quality of higher-education qualifications. Widely differing education and training systems in Europe have traditionally made it hard for Europeans to use qualifications from one country to apply for a job or a course in another. Increased compatibility between education systems makes it easier for students and job seekers to move within Europe. At the same time, the Bologna reforms help to make European universities and colleges more competitive and attractive to the rest of the world.

More than 1000 people participated in opening of the ceremony at the Palazzo Re Enzo. When he first came to our department, Can stood out of the crowd with his curiosity and perfectionist personality. He would always sit at the forefront of the class and ask many questions. He also asked us how he can help us with the ABET accreditation process. If Ömer Can Akman had not attached so much importance to science and education, we would not be here now. His memory will be kept alive with every student who will be studying in these laboratories.

"A Noble and Noteworthy Behavior"

Expressing their happiness regarding the renewal of the laboratories, Ömer Can Akman's mother Çiğdem Akman put forth that the new equipment was donated by Ömer's sister, father and herself. Akman also thanked EMU Rector Prof. Dr. Necdet Osam and Electrical and Electronic Department Chair Prof. Dr. Hasan Demirel for their support.

Speaking at the ceremony, Dean of the Faculty of Engineering Prof. Dr. Aykut Hocanın, stated that students will learn the basics of engineering with the donated equipment. Prof. Dr. Aykut Hocanın also called the family's behavior as very noble and noteworthy. Prof. Dr. Aykut Hocanın's statement reads as follows: "Can was also a student of mine. He would sit in the front row, listen to the lesson with great interest and ask questions. He said he wanted to become a scientist. He was very sincere and friendly. We are proud to keep his memory alive.

Assist. Prof. Dr. Turgay Bülent Göktürk attended the "100th Year of 19 May 1919 and the International Symposium for National Struggle" organized by Ondokuz Mayıs University and the Turkish Historical Society (TTK) operating under the Republic of Turkey's Higher Institution of Atatürk Culture, Language and History. The symposium was supported by Samsun Governorship and Samsun Metropolitan Municipality. Representing EMU in Samsun, Assist. Prof. Dr. Göktürk delivered a visual presentation of the paper entitled "Turkish Cypriot's Support in the National Struggle and its

Reflections in Turkish Cypriot Media". In the paper, Assist. Prof. Dr. Göktürk put forward how Turkish Cypriots provided moral and material support for the national struggle in Anatolia from 1919 to 1922, despite the oppression of the British Rule and Greek provocation as well as how they travelled to Anatolia to actively support the struggle. At the end of the paper, Assist. Prof. Dr. Göktürk maintained that Turkish Cypriots still uphold the view of Söz Newspaper's headline from the 17th of October 1925: "It is the duty of every Turk to walk the radiant and prosperous road shown

by Atatürk." The symposium was attended by 140 academicians from Turkey, TRNC, Germany, Russia, Poland, Romania, Ukraine, Kazakhstan, Azerbaijan, Tatarstan, Iraq and Albania. During the symposium Turkish Historical Society President Prof. Dr. Refik Turan was presented EMU's traditional Cypriot Lefkara laced plaque by Assist. Prof. Dr. Turgay Bülent Göktürk. During his presentation Assist. Prof. Dr. Göktürk stated; "I am proud to give a voice to the justified pride of Turkish Cypriots on the land where Mustafa Kemal Pasha sparked the flame of the National Struggle."
