EMU SUCCESFULLY COMPLETES ISO 9001, ISO 10002 AND ISO 45001 INSPECTIONS



Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU), successfully completed ISO 9001:2015 Ouality Management System (2nd Surveillance Audit), ISO 10002:2018 Student Satisfaction Management System (2nd Surveillance Audit) and ISO 45001:2018 Occupational Health and Safety Management System (Recertification) inspections conducted by the Turkish Standards Institution (TSE) between 29 November -3 December, 2021. The audit inspecting the work of the 43-person quality team from the Total Quality Management Directorate who have been working on management system process since 2015 lasted 5 days.

The Evaluation Results were shared with the Participants during the Final Meeting

An opening meeting was held on Monday, 29th of November, at 09:00. Chief Auditor Mehmet Ali Göksel (ISO 9001Quality Management System), Chief Auditor Gökçen Bircan Değerliyurt (ISO 10002 Student Satisfaction Management System and ISO 45001 Occupational Health and Safety Management System) and Audit Officer Metin Turan (ISO 9001 Quality Management System, ISO 10002 Student Satisfaction Management System and ISO 45001 Occupational Health and Safety Management System) attended the meeting on behalf of the Turkish Standards Institution. On the other

hand, vice Rector for Administrative and Technical Affairs Prof. Dr. Serhan Şensoy and vice Rector's Office for Administrative and Technical Affairs Coordinators Hasan Kavaz and Mahmut Dağtekin, Quality Representatives of all units (43 personnel) and Management Systems Consultant Latif Sakar attended the meeting on behalf of EMU.

The inspection team audited the units from three different branches, both in terms of documentation and infrastructure. In addition to the management system activities, academic reviews and evaluations were also made during the 5-day audit. A Final Meeting was held on Friday, 3 December 2021, with the participation of individuals who attended with opening meeting. Inspection outcomes were shared by the Inspection Team during the final meeting.

"EMU Serves as a Model"

Making a statement on inspection results regarding the Quality Management System, Chief Auditor Mehmet Ali Dönmez expressed that the Quality Management System in EMU was well established and reflected on the field, and that the practices in the units were carried out in an exemplary manner. Apart from the Quality Management System, Dönmez stated that EMU was the first

institution in the TRNC to receive the Safe Education Institution Certification regarding the COVID-19 Pandemic and, that EMU has successfully completed the inspection process without any setbacks.

"Personnel adapted the Management Systems"

Chief Auditor Gökçen Bircan Değerliyurt information the Student shared on Satisfaction Management System Occupational Health and Safety Management System inspection outcomes. Putting out that both systems are adapted by the members of the personnel, Değerliyurt stated that the university received positive feedback, especially in the Occupational Health and Safety Management System inspection for the institution's importance work conducted in terms of pandemic measures. Değerliyurt stated that no minor or major non-compliance was detected regarding either of the two management systems. Audit Officer Metin Turan also conveyed that he appreciated the interests and efforts of the people he interviewed regarding the investigations he conducted during the audit, and that he saw good examples.

"We Wish to Continue Being a Leader"

Following the outcomes shared by the audit team, vice Rector Prof. Dr. Serhan Sensoy made a statement on behalf of EMU and expressed his happiness on the results of the inspection. Vice Rector Prof. Dr. Sensoy thanked the 43-person Quality Team which conducted the management system studies and Latif Sakar who provided consultancy and training to the Quality Team. Prof. Dr. Şensoy also said that they want to continue to break new ground in the TRNC and that they want to be a green university. For this reason, he stated that they aim to be the first university in the TRNC certified by TSE by fulfilling the requirements of ISO 14001:2015 Environmental Management System.

EMU FACULTY OF ARCHITECTURE ATTENDS MOBBIG 51 MEETING AND MEK11

Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) Faculty of Architecture, Department of Architecture attended the 51st Communication Group Meeting of the Architecture Schools' Department Heads (MOBBIG 51) and Architectural Education Convention (MEK11) held in Eskişehir.

