THE FUTURE OF ELECTRICITY DISCUSSED IN EMU WITH THE PARTICIPATION OF TRNC MINISTER OF FINANCE ATUN





















Organized by the Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) Faculty of Business and Economics, the panel titled "The Future of Electricity in the TRNC" was held on Wednesday, 30 March, 2022 at 10:00 a.m. at EMU Mustafa Afşin Ersoy Hall. Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus (TRNC) Minister of Finance Sunat Atun, CTP MP Teberrüken Uluçay, EMU Board of Trustees President Dr. Erdal Özcenk, EMU Rector Prof. Dr. Aykut Hocanın, Board of Trustees Members, Vice Rectors, Cyprus Turkish Electricity Authority General Director Gürcan Erdoğan, faculty deans, academicians, representatives of non-governmental organizations and students attended the event.

Delivering the opening speech of the panel, EMU Rector Prof. Dr. Aykut Hocanin stated that one of the main duties of EMU, as a state university, is to offer suggestions to legislators for the solution of crucial problems within its fields of expertise, with a



scientific point of view and by sharing different views. Prof. Dr. Aykut Hocanin also expressed his wish that the results of the panel would be beneficial to the country in these difficult days.

Minister Atun Invited Panel Speakers to the Ministry

The keynote speaker of the panel, Sunat Atun, TRNC Minister of Finance, stated that electricity is the most important energy element and drew attention to the importance of talking and planning for the future. Providing information on various energy activities developing within the geography, such as the Eurasia Project, which aims to interconnect Israel, Southern Cyprus, Greece and Italy, Minister Atun pointed out the importance of providing further visions on the issue of being interconnected in electricity transmission with Turkey. Stating that he cares about the contribution of the

panel speakers to this process and this issue, Minister Atun invited the speakers to gather at a roundtable in the Ministry after the publication of the final booklet of the panel.

After the opening addresses, EMU Rector Prof. Dr. Aykut Hocanin presented Minister Atun a plaque of appreciation.

"TRNC is Powerful Enough to Finance Electricity Investments"

The moderator of the panel, EMU Business and Economics Faculty Dean Prof. Dr. Mustafa Besim stated that it can be seen how bad the electricity situation in the TRNC is, compared to the global reports, and drew attention to the supply problem experienced within the last days. Stating that countries where TRNC stands behind in electricity are far behind the TRNC in terms of literacy, university education, human resources, and per capita income, Prof. Dr. Besim pointed out that especially the banking sector has the power to finance important projects such as electricity generation investment in terms of financial resources. Underlining that the main problem is the correct management, administration and planning of electricity in the TRNC, Prof. Dr. Besim added that they wanted to talk about the future in the panel. Prof. Dr. Besim also pointed out the necessity of making the electricity issue a supra-governmental state policy.

How Should Investment Planning Be Made?

Görkem Çelik, Chair of the Energy Commission of the Chamber of Electrical Engineers, delivered a presentation titled "Vision of Innovation in Energy" at the panel and evaluated how energy is managed in the TRNC. Pointing out that investment planning should be handled with a transparent policy, Çelik stated that there is a need for an electricity higher energy board in the country. He also made statements about the current situation and capacity of renewable energy sources and talked about the advantages that energy efficiency can provide.

In his presentation titled "Cost-Efficiency Analysis of the Electricity Production in the TRNC", EMU Business and Economics Faculty, Banking and Finance Department academic staff member Assoc. Prof. Dr. Hasan Ulaş Altıok summarized the total installed and usable power situation of the TRNC and shared scientific data on the capacity that will be needed in future projections. Explaining the main factors that increase production costs, Assoc. Prof. Dr. Altıok added that production with new technologies is much more beneficial and that production with natural gas can create resources for investment by saving money. Assoc. Prof. Dr. Altıok also provided information about the amount of investment to be made and the returns that can be received.

Demand Management Strategies Evaluated

In his presentation titled "The Importance of Demand Management in Sustainable Energy", President of EMU Energy Research Center Prof. Dr. Uğur Atikol summarized the reasons for the current power outages and stated that production should be planned according to demand. Stating that the operation of electric water heaters is one of the most important factors in increasing the peak electricity demand throughout the day, Prof. Dr. Atikol noted that the power plants that need to be operated during peak demand hours are missing. Explaining that savings can be made by directing consumers correctly in demand management and different strategies that can be applied, Prof. Dr. Atikol drew attention to the importance of expanding renewable energy sources.

