## TRNC MINISTER OF FINANCE OLGUN AMCAOĞLU VISITS EMU



Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus (TRNC) Minister of Finance Olgun Amcaoğlu paid a visit to emu Rector Prof. Dr. Aykut Hocanın. The meeting about the COVID-19 pandemic and the new academic year was held on Thursday, 27 August, 2020, at 11:00 a.m.

In a statement made to the press members before the meeting, Prof. Dr. Hocanin expressed his pleasure regarding the visit of the Minister of Finance and noted that they will exchange views on new measures taken and to be taken during the pandemic process. Referring to the results of the Higher Education Institutions Exam (YKS), Prof. Dr. Hocanin stated that 26% more students have been placed in EMU programs compared to the former year. Underlining that EMU has achieved great success, Prof. Dr. Hocanin explained that EMU has the highest number of equivalent students amongst all TRNC universities. Prof. Dr. Hocanin noted that the task of EMU as a result of the aforesaid student placements, through taking the necessary measures, is to ensure that students register. Prof. Dr. Hocanin emphasized that

the health of the staff and students is the top priority. TRNC Minister of Finance Olgun Amcaoğlu stated in his speech that both parties have come together to discuss the steps and measures to be taken in line with the latest developments. Minister Amcaoğlu stated that the support they have put in as the Ministry of Finance since the beginning of this period will continue.

Drawing attention to the importance of the tourism sector and higher education for the TRNC economy, Minister Amcaoğlu stated that steps have been taken for the survival

## EMU BECOMES THE TOP UNIVERSITY WITHIN THE TRNC INCREASING THE NUMBER OF STUDENT PLACEMENTS



According to the student placement results of the 2020-2021 Higher Education Institutions Examination (YKS) announced on Wednesday, 26 August 2020, Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) has become the top university among the universities of the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus increasing the student placements both in terms of number and percentage compared to the previous year. A total of 1,635 students have been placed in EMU for the 2020-2021 Academic Year. While there has been an increase of 7.43% in YKS student placement results in TRNC

universities compared to the previous year, it is worth mentioning that there has been an increase of 26.06% in the number of students placed at EMU. EMU also became the most preferred university considering the equivalent number of students. In his statement on the subject, EMU Rector Aykut Hocanin expressed his satisfaction with the remarkable success achieved and said, "I would like to thank all our staff, especially the Promotion Committee and the Promotion Office of our University. I wish that the 2020-2021 Academic Year brings positive outcomes for our country."

Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus (TRNC) Member of the Parliament representing Democratic Party Serdar Denktaş, Member of the Parliament and Party Chairperson Fikri Ataoğlu and Former Member of the Parliament Dr. Mustafa Arabacıoğlu visited Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU). ### "The Number of Students Placed at EMU Increased"

Speaking at the press conference held before the meeting, EMU Rector Prof. Dr. Aykut Hocanin stated that they are happy to be hosting valuable politicians at EMU. Prof. Dr. Hocanin noted that according to the placement results of the 2020-2021 Higher Education Institutions Examination (YKS), EMU, as a state university, has increased the number of students placed compared to the previous year. Prof. Dr. Hocanin stated that the increase in the total number of students placed at EMU as a result of YKS is 26% compared to last year.

Prof. Dr. Hocanin also put forth that as a result of the YKS, a total of 1,635 students have been placed in EMU.

### "We Are Getting Ready For The New Academic Year"

Drawing attention to the fact that EMU ranks first in the number of students placed with equivalent grades through the YKS results, Prof. Dr. Hocanın said "In addition to our scholarship programs, our non-scholarship programs were also preferred. This is an indication of the interest shown towards our university's programs ". Prof.

Dr. Hocanin emphasized that the pandemic process has caused difficulties in higher education, but EMU is continuing to ensure the necessary preparations for the 2020-2021 Academic Year.

In his speech, Member of the Parliament from Democrat Party Serdar Denktaş stated that they are happy to be visiting EMU, which is the first university of the island. Denktaş stated that they are visiting the institution to extend their congratulations to the new administration of EMU and to exchange ideas.

Eastern Mediterranean University Atatürk Research and Application Center (EMU-ATAUM) Chair Assist. Prof. Dr. Turgay Bülent Göktürk released a statement on the 98th anniversary of the 30th of August Victory Day. Asst. Prof. Dr. Turgay Bülent Göktürk's statement reads as follows:

Today, as we are celebrating the 98th anniversary of Victory Day, the day when the last step of the Action Phase of our National Liberation Struggle started by Great Leader Atatürk by stepping into Samsun. Today is the day when a nation succeeded in the National Liberation Struggle, which started with the motto "Either independence or death ..." despite all the difficulties, and saved the country from the imperialist occupation forces. In Atatürk's own words, 'The August 30 Victory is the most important turning point in Turkish History. Our national history is

full of great, wonderful victories, but I do not remember a pitched battle that was as decisive as the victory of the Turkish Nation here, which was absolutely effective in giving a new trend not only to our history but to world history. Obviously, the new Turkish state, the foundation of the young Republic of Turkey, was strengthened here, its existence was immortalised here.'

After the successful conclusion of the "Great Offensive", also known as the Commander-in-Chief Pitched Battle in international literature, as the chief commanders of both armies were actually on the battlefield, Greek armies were followed up to Izmir; With the liberation of Izmir on 9 September 1922, Turkish lands were completely cleared from the occupation forces. With this victory, it was once again shown to the world that there is no power to break the will of the Turkish

Nation to exist. In unity and solidarity, our nation, which has given an unforgettable lesson with the August 30 Victory to those who want to erase it from the stage of history, has made the whole world accept once again that it will never compromise its independence and freedom and that it will exist forever.

On this meaningful day, one should remember the Supreme Leader's words: "Victory is for those who can say "Victory is mine". Success is for those who can begin saying "I will succeed" and say "I have succeeded" in the end." We commemorate all our martyrs who fell to the ground for the sake of making this land a homeland, especially the Great Commander-in-Chief Gazi Mustafa Kemal Atatürk and his comrades in arms, with feelings of mercy, gratitude and respect. Happy 30 August Victory Day to you all. "