At the 51st MOBBIG and MEK11 meetings, hosted by the Union of Chambers of Turkish Engineers and Architects (TMMOB), the Chamber of Architects and Eskişehir Technical University, EMU was represented by the Department of Architecture Chair Prof. Dr. Resmiye Alpar Atun.

The theme of the 51st MOBBIG meeting specified as "Challenges was Opportunities of Hybrid Education". In scope of the meeting, a very useful platform was created both to share the past experiences of MOBBIG and to discuss and question hybrid education and to shed light on future processes by generating new ideas. The MOBBIG meeting, during which distance education models and experiences were discussed especially after the Covid-19 pandemic, created important input for the problems and solutions in the current process. The multidimensional impact areas of architectural education were evaluated together with the relevant stakeholders and contributed to the creation of a roadmap within the scope of the the short, medium and long term planning processes for the future.

Current issues in architectural education and practice were evaluated at the Architectural Education Convention, which was held under the theme of "Change/Solidarity". A very productive and constructive congress was held with the participation of a large group of participants including professionals and students from various educational institutions and TMMOB Chamber of Architects branches. EMU Architecture Department Head Prof. Dr.





Resmiye Alpar Atun stated that in the congress, architectural education was evaluated under the headings of "Current Developments in Architecture Education, Architecture and Inter - Institutional Relations in Education, Architecture Accreditation and Admission Processes". Expressing that the Diploma Projects Exhibition was held with the participation of all institutions, Prof. Dr. Atun noted that all stakeholders contributed from different perspectives in the Diploma Form, which

was held together with the exhibition, and a holistic discussion took place in a sharing environment. Stating that the student projects of the EMU Architecture Department were included in the Diploma Projects Exhibition, Prof. Dr. Atun added that EMU Architecture Department has preserved its uniqueness and made its difference with its international accreditation and memberships, prominent academic staff, and students from different countries and cultures.


to the creation and development of a culture of intellectual property rights and the preparation of a legal infrastructure for the industry by raising awareness of the relevant parties on what these rights are.

EMU TOURISM MANAGEMENT DOCTORAL PROGRAM GRADUATE RECEIVES OUTSTANDING PAPER AWARD



Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) Faculty of Tourism, Tourism Management Doctorate Program graduate Ecem Ince has received the "outstanding article" award. Her article titled "Impacts of Cittaslow Philosophy on Sustainable Tourism Development", which is about her doctoral thesis and published in Open House International, was deemed worthy of the "2021 Outstanding Paper" award by the editors of Emerald Publishing and the scientific committee.

Emerald Publishing, the international publisher of academic journals and books in different fields including tourism, management, business, education, health and engineering, has been awarding high-impact and prominent articles amongst its publications under the umbrella of the Emerald Literati Awards for more than 25 years. This award, presented for the 26th time this year, aims to celebrate and reward the extraordinary contributions of authors not only to Emerald journals and books, but to the body of knowledge itself.

Ecem İnce's article, which was deemed worthy of the "Outstanding Paper" award, one of the most important awards within the scope of the 2021 Emerald Literati Awards, was among the most distinguished articles published in the Emerald database in 2021. Making a statement on the subject, EMU Faculty of Tourism Dean Prof. Dr. Hasan Kılıç emphasized that this award

is a work that reflects the level of quality doctoral theses produced in the EMU Tourism Faculty Doctorate Program. Expressing his happiness and pride that the results of Ecem İnce's doctoral thesis will reach a wider audience, Prof. Dr. Kılıç extended his heartfelt gratitude to thesis supervisors Prof. Dr. Deniz İşçioğlu and Prof. Dr. Ali Öztüren for their valuable guidance and contributions from the beginning of the thesis until its dissertation. Prof. Dr. Kılıç stated that the study, which reveals the effects of the Cittaslow (slow city) philosophy on the development of sustainable tourism in Northern Cyprus, provides important results within the scope of the development of the Northern Cyprus tourism industry and the cities in Northern Cyprus.

