THREE THOUSAND SAPLINGS AS NEW YEAR GIFTS

Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) will be gifting an olive sapling, one of the symbols of the Cyprus Island, to all its staff members with the intention of contributing the nature. Distribution of three thousand olive saplings has begun.

The project that aims to support the nature started with the planting of four olive saplings to the Prof. Dr. Erdil Rıza Tuncer Square located between the buildings of EMU Faculty of Engineering. The planting session took place on 14 December 2020 - Monday at 09:30. EMU Rector Prof. Dr. Aykut Hocanın, Vice Rector for Academic Affairs Prof. Dr. Hasan Demirel, Vice Rector for Social and Cultural Affairs Assoc. Prof. Dr. Deniz İşçioğlu and Vice Rector for Administrative and Technical Affairs Assoc. Prof. Dr. Serhan Şensoy planted the saplings. EMU Environment Affairs Director Ali Ertay and staff members of the unit were also present during the planting session.

A NEW BOOK FROM EMU ACADEMIC STAFF AT THE NATIONAL STRUGGLE AND MARTYRS WEEK: "MUJAHIDS NARRATING"

Mediterranean Eastern University Atatürk Research and Application Center (EMU-ATAUM) President Assist. Prof. Dr. Turgay Bülent Göktürk and EMU-ATAUM academic staff member Süheyla Göktürk finalised the project they have been working on for nearly ten years with a book called "The Mujahids Narrating". Developed within the scope of December 21-25, National Struggle and Martyrs Week, the said book was presented to EMU Rector Prof. Dr. Aykut Hocanın, Vice Rectors Prof. Dr. Hasan Demirel and Assoc. Prof. Dr. Deniz İşçioğlu.by Assist. Prof. Dr. Turgay Bülent Göktürk and academic staff member Süheyla Göktürk on Friday, 18 December, 2020, at 09:00 a.m.

26 Mujahids Included

Providing information about the project, EMU-ATAUM President Assist. Prof. Dr. Turgay Bülent Göktürk stated that the project was carried out based on the project work on "Interview with the Mujahids" conducted by the undergraduate students taking the courses they offer and the interviews of both academics with the mujahids. Assist. Prof. Dr. Göktürk added that in this process, a total of 814 interviews with mujahids were conducted between 2008 and 2018 and were transcribed and classified as a result of a long efforts. He

stated that the texts were transferred to the computer and the five thousand pages of written text were thoroughly revised. As a result, Asst. Prof. Dr. Göktürk stated that since it is not possible to turn all of these into a book at the same time for technical and material reasons, it is deemed appropriate to publish the study in volumes in the process. As a start, the first volume of the "Mujahids Narrating" series, which includes our 26 valuable Mujahids, who fought in the Struggle for Existence, including the Founding President of the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus (TRNC) Rauf Raif Denktas, the 3rd President of the TRNC Dervis Eroğlu, Hakkı Atun, Ertuğrul Hasipoğlu, İsmail Bozkurt, Yılmaz Bora, and Vural Türkmen, were included in the first volume of the said book. Assist. Prof. Dr. Turgay Bülent Göktürk expressed his gratitude to Turkish Ambassador Ali Murat Basceri for his support in the publication of the book.

"The Struggle for Existence will be Transferred to Future Generations"

Sen. Inst. Süheyla Göktürk said "The main purpose of the project is to once again commemorate our Mujahids, who have enabled us to live freely today by sacrificing their lives to make these lands a homeland, and who could not live their own youth while doing so. The



project also aims to guide our youth to understand the conditions under which their ancestors carried out the Turkish Cypriot National Struggle and most importantly to convey the struggle of the Turkish Cypriots for freedom to future generations with documents and the expressions of those who experienced it. The list of students who contributed to the preparation of the first volume has also been included in the book.

On this occasion, Assist. Prof. Dr. Turgay Bülent Göktürk and Sen. Inst. Süheyla Göktürk expressed their feelings of gratitude to all our martyrs who lost their lives in the Turkish Cypriot National Struggle, and also their wish that the project reaches the targeted goals and become a guide for future generations.

Who is Assoc. Prof. Dr. Hakkı Yırtıcı?

Graduated from İstanbul Technical University Faculty of Architecture, Assoc. Prof. Dr. Hakkı Yırtıcı completed his master's and doctoral studies at the same university. His book "Spatial Organisation of Contemporary Capitalism" was published by Bilgi University Publications in 2005. Focusing on power, space, language and psychoanalysis, Assoc. Prof. Dr. Yırtıcı gives lectures on the reproduction of power and space, modernization and daily life practices, cinema and architecture, and the history of urban modernization. He regularly writes on the urban and architectural problems in the "Gazete DuvaR" internet newspaper.

Assoc. Prof. Dr. Yırtıcı briefly summarizes his presentation titled "From the Immemorial Space to the House, Its States of Being" prepared for the EMU Faculty of Architecture: "The house has its own states. The states depend on the variety, time and circumstances. It is the object of change throughout history, but it is also our only constant. We attribute a special meaning to the house as an interior against the outside. But it is also the object of political economy, the favorite of the real estate market. Every change in the forces that establish daily life is reflected in the house, reconstructing its meaning and our lives, over and over again.