In his presentation titled "Energy Cooperatives for Domestic and Renewable Resources", EMU Engineering Faculty Vice Dean Assist. Prof. Dr. Davut Solyalı, stated that in developed countries cooperatives are also developed and noted that the TRNC is an experienced country in this regard. Explaining how the public can be informed about renewable energy cooperatives, Assist. Prof. Dr. Solyalı stated that monopolization and privatization should be prevented in the TRNC, which has a small energy volume, and that cooperatives will contribute to this. Assist. Prof. Dr. Solyalı finally noted that the foundations for cooperatives in energy should be laid

Attention Drawn to the Importance of Being Interconnected

METU-TRNC Electrical and Electronics Engineering Department Head Prof. Dr. Murat Fahrioğlu, in his presentation titled "The Future of Electrical Interconnection in Cyprus", stated that the interconnection of the TRNC to its neighboring countries will make the optimal contribution to the electrical energy system. Stating that the countries that are interconnected to the electricity transmission lines in the world, can manage their energy much more easily, Prof. Dr. Fahrioğlu pointed out that this would bring benefits to the TRNC in the long run and that all stakeholders should agree on this issue

Cyprus Turkish Electricity Authority Deputy General Director Kamil Direl shared the current installed power and peak load charts of the TRNC in his presentation titled "Current Status of Electricity Production in the TRNC". Emphasizing that the existing power plants are not enough to meet the demand, Direl pointed out that this is an unacceptable situation, on the contrary, electrical energy should be produced above the demand, and that even a backup capacity should be created in the largest power plant in the country.

The panel ended after the question-answer session. EMU Rector Prof. Dr. Aykut Hocanin presented plaques of appreciation and gifts to the participants of the panel.

Then, the decisions of the Constitutional Court on gender were interpreted within the framework of the legislation that has changed over the years. While examining the topic, the amendments made since the 1924 Constitution of the Republic of Turkey until today were discussed and the relevant articles of the Turkish Penal Code and the Turkish Civil Code were also examined. The seminar ended with a question and answer session.

18 March Çanakkale Victory and Martyrs Commemoration Events were held at Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) to mark the 107th Anniversary of the Çanakkale Victory. As part of the "18 March Çanakkale Victory and Martyrs Commemoration Program" organized by the EMU Atatürk Research and Application Center (EMU-ATAUM) with the contributions of the EMU Atatürk Ideology Club (EMU ADK), wheat soup

was distributed to students at EMU Atatürk Square between 12:30 and 14:30 on Friday, 18 March 2022. EMU Vice Rector for Social and Cultural Affairs Prof. Dr. Deniz İşçioğlu also attended the organisation. Then, at 14:30, the "18 March Çanakkale Victory and Martyrs Commemoration Panel" was held at EMU Mustafa Afşin Ersoy Hall. Materials collected from the Çanakkale Battlefield were also exhibited in the panel hall.

"The Preface of the Republic of Turkey Written in the Battle of Canakkale"

The panel which started with a moment of silence and the National Anthem was moderated by EMU-ATAUM President Assist. Prof. Dr. Turgay Bülent Göktürk. The panel commenced with Assist. Prof. Dr. Göktürk's presentation titled "Military and Political Aspects of the Çanakkale War". Stating that the Republic of Turkey is the work of a national struggle under the leadership of Mustafa Kemal Atatürk, Assist. Prof. Dr. Göktürk said, "The preface of this work was also written during the Battle of Çanakkale. Because the determination and spirit of the struggle in the Çanakkale Front became one of the main dynamics of the national struggle and was a first step for the Epic Wat of Independence. As Mustafa Kemal stated, if Canakkale had been invaded, Istanbul would have been taken, the Ottoman Empire would have been shared, and the Turkish Republic would not have been established. In this respect, the Çanakkale Victory has a special place and importance in Turkish History." Assist. Prof. Dr. Göktürk said, "On the 107th Anniversary of the Çanakkale Victory, I commemorate with gratitude all those who did not hesitate to sacrifice their lives and blood for this land to become a homeland:our heroic soldiers, who were martyred in the prime of their lives for their homeland, flag and nation. May their holy souls rest in peace."

History Department Chair Assoc. Prof. Dr. İhsan Tayhani provided information the processes experienced in the Çanakkale Victory, Mustafa Kemal Atatürk's involvement in the war and the turning points of the war with his decisions, the effects of the Canakkale Victory in the imperialist countries, the provisions regulating the war law that has been in effect since the 16th century. Assoc. Prof. Dr. Tayhani also talked about the activities carried out by the Entente states in violation of international law, such as the bombing of residential areas, which led to the deaths of civilians during the war. In her presentation titled "Mustafa Kemal and Çanakkale", EMU-ATAUM academic staff member Sen. Inst. Süheyla Göktürk mentioned the military genius of Mustafa Kemal and stated that the Çanakkale Wars were a place where it was seen that the military and financial power would not always be enough. Stating that the great navies of the most powerful countries on a global scale came to Çanakkale, but they could not pass either by sea or by land, Göktürk stated that the results of the Dardanelles Wars affected Turkish and world history militarily, politically and economically. Noting that the course of history has changed in Çanakkale, Göktürk said, "The unique struggle of freedom and independence was exhibited in Çanakkale. The experiences gained here made important contributions to the victory of our national liberation war. We commemorate with gratitude and respect all our heroes, especially Gazi Mustafa Kemal Atatürk, who sacrificed their lives for the sake of the country and the flag, who wrote an epic in Çanakkale. May their souls rest in





peace,". After the speeches, Assoc. Prof. Dr. İhsan Tayhani and Sen. Inst. Süheyla Göktürk were presented certificates of appreciation by EMU-ATAUM President Assist. Prof. Dr. Turgay Bülent Göktürk.


EMU TO HOST ROCK'N EMU




EMU PAKISTANI STUDENTS SOCIETY ORGANISES A TRIP TO YEŞİLIRMAK
