The application dates for the education scholarship directed to Turkish and foreign national students had been decided for Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) 2020-2021 Academic Year Fall Term Postgraduate programs. At the statement made by the EMU Institute of Graduate Studies and Research, it was said: “The student candidates has to declare their scholarship requests on the postgraduate program online application form at <https://applyonline.emu.edu.tr/grad> website. The applications should be fully completed until 16th August 2020 for the

candidates that will be placed in the first list. The results for scholarship applications will be declared on 4th September 2020 from the university website (<https://www.emu.edu.tr>).”

## %100 Scholarship Opportunity

At the statement, it was mentioned that new candidates can be suggested at the second list instead of the candidates who were placed in the first list but decided not to register. The final date for the extra application duration to be placed on the second list is declared as 6th September 2020. The following information

about the scholarship application conditions took place at the statement: “1 Turkish student who registers on any of the masters programs for the first time and has an undergraduate CGPA equivalent of 3.00 out of 4.00 might receive a 100% and 2 students might receive 50% postgraduate education scholarship. 1 Turkish and 1 foreign national student who registers on any of the doctoral programs for the first time and has an undergraduate CGPA equivalent of 3.00 out of 4.00 might receive 100% or two students might receive 50% separately. EMU Physics and Chemistry Departments have completed their preparations for an assertive undergraduate education with its quality academic staff, modern laboratories and physical infrastructure equipment. The students who will register at the EMU Physics and Chemistry Departments programs will study at a magnificent campus and an international faculty that has took the first place in Cyprus on Nature Index 2020.

### Wide Career Opportunities

In case they fulfill the requirements for application conditions of Physical Sciences and Higher Technology Institutes, the alumni of Physics and Chemistry Departments can own an academic career by undertaking masters and doctoral studies. The alumni of Physics and Chemistry Departments also have the opportunity to work as a physics or chemistry teacher at public, private sector or foundation schools by participating at the Teaching Profession Specialization Program or Pedagogic Formation Programs.



The Physics Program alumni can work at all of the private, university (example: GÜNAM-METU) or public institutions and establishments that conducts research on energy sources (solar, wind, hydroelectric energy etc.). Since there is an obligation to have a health physics employee at hospitals on the field of health physics, the alumni also have the opportunity to work in this field.

After completing the medical physics postgraduate program, the alumni has job opportunities at health institutions as specialists (especially at the radiology departments of the hospitals). The alumni can participate at job security specialist education and work as "Job Security Specialist" in various sectors after completing the written examination successfully. At the same time, the alumni can work as Physicist at different units of nuclear power plants, particle accelerators, oil exploration and natural gas industry. The alumni can find jobs at telecommunication field (especially on electromagnetic waves), weapon industry, fields that laser technology is used, the

institutions that work on electronic and industry and banks.

The Chemistry Department alumni can work as quality control responsible, chemist, administrator and consultant at production fields of food, water, paint, medicine, textile, oil, polymer, energy, biotechnology etc. industries. The alumni can work at health, legal medicine laboratory, security, environmental pollution parameters measuring, production development, and standardization etc. fields. The alumni can provide consultancy, sales and marketing services for technical equipment that are used at analysis and manufacturing at the chemistry field. The alumni can work as "Job Security Specialist" at the chemistry industry after obtaining the necessary education and certificates.
