The UK-based Times Higher Education (THE), the publisher of the world's most widely-referred university rankings and published, has announced the 2021 Ranking of the Best Young Universities in the World that have started educational activities within the last 50 years. Similar to last year, Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU), the only university from the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus to be included in the rankings this year again, ranks within the 251-300 band. The ranking provides a comparison of the younger institutions in terms of publications, citations, quality of education and internationalization.

Singapore's Nanyang Technological University has been announced as the world leader in the list, where EMU ranks 7th amongst 32 Turkish universities. The increase in the universities of developing countries in the list is worthy of attention. While 34 universities from India, 12 from Malaysia and 8 from China have been included in the ranking, only 4 young universities from the USA were included in the list. Three

universities from South Cyprus managed to enter the list. The performance scales from the overall THE World List were used in the THE Best Young Universities Ranking 2021, which ranks young universities under the age of 50 around the world according to their quality of education, scholarly research, bibliographic citations, international visibility and industrial revenue.

EMU STUDENT SELECTION, PLACEMENT AND SCHOLARSHIP SYSTEM – 2021 RESULTS ANNOUNCED



Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU), Student Selection, Placement and Scholarship System-2021 results have been announced. According to the results, 1,681

student candidates have been placed in associate degree and undergraduate programs (excluding Medicine and Dentistry Programs) according to their high school achievement scores. According to the results of the EMU Entrance Exam held at the EMU campus and Maltepe University in Istanbul On 19 June 2021 and participated by 197 candidates, 15 candidates have been placed in the EMU – Marmara University International Joint Medicine Program, while 10 candidates have been placed in the EMU – Health Sciences University International Joint Dentistry Program. Candidates can access their exam results through the system from which they submitted their applications. The scholarship rates of the candidates who are entitled to a scholarship have also been announced through the same system.

Score Category Highest Achievers Also Announced

In High School Achievement Score Category, Ayşe Naz Kankur, Azra Aygün, Eren Erberk Erkul and Murat Bebiş shared the first place, while Meryem Boran came first in Music Score and Remziye Kızılbora in Sports Score. According to the results of the Entrance Exam, Neslişah Baki became the first in Mathematics-Science Score Type.

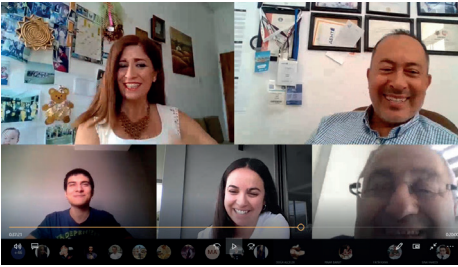

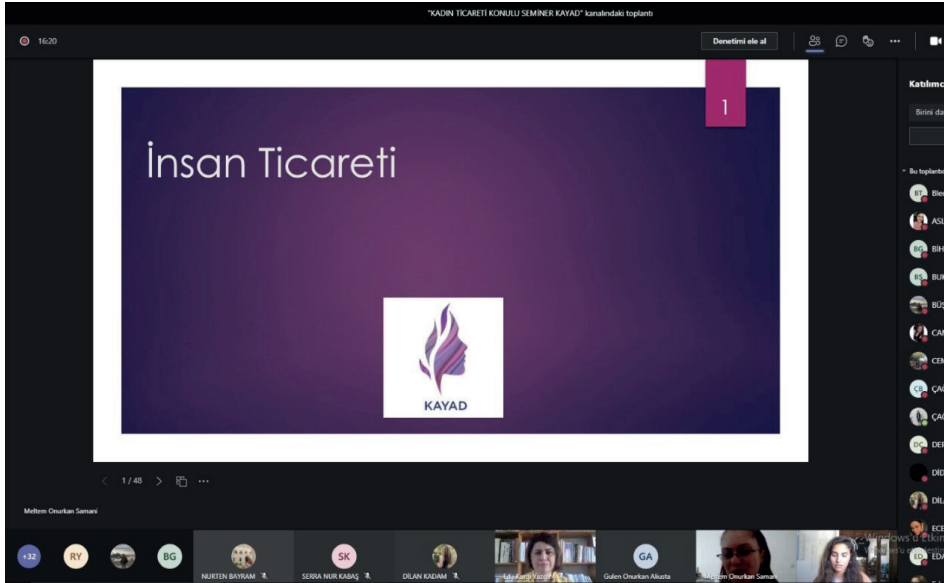

Within the scope of the World Interiors Day 2021 (IFI WID), Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) Faculty of Architecture, Department of Interior Architecture held an event titled “EMU Interior Architecture Department’s Global Conversation with Projects in Design Studios”.

Making a statement on the subject, EMU Interior Architecture Department Chair Assoc. Prof. Dr. Zehra Öngül stated that the theme of the World Interiors Day (IFI WID) for 2021 has been determined as “Design as a Global Conversation”, and added that, on behalf of EMU Department of Interior Architecture, a video has been developed under the coordination of IFI Committee Members Assoc. Prof. Dr. Asu Tozan and Research Assistant Nüvit Köseoğlu.

Assoc. Prof. Dr. Öngül stated that the video has been developed with the contributions of all studio coordinators and students and, in order to create a holistic conversation, is based on the processes that took place in the design project workshops during the 2020-2021 Fall Semester. Emphasizing that the video is an inspiring one consisting of written and graphic expressions from student project samples and noteworthy keywords in the project topics, Assoc. Prof. Dr. Öngül stated that the conversations that took place emphasized the important role of the interior architecture profession in shaping the renewed life in changing world conditions. Stating that socialization, education, living and working spaces are among the project topics, Assoc. Prof. Dr. Öngül stated that a talk was held on the keywords in the areas of communication,

climate change, home and inclusion. Assoc. Prof. Dr. Öngül emphasized that the profession of Interior Architecture has a nature that supports human life physically and psychologically in changing world conditions, and stated that the COVID-19 pandemic process, which has an impact at a global scale, once again confirms this.