Stating that the success of master's and doctoral programs is not a coincidence, Prof. Dr. Kılıç stated that EMU Tourism Faculty is ranked 38th in the field of Tourism and Hotel Management in the World University Academic Ranking 2021 Field Rankings List of the China-based world university ranking institution ShanghaiRanking.

Prof. Dr. Kılıç added that Ecem İnce, who is a graduate of EMU Tourism Faculty, is currently employed as a lecturer with the title of Dr. at Istanbul Kent University, Faculty of Art and Design, Department of Gastronomy and Culinary Arts. EMU FACULTY OF EDUCATION CRCP HELD 6TH INTERNATIONAL COMMUNICATION AND MEDIA STUDIES CONFERENCE

The 6th Communication and Media Studies Conference, organized by the Center of Research and Communication for Peace (CRCP), which was established under the roof of the Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) Faculty of Communication in 2006, has been completed. Having taken place with the theme "Peace, Intersectionality and Uncertainties", the online conference was held in English and Turkish. At the said conference, presentations were delivered in 11 main areas, namely, Peace and Conflict, Peace Journalism, Visualizing Peace / Peace through Art, Gender and Intersectionality, Equality, Differentiation and Inclusion, Environmental Crisis Global Warming (Heating) and Peace for Climate Change, Racial and Ethnic Studies and Peace, Public Relations and Peacebuilding, Social Justice and Digital Divide, Human Mobility, Migration and Displacement, and Peace in Education - Education for Peace. EMU Rector Prof. Dr. Aykut Hocanin and Dean of the Faculty of Communication Prof. Dr. Senih Cavusoğlu, academic staff, scientists, young researchers, activists, human rights defenders and film directors participated in the said event

Commenced with Opening Speeches

The opening addresses of the conference were delivered by EMU Rector Prof. Dr. Aykut Hocanin, Dean of the Faculty of Communication Prof. Dr. Senih Çavuşoğlu and President of the CRCP Prof. Dr. Hanife Aliefendioğlu. In his speech, Prof. Dr. Aykut Hocanın stated that EMU, as a state university, has a duty to make a breakthrough in the field of research as well as providing quality education, and that there are many centers established within the university operating towards fulfilling this purpose and that CRCP is among these centers and contributes to scientific work. Prof. Dr. Avkut Hocanın thanked all the participants from all over the world who attended the international conference organized by the Faculty of Communication, CRCP, and wished everyone a productive conference. In his speech, Prof. Dr. Cavusoğlu stated that at the 6th international conference of CRCP, which was established under the roof of the faculty, participants from many different countries of the world would deliver around 50 presentations. Drawing attention to the importance of the role of the media in establishing peace in conflict zones, Prof. Dr. Cavusoğlu expressed that the conference would feature examples from different regions of peace journalism, human rights journalism and peace struggles in the world. Prof. Dr. Çavuşoğlu thanked those who contributed to the organization of the conference and conference participants.

Prof. Dr. Hanife Aliefendioğlu, on the other hand, provided information about the activities of CRCP since its establishment. Expressing that the center established within the EMU Faculty



of Communication has accomplished important achievements, Prof. Dr. Aliefendioğlu stated that the international conference, the 6th of which was held this year, would fulfill an important task in understanding the problems that stand in the way of establishing peace in the region and in the world, and in bringing the solution proposals to be produced for the solution of these problems to the societies with a scientific approach. At the end of her address, Prof. Dr. Aliefendioğlu thanked all the participants.

Prof. Dr. Alankuş and Dr. Shaw Among Keynote Speakers

The first invited keynote speaker of the conference, founder of the CRCP and one of the first CRCP conference organizers, was the former EMU Communication Faculty Dean and current Yaşar University Faculty of Communication Dean Prof. Dr. Sevda Alankuş. In her speech titled "The Absence of Feminist Epistemology in Peace Journalism", Prof. Dr. Alankuş presented a new peace journalism perspective and ethics that goes beyond binary oppositions, with an interdisciplinary approach that goes beyond injecting a "gender perspective" into peace journalism. Prof. Dr. Alankus pointed out the need for a peace journalism that removes the boundaries between rights-oriented journalism and peace journalism and is shaped around the positive meaning of peace.

