## EMU FACULTY OF ARCHITECTURE'S PRESTIGIOUS NAAB ACCREDITATION HAS BEEN EXTENDED FOR ANOTHER 6 YEARS

Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) Faculty of Architecture, Department of Architecture has successfully completed the inspection process of The National Architectural Accrediting Board, USA (NAAB), mandatory for all graduates of architecture schools in the USA and Canada to obtain a Bachelor of Architecture. Thus, the NAAB accreditation that EMU Architecture Department has been holding since 2016 has been extended for another 6 years.

The quality education provided to its students by the EMU Architecture Department, the only Department of Architecture on the island of Cyprus with NAAB accreditation, has been re-confirmed in this way. Thanks to the NAAB accreditation, students graduating from EMU Architecture Department programs have the opportunity to pursue their profession in the USA and Canada with a Bachelor of Architecture, while at the same time they have great advantages in getting admitted to graduate programs and finding a job in these countries.

### “Achieved as a Result of Teamwork”

In a statement given by EMU Architecture Faculty, Architecture Department Head Prof. Dr. Rafoneeh Mokhtar Shahi Sani and Assistant Head of the Department Assoc. Prof. Dr. Öznem Şahali Kovancı, it was put



forth that the NAAB accreditation of the department has been achieved as a result of intense and strict inspections, and the said accreditation has been achieved as a result of a team effort contributed by all academic staff of the department. Prof. Dr. Sani also thanked Prof. Dr. Alpar Atun, who served as the Head of the Department of Architecture at the beginning of the process and later has been elected as the Dean of the Faculty of Architecture in the new term as well as the department administrative team in the former periods for their important contributions to obtaining the NAAB accreditation. In a statement made regarding the achievement, EMU Architecture Faculty Dean Prof. Dr. Resimiye Alpar Atun pointed out the importance of the pioneering role that the EMU Architecture Department has assumed in architectural education, both in terms of

the quality of the education provided and the accreditations it holds. Emphasizing that having the international certification of NAAB is a real prestige for the institution, Prof. Dr. Atun also highlighted its importance in terms of documenting the educational quality of the department. Prof. Dr. Atun stated that for students studying at EMU Architecture Department from many different parts of the world, the fact that their education has international equivalence brings many opportunities in terms of professional practice after their studies. Prof. Dr. Atun expressed her belief that many more successful achievements will be gained and expressed her gratitude to EMU Rector Prof. Dr. Aykut Hoca'nın, all administrative levels of the university, and everyone who contributed to the process for their sensitivity and support.

## EMU'S MASTER'S PROGRAMS RANK HIGH IN EURASIA AND MIDDLE EAST REGIONS AT EDUNIVERSAL 2022 WORLD RANKINGS

Five postgraduate programs from Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) Faculty of Business and Economics and one postgraduate program from the Faculty of Communication have been listed among the top 200 graduate programs in the 2022 report prepared by the ranking agency Eduniversal, which evaluates postgraduate programs at a global level. During the determination of the Eduniversal 2022 Best Postgraduate Programs Ranking, more than 25 thousand programs have been examined and 5,600 programs in 55 branches have been included in the national and international rankings.

### 5<sup>th</sup> Best Program in the Field of Energy and Natural Resources

According to the Eurasian and Middle East region ranking results, which have proven the quality and success of EMU postgraduate programs, EMU Business and Economics Faculty, Energy Economics and Finance Master's Program has been ranked 5<sup>th</sup> in the field of Energy and Natural Resources; Economics Master's Program 7<sup>th</sup> in the field of Economics; Marketing Master's Program 8<sup>th</sup> in Marketing; Banking and Finance Master's Program 12<sup>th</sup> in Corporate Finance, and Business Master's Program 17<sup>th</sup> in the field of MBA Full Time. EMU Communication Faculty, Communication and Media Studies Master's Program has been announced as the 7<sup>th</sup> best program in Corporate Communication.





## EMU HOLDS A PANEL ON “SCOLIOSIS AND POSTURE DISORDERS IN ADOLESCENCE”



Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU), Faculty of Health Sciences, Department of Physiotherapy and Rehabilitation held a panel on “Scoliosis and Posture Disorders in Adolescence”. The said panel, held at the Faculty of Health Sciences Amphitheater, was organized for Çanakkale Secondary School students and their parents.

Speaking at the panel, EMU Physiotherapy and Rehabilitation Department Vice President Assist. Prof. Dr. Sevim Öksüz provided information about the Center for Healthy Living and Prosthesis Orthotics Biomechanics Center within the Faculty, and stated that physiotherapy services and orthopedic device applications for different groups are carried out by expert academics in their fields. In her speech, Dean of the Faculty of Health Sciences Prof. Dr. Mehtap Malkoç pointed out that besides the treatment services provided within the Faculty, practices and training that will improve public health are one of their important missions. At the end of her speech, Prof. Dr. Mehtap Malkoç wished the panel to be beneficial for everyone. During the said panel, EMU Physiotherapy



and Rehabilitation Department academic staff member and Head of Prosthetics Orthotics Biomechanics Center Assoc. Prof. Dr. Yasin Yurt provided information to students and parents about what needs to be done to protect and improve spinal health during adolescence and stated that posture disorders observed in this period may be related to scoliosis. Stating that screening studies to be carried out in schools to detect scoliosis in growing young people facilitate early diagnosis and treatment, Assoc. Prof. Dr. Yurt said that they launched a study in secondary schools in the Famagusta Region for this purpose,



and that they will evaluate all the students and identify, inform and treat those who are at risk of scoliosis. The principal and deputy principals of Çanakkale Secondary School, which will be the first leg of the study, also participated in the panel and provided their full support. Çanakkale Secondary School Principal Mehmet Erim and Deputy Principal Ertül Erciyas expressed their satisfaction with the organization of the panel and stated that they would support the studies to be carried out on such an important issue, and that scoliosis screening could be carried out in children upon the consent of their families.





## EMU EDUCATIONAL SCIENCES DEPARTMENT PROVIDES TRAINING SEMINAR TO POLATPAŞA HIGH SCHOOL TEACHERS
