



Mediterranean University (EMU) has once again included in the Global Ranking of Academic Subjects 2020 of Chinabased ShanghaiRanking, an independent organisation which has been the official publisher of the Academic Ranking of the World Universities since 2009.

In the said rankings, Eastern Mediterranean University has been ranked 46th in the Hospitality **Tourism** and Management Category. As the only university from Cyprus appearing on the said list, Eastern Mediterranean University also the top ranking university amongst the universities of Turkey. EMU appeared within the 76-100 band in the aforesaid category in the rankings of the former year. The only universities from Turkey, apart from EMU, qualifying for the aforesaid list in the Hospitality and Tourism Management Category Akdeniz University appearing within the 101-150 band and Anadolu University appearing within the 201-300 band.

In addition to all, EMU has become the only university appearing in ShanghaiRanking's

com/

Economics Category in the TRNC. The university which appears within the 401-500 band is also the second ranking university in Turkey in the said category. Having appeared within the 201-300 band, Koç University has become the top ranking university in Turkey in the Economics Category.

"I chose to come to EMU because I am learning Turkish as a second language, so I knew being in Cyprus would help my learning, and it has. # EMU DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATIONAL SCIENCES NICOSIA MASTER'S PROGRAM APPLICATIONS COMMENCE



Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU), Faculty of Education, Department of Educational Sciences has continued to expand in Nicosia with 3 Master's Programs. Applications for the Fall 2020 Semester Nicosia Master's Programs have begun.

Deadline for online applications for the Guidance and Psychological Counseling Program, EMU Department of Educational Sciences, Educational Administration and Supervision Program, Education Program and Teaching Master's Programs at the EMU Educational Sciences Department, is the 15th of September 2020. Applications can be made in person between 17 and 18 September 2020. The master's programs in question will be in Turkish with thesis, and will take place at the Atatürk Teachers Academy from the 21st September 2020, between the hours of 16:30 - 19:30. In an effort to provide convenience to those that live in or around Lefkosa, individuals who work long hours or cannot travel to Famagusta due to distance, Master's Programs will be provided in Nicosia with the same admission criteria as those at EMU.

### Guidance and Psychological Counseling Master's Program:

In this program there are 4 compulsory and 4 elective courses, making 8 courses

in total to succeed in, with an area thesis to complete. Students who have completed an undergraduate program in the area of Guidance and Psychological counseling, with a grade average of over 2.50 may apply for this program. Candidates applying from other programs will be admitted to the preparation program. Any experience in the field will be considered an advantage among applying candidates

### **Educational Administration and Supervision Masters Program**

In this program there are 4 compulsory and 4 elective courses, making 8 courses in total to succeed in, with a thesis to complete.

Candidates must possess a bachelor's degree in any teaching program. For applications from other areas, a pedagogic formation document must be presented. Anyone without a teaching certificate will be admitted to a scientific preparation program.


### **Education Programs and Teaching Masters Program:**

In this program there are 4 compulsory and 4 elective courses, making 8 courses in total to succeed in, with an area thesis to complete. Candidates must possess a bachelor's degree in any teacher education program. Candidates applying from different areas that demonstrate

a teaching qualification (pedagogic formation document) may apply for this program. Those who do not possess a teaching certificate, will be admitted to a scientific preparation program identified by the department. Any experience in teaching will be considered an advantage among applying candidates. All applicants must have a minimum grade average of 2.50 over 4 from their bachelor education. Republic of Turkey candidates must have a minimum of 55 standard points from the LES examination. ## EMU GRADUATE ONUR ÖNEL BOOK MAKES BEST SELLERS LIST IN SHORT TIME



Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) Faculty of Engineering, Department of Industrial Engineering graduate has compiled his working life experiences in a book. Even though the sales of the 368 page book published by Nobel Scientific Works just started last week, it has succeeded in being

among the best sellers in bookstores such as D&R.

The novel-like book explains the difficulties of working life, by holding a mirror and explaining workers' thoughts and feelings to their employer. A more detailed explanation of the content is as follows: The book was initially been written as a result of an unhappy journey on the way to work and, came to life in virtue of a realistic approach to the reasons lying beneath that unhappiness. When the operational problems in private sector enterprises are analyzed, it will be seen that the problem stems from the lack of institutionalization and the employment of virtuous people in key positions of the enterprise.

In this case, when the problems are reached according to the stage where those problems become inexhaustible; the increasing inefficiency will not be stopped and the enterprise will move rapidly towards a dangerous point of return. This will be a breaking point for the business, whatever the business does after this stage, it will not be able to stop the relapse. This situation, which will turn into a vicious cycle and then vortex, will eventually swallow the functioning of the institution. While all this is happening, every element against the truth; undoubtedly be a supporter of this relapse. Therefore, most businesses close shutters before they can see the 2nd and 3rd generations.

This book does not include persistently tried and failed methods. It associates and illustrates issues with life experiences. The book has a unique place due to its nature that describes the events by mirroring them and gives messages that raise awareness. These messages also reflect the thoughts and feelings of employees which they want to say but do not or are not able to express. The ultimate aim all of the given messages and solution methods, without exception, is to include realistic, feasible and equitable results. At the end of the day, the winner is; "virtuous people" and "company owners who want to do business more accurately than yesterday" will be the reason for the existence of institutions.

This book, inspired by the real situations and experiences, will be a support for current employees, a bibliography for those who will just start their business life, and a way out to senior management. In order to be admitted to the English Language Teaching Doctorate Program, interested candidates must have a Master's Degree in the related field and must meet the acceptance criteria set by the Institute of Graduate Studies and Research.
