Prof. Dr. Deniz İşçiöğlü, Dr. Fazıl Küçük Medicine Faculty Dean Prof. Dr. Nahide Gökçora, Vice Dean Assist. Prof. Dr. Mümtaz Güran, Ministry of Health authorities and press members attended the ceremony.

“We will always be in Collaboration with Governmental Institutions”

EMU Rector Prof. Dr. Aykut Hocanın delivered a speech during the signing ceremony: “I would like to express my sincere thanks to the Ministry of Health for having us here today. Eastern Mediterranean University is a state university. As EMU, we always desire to take steps forward in terms of serving the society in cooperation with the relevant institutions of our state. Today, we will sign very important protocols with the Ministry of Health

EMU SIGNS A COLLABORATION PROTOCOL WITH THE KIBATEK FOUNDATION

A cooperation protocol was signed at the EMU Rector’s Office between Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) and Cyprus-Balkans-Eurasia Turkish Literature Foundation (KIBATEK) on Thursday, 12 November 2020, at 11:00 a.m. EMU Rector Prof. Dr. Aykut Hocaanin and KIBATEK President İsmail Bozkurt signed the said protocol. At the signing ceremony, EMU Vice Rector for Social and Cultural Affairs Assoc. Prof. Dr. Deniz İşçioğlu was also present. The said cooperation protocol aims to preserve, develop and archive cultural heritage in literature, art, history and similar scientific / cultural areas in the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus (TRNC) and overseas surrounding regions and to organize social or cultural projects and events for this purpose.

“Very Important Collaboration”

Speaking at the signing ceremony, EMU Rector Prof. Dr. Aykut Hocaanin said, “Today we are hosting a very important person of culture and we are here for a very important cooperation. Mr. İsmail Bozkurt is a man of culture, who has made very important contributions to the field of culture and arts in the TRNC with his works. By signing a cooperation protocol between EMU and KIBATEK today, we believe that we have achieved a very important stage in the education, research and community service responsibilities of EMU. KIBATEK is a foundation that operates in the fields of culture, art, history and social science.



EMU, as a state university, decided to sign this protocol in order to organize joint events and contribute to science. It is an honor for us to sign this protocol with Mr. İsmail Bozkurt. There was former collaboration between EMU and KIBATEK in different fields. I thank him very much for giving him this opportunity and opening the way for cooperation. I think this will yield very fruitful outcomes”.

“The Birthplace of KIBATEK is EMU”

KIBATEK President İsmail Bozkurt said, “Indeed, KIBATEK is a product of EMU. Because KIBATEK emerged as a product of EMU Center for Cyprus Studies’ (EMU-CCS) work. It started with a symposium in 1998 when I was the EMU-CCS President. Then it developed into a foundation. This is the birthplace. Therefore, we will be very happy to work together with our place of birth within the

framework of a protocol. I am sure there is a lot to do. KIBATEK is a foundation of the TRNC. In addition, we have representative offices in approximately 30 different countries. Therefore, it is a formation that has international relations as much as possible. We have international symposiums every year. Our last concrete work is a 5-volume History of Turkish Cypriot Literature. It is the product of a few years of work. I think it is a study contributed by about 100 academicians and it is indeed a study that reflects the Turkish Cypriot Literature from all aspects. I think the said work can be the starting point of our joint projects with EMU. I hope the protocol will be beneficial for both parties,” he said.

Following the signing ceremony, KIBATEK President İsmail Bozkurt presented EMU Rector Prof. Dr. Aykut Hocaanin a signed copy of the 5-volume History of Turkish Cypriot Literature.

LATEST EMU ART EVENT – GÜNAY GÜZELGÜN EXHIBITION

Our future plans include a book on all the artworks of Günay Güzelgün. Even though Güzelgün is not



in the public eye, as can be seen in her work, she is rather sensitive, productive, and has a quite colorful world who is also humorous. Still holding to the village life and Cypriot roots, Güzelgün tries to reflect these into her work. It is an honor to work with Günay Güzelgün".

Artist's first solo exhibition was held in January 2020 within the scope of the collaboration between EMU and Rüstem Bookstore. Artist also has another solo exhibition on photography. She still lives in İskele and continues her art career.

What is the Othello International Motion Art Biennial?

Othello International Motion Art Biennial is organized by EMU Communication Faculty and financially supported by the Eastern Mediterranean University. The biennial takes its name from the Othello Castle in Famagusta, which is mentioned in Shakespeare's famous play, and symbolizes and emphasizes the relationship of the city with culture and arts.

With the awareness that universities' support towards culture, arts and creativity is one of their important roles, the main motivation of the Biennial is to bring together both national and international design and film students who are on their way to become artists, and by encouraging young artists to reflect their own thoughts by using animated art. It aims to create a productive and motivating environment where ideas and experiences can be shared.

The main purpose is to help cinema and visual communication design students, who can produce original ideas with motion arts and contribute to the field with different perspectives, put their theoretical knowledge into practice, to contribute to the development of short film production in the international arena, and to ensure that the audience meets short films.

EMU DR. FAZIL KÜÇÜK MEDICINE FACULTY CLINICAL PRACTICE CENTER INSPECTIONS COMPLETED



The inspection of the Clinical Application Center planned to be opened under the Eastern Mediterranean University Dr. Fazıl Küçük Medicine Faculty has been completed. The center, recently inspected by the authorities of the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus (TRNC) Ministry of Health, will provide outpatient services and polyclinical services in different areas. Within the framework of the cooperation protocol signed with the TRNC Ministry of Health, in the Dr. Fazıl Küçük Faculty of Medicine Clinical Practice Center, support will be received from the Famagusta State Hospital for advanced examination, blood and radiological tests, inpatient treatment, surgery and intensive care services when deemed necessary.

Stating that the Clinical Practice Center would provide important services in terms of both education and health, EMU Dr. Fazıl Küçük Medicine Faculty Dean Prof. Dr. Nahide Gökçora emphasized that the center would also play an important role in increasing the clinical skills of the students. Prof. Dr. Gökçora added that the Center will start accepting patients as soon as possible.

Prof. Dr. Gökçora stated that they will bring together the people of Famagusta and the academic staff of EMU Dr. Fazıl Küçük Medicine Faculty and emphasized that they will enable the public to benefit from the services of the center. Prof. Dr. Gökçora also added that they will provide opportunities for students for outpatient training within the scope of the introductory clinical practice lessons offered every year at the Faculty of Medicine.

With these feelings and thoughts, we commemorate the Great Leader Atatürk with love, respect and longing once again on the 82nd anniversary of his passing, and bow before his high memory.” Assist.Prof. Dr. Göktürk also included in his statement the sentences written by the Mujahids of Cyprus about Atatürk. The ceremony then continued with a moment of silence and

the Turkish National Anthem singing in unison accompanied by sirens at 09:05 a.m.

Instead, there is studying and learning, reflecting what you have learned to life, and developing and achieving without leaving the right path. With these feelings,

I bow respectfully before the honorable memory of Gazi Mustafa Kemal Atatürk. Great Atatürk, our love, respect and gratitude to you will increase day by day and will continue forever.”
