Within the scope of the joint art activities of Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) and Rüstem Bookstore, Günay Güzelgün's second exhibition titled "The Heart's Eye" will be launched at Rüstem Bookstore on Monday, 9 November 2020, at 18:30 a.m. by the president of the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus (TRNC) Ersin Tatar. About 80 watercolor and pastel works of the artist will be displayed in the exhibition. These works, like her first exhibition, mostly consist of pieces from the artist's diary, freelance works she painted for herself, her experiments with colors, research she conducted and set herself free. The exhibition will be open to visitors between 10:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. from 9 to 21 November 2020, except Sunday.

The preface written by the editors included the following statement: "Many theoretic or applied studies have been done on grammar from past to present and, the ways of using grammar within the educational environment is discussed. The notion of how to teach grammar is approached from grammatical and pedagogical aspects both in Turkey and international platforms. In general, constructivist and metacognitive oriented views were put forward in existing programs and these opinions were tried to be reflected in the curriculum. The book that you are holding is based on a wide literature review conducted both nationally and internationally regarding the grammar teaching methods throughout the history. We would like to thank each of the writers of the book who have contributed by writing chapters for the book. With this book, our desire is to address the gap in the literature". During his speech on the contents of the book, EMU Education Faculty Dean Prof. Dr. Ahmet Pehlivan stated that this book, which was prepared as a result of long efforts, will contribute to the re-discussion of grammar teaching in terms of academicians, from what angles

teachers should look at grammar, and to teacher candidates in the faculty.

"A New Field of Discussion"

As Prof. Dr. Pehlivan, the book aims to shed light on the discussions on grammar teaching, new educational models and how grammar teaching is applied in different parts of the world and continued by saying: "Book discusses grammar teaching models in our country, in Turkey and all around the world. In the exhibition, where mostly the unknown aspects of the artist are to be revealed, there are pieces oriented towards nature, despite Güzelgün's human-centered Leaving an anthropocentricapproach, the artist attempts to come to terms with the environment, life and the universe by focusing on the human being in daily life and nature and the animals accompanying them. The human does not have a privileged structure and importance in her work. S/he exists in nature and is a part of it like other creatures. The human gains meaning and comes to life with nature and environment in her works.

"For Those Who Look and Know How to See"


Making a statement about the exhibition, EMU Art Coordinator and Exhibition Curator Zehra Şonya said, "It can be said that Güzelgün uses color in her paintings in a dominant and evocative manner and therefore has a colorist understanding. " The artist, who used to apply vivid colors in blocks to flat surfaces, moves towards

an impressionist style with fast and broken brush strokes, spots and dots in later periods, but also towards an expressive effect due to the intensity of emotion she creates with colors."

Pointing out that Güzelgün's paintings appear before us, emerging from an unforced and undifferentiated inner structure, a childish and pure world, and a state of emotion and energy ready to explode at any moment, Sonya said "It leads us to a place in Gunay's colorful world and makes us smile most of the time. We can say that life itself is recreated with the heart's eye in Gunay's colorful world and brought to our attention. For those who look and know how to see."

Who is Günay Güzelgün?

She was born in 1944 in the village of Luricina in Cyprus. She graduated from Ankara Gazi Education Institute, Department of Painting in 1968. She settled in Iskele and worked as a teacher for many years. The first solo exhibition of the artist's works, who



participated in many group exhibitions between 1982 and 1999, was opened in January 2020 within the scope of EMU-Rüstem Bookstore joint projects. In addition, the artist, who also deals with photography, has a personal exhibition on this subject. Güzelgün still lives and continues her works in Iskele.

EMU RECTOR PROF. DR. AYKUT HOCANIN RELEASED A MESSAGE ON THE ANNIVERSARY OF GREAT LEADER ATATÜRK'S DEATH



Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) Rector Prof. Dr. Aykut Hocanin has released a message on the occasion of the 82nd anniversary of the death of the Great Leader Mustafa Kemal Atatürk. Prof. Dr. Hocanin's statement reads as follows:

"We commemorate with respect Great Leader Mustafa Kemal Atatürk, Founder of the Republic of Turkey, on the 82nd anniversary of his death and express our gratitude for his legacy.