The second keynote speaker of the conference was Northumbria University academic staff member and Chair of the Sierra Leone Right to Access Information Commission, Dr. İbrahim Seaga Shaw. In his speech titled "The Contribution of Human Rights Journalism to Social Change and Development", Dr. Shaw stated that for peace journalism and rights-oriented journalism, journalists should adopt an activist newsmaking process and question basic journalism concepts. At the CRCP's 6th International Conference

on Communication and Media Studies, around 50 presentations were delivered from many countries including Cyprus, Turkey, Belgium, Pakistan, Germany, England, India, Burkina Faso and Canada. In addition to the presentations. the conference also hosted film screenings and book promotion events. In addition to two short films promoting Famagusta and EMU, Kalli Paakspuu's film "Bridge Text of an Estonian Song as a Nation's Narrative" was screened at the last session of the conference. Prof. Dr. Nico Carpentier of Charles University, Czech Republic, introduced his latest book, "The Struggle Over Memory: Monumentalizing Cyprus' Violent Past." Peacemaking, peace journalism and peace activism were discussed at the conference, with specific focus on news value, peace education, post-truth, immigration and refugees, representation of LGBTI+ identities in the media, social memory and journalism, hate speech, digital activism, and street art for peace. At the same time, various presentations were made on the COVID-19 period state of exception, the intersection of gender and peacemaking, the representation of ethnic identities in the media or the media of ethnic identities. The practices of peace journalism in various countries such as India, Pakistan, Nigeria, Cyprus and Palestine were discussed at the conference, and presentations on the peace process in various conflict zones were also included. Among them, Cyprus, Kashmir and Palestine examples were shown. In a statement made by CRCP, it was put forth that with similar events, ways of multi-communal and multidisciplinary cooperation in the fields of media and peace journalism were sought in a divided island like Cyprus. CRCP stated that while conducting research and organizing events on issues such as peace studies, peace and human rights journalism, and conflict resolution, the center aims at a series of activities that can contribute to peace and communication education both within the region and throughout the world.

Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) Faculty of Education, Elementary Education Department organized a conference titled "Child-Friendly Protection Environments: Abuse and Children Interview Rooms" on the occasion of 20 November, World Children's Day. The event which was held on the 6th of December, 2021 hosted Specialist Clinical Psychologist and Psychotherapist Esmen Tatlicali as a guest speaker whom provided detailed information on interviewing rooms which have recently started providing service for children and their families within the scope of Social Services Department.

Tatlıcalı addressed the Students' Questions

Stating that the new interview rooms has started providing services in Nicosia and Kyrenia, Tatlıcalı mentioned that actions plans to increase the number of the interview rooms are in the agenda. Tatlicali emphasized that the rooms have equipment that can be used both for children who come to the Social Services Department with suspicion of abuse, and for family child investigations. Moreover, Tatlıcalı underlined that these rooms are very important to respond to the age, development and needs of children while interviewing children at risk, and answered the questions posed by the students of the Elementary Education Department

at the end of the conference. The students who attended the conference stated that the conference was very beneficial and that their participation in such activities while preparing for the teaching profession contributed to their development.

Contributing the organizing process of the conference, Elementary Education Department academic staff member Assist. Prof. Dr. Nihan Koran made a statement regarding the matter and said: "Through the medium of this conference, we, as EMU Education Faculty, Elementary Education Department academic staff members declare that, in addition to creating child-friendly environments, we will contribute to the future studies on Children's Rights and continue to work for children together with children". EMU Education Faculty, Elementary Education Department Head Prof. Dr. Ayşe Işık Gürşimşek stated that it is the common goal of all faculty members in the department to raise teacher candidates with an understanding that will consider "the best interests of children" during the preparation process for the profession, and said that similar activities is to continue.
