TRNC PRIME MINISTER ERSIN TATAR VISITS EMU



Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus (TRNC) Prime Minister Ersin Tatar and his committee visited Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) Rector Prof. Dr. Aykut Hocanın. The meeting that focused on COVID-19 pandemic and the new academic semester took place on the 21st of August, 2020 – Friday at 13:00.

EMU'S NEW ONLINE REGISTRATION SYSTEM

Moreover, a tuition fee loan in favorable terms with our students is also available. Certain collaborations are initiated with various banks in regards to the online payments of tuition fees in installments. Students will be able to benefit from the services once the setup process is done and ready.