The best way to commemorate Atatürk is to understand and explain him correctly. The importance of 10 of November is great in terms of correctly understanding Atatürk's 57-year life, his struggle, what he brought to the Turkish nation and what he wanted to do. In this context, we should explain well what the Kemalist Thought System is to our youth, who are the guarantors of our future.

The savior and founding leader of the Turkish Nation said "My spiritual heritage is science and wisdom ... If those who want to adopt me after me, if they accept the guidance of reason and knowledge on this basic axis,

they will become my spiritual inheritors." In this way, he put forward the necessity of basing every activity on reason and science and placed the Atatürk Thought System on the logic of reason and science.

Atatürk entrusted the future to the youth, whom he described as "all my hope", and emphasized that standing on the path of enlightenment is to be defeated. There is no rest on the way of independence and civilization. Instead, there is studying and learning, reflecting what you have learned to life, and developing and achieving without leaving the right path.

Science is the most genuine guide for everything in the world, for materiality, for spirituality, for life, for success," said the Great Leader Atatürk. We will continue to follow the motto "Seeking a guide outside of science is absurdity, ignorance and heresy."

With these feelings, I bow respectfully in front of the honorable memory of Gazi Mustafa Kemal Atatürk. Great Atatürk, our love, respect and gratitude to you will increase day by day and will continue forever."


GREAT LEADER MUSTAFA KEMAL ATATÜRK TO BE COMMEMORATED IN EMU

At 12:00 p.m., EMU-ATAUM Chair Assist. Prof. Dr. Turgay Bülent Göktürk will give a conference under the title "Atatürk in Turkish and World Press in 1938". The conference will be broadcast live on EMU TV and Microsoft Teams.





EMU –ATAUM RELEASED A STATEMENT ON THE ANNIVERSARY OF GREAT LEADER ATATÜRK'S DEATH

Eastern Mediterranean University Atatürk Research and Application Center (EMU-ATAUM) Chair Assist. Prof. Dr. Turgay Bülent Göktürk released a statement titled "THE ADDRESS OF MUJAHID TO ATA" on the 82nd anniversary of the death of Great Leader Mustafa Kemal Atatürk. Asst. Prof. Dr. Turgay Bülent Göktürk's statement reads as follows:

"One of the world's most distinguished points in history, the epic War of Independence created by him, miracle of Turkey, belongs to the Great Leader Atatürk. Savior of the Turkish nation and the Republic of Turkey's founder Ataturk, in his short life of fifty-seven years did a great job.

He started the National Struggle in Anatolia in order to save the nation that was destined to be destroyed and and became the winner of the War of Independence and the leader of the torch of freedom in the world by turning the nation into a single force.

He established a modern republic on the burned and destroyed motherland and ensured good relations with countries he had fought against to turn the Republic of Turkey into a state which had everyone's respect. Besides, he realized the reforms that form the basis of modernization hand in hand with his nation.

The Turkish Cypriot people, an indispensable part of this Nation, saw Mustafa Kemal Atatürk as a savior and acted in line with his teachings. In this context, Ataturk's reforms were adopted simultaneously with the Republic of Turkey, without any force. Together with the free and independent Turkish Republic Northern Cyprus, which was established 37 years ago, it has shown at every opportunity that it is determined to keep Atatürk's principles and reforms alive forever.

The clearest example of this is that exactly 55 years ago, on 10 November, 1965, our Mujahids sent messages to the Magusa Sancaktar titled "On the occasion of the

Death of the Eternal Leader Atatürk":

Atatürk does not die. You have proven in Sakarya what the Turks can do in times of need. You are not dead, we are at your command and we will see the victory of the Turkish Cypriots in Sakarya again.

We Karakol region Mujahids will follow in your footsteps and teach the enemies what it means to oppose the Turk. We find this strength and power in the noble blood in our veins. How happy is the one who says I am a Turk... Karakol Mujahids"

We all know that our mujahids crowned their promise to the Great Leader with the Independent TRNC.


