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EMU'S ONLY RECTOR CANDIDATE: PROF. DR. HASAN KILIÇ

The candidate selection process for the new Rector of the Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) was completed on 12 October, 2023, following a Senate meeting. The EMU Senate unanimously approved Prof. Dr. Hasan Kılıç's candidacy.

How Does the Process Work?

To determine Rector candidates, EMU formed a Rector Candidate Determination Committee on September 22, 2023, upon the Senate's decision and the EMU Board of Trustees announced a vacancy for the Rector position on September 26, 2023. Two candidates applied by the deadline on October 6, 2023. The applications were forwarded to the committee, which then presented them to the EMU Academic Evaluation Commission. The commission reported that Prof. Dr. Hasan Kılıç met their criteria.

On October 11, 2023, the commission decided to recommend Prof. Dr. Hasan Kılıç's candidacy to the EMU Senate. The Senate approved his candidacy unanimously on October 12, 2023, making him the only candidate.

What's Next?

Even as the sole candidate, Prof. Dr. Hasan Kılıç still needs a vote of confidence. A presentation period for the candidate will take place between October 16-18, 2023. He will share his views and vision with EMU staff on a panel organized by the committee on October 19, 2023. A

confidence vote will be held on October 20, 2023, where all EMU staff will vote.

If he receives the vote of confidence, the DAÜ Senate will recommend Prof. Dr. Hasan Kılıç for the position of Rector to the DAÜ Board of Trustees on October 26, 2023. The appointment will then be finalized by the Board of Trustees

Who is Prof. Dr. Hasan Kılıç?

Prof. Dr. Hasan Kılıç completed his master's and doctoral education at Dokuz Eylül University. After his military service and a year of teaching experience, he went to the UK to gain experience and receive education in Tourism Management. He gained his initial experience in various hotels at different managerial levels. After returning to Cyprus, he served as Deputy General Manager at Celebrity-Chateau Lambousa Hotel. He then joined the academic world at Eastern Mediterranean University's School of Tourism and Hospitality, becoming a Professor in 2013

In 2003, he went to the Macao Special Administrative Region of China to gain diverse experience, conducting research and giving lectures. His work has been published in high-ranking journals like Tourism Management and International Journal of Contemporary Hospitality Management. He has represented Northern Cyprus in economic sub-committee talks concerning Cyprus. He



served as the Secretary of the Ministry of Economy and Tourism in 2008-2009 and is actively involved in various NGOs.

Prof. Dr. Kılıç is the current president of the newly established Cyprus Gastronomy Tourism Association (GASTUR) and has actively participated in various projects. He is currently leading a project related to tourism planning and capacity measurement in collaboration with the Ministry of Tourism. Serving as the Dean of the Faculty of Tourism at Eastern Mediterranean University, he has conducted education and research in the fields of service and hospitality management, tourism planning, and gastronomy. He also teaches courses and supervises master's and doctoral theses in these areas.

EMU PUTS HUGE SUPPORT FOR THE CHAMPION ANGELS ÜLKER NICOSIA MARATHON

Prof. Dr. Osam continued his duty as a faculty member at EMU Faculty of Education, Department of Foreign Languages Education as of 20 February, 2020 and retired on 30 September, 2023.

Prominent Names in the Design Field on the Jury

The competition, which attracted applications from academics, professional designers, undergraduate and graduate students, as well as elementary, middle, and high school students in the categories of home, office, kitchen-bathroom, and smart furniture, had a prestigious jury formed by some of the most prominent figures in the field of design. Prof. Önder Küçükerman served as the Chair of the Jury, and other distinguished jury members included Reşit Soley, Aziz Sarıyer, Mustafa Toner, Kaan Dericioğlu, Didem Çapa, Fatih Kıral, and Murat Armağan, all of whom are renowned experts in the industry. The competition received support from organizations such as TRT, the Chamber of Architects, the Chamber of Interior Architects, and the Creative Kids Association.

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TWO BOOKS CO-EDITED BY EMU FACULTY OF ARCHITECTURE ACADEMIC STAFF MEMBER PROF. DR. KAĞAN GÜNÇE ARE NOW AVAILABLE TO READERS

Two academic books coordinated and coedited by Prof. Dr. Kağan Günce, the Faculty of Architecture academic staff member and Assistant Director of the Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU), Institute for Graduate Studies and Research have been published. Prof. Dr. Günçe served as the co-editor for the books titled 'Architectural Science and Cultural Heritage - Historic Matter' and 'Architectural Science and Cultural Heritage - Traces of the History,' alongside with Assoc. Prof. Dr. Hale Kozlu, Vice Dean of the Faculty of Architecture at Erciyes University and Head of the Restoration Department, and Assoc. Prof. Dr. Damla Misirlisoy, faculty member and Department Chair at the Lefke University, Faculty of Architecture and Design.

Numerous Submissions from Academics

Initially, studies were conducted on academic e-books in English, produced to serve the field of architecture, which aimed to increase awareness of preserving and perpetuating cultural heritage under the operations of the Journal of Architectural Sciences and Applications (JASA) and IKSAD Publishing House. With the aim of increasing awareness of the importance of raising, preserving, and perpetuating cultural heritage and creating a concrete academic book, a call for chapters was made under the title 'Architectural Science and Cultural Heritage.' Following this call, numerous submissions were received from a wide range of academics, and a highly selective process led to 30 of these submissions being accepted.

Bridging the Gap Between the Past, Present, and Future

Fifteen of these valuable academic studies were published in the book 'Architectural Science and Cultural Heritage – Historic Matter,' edited by Prof. Dr. Kağan Günçe and Assoc. Prof. Dr. Hale Kozlu, while the remaining fifteen were published in the book 'Architectural Science and Cultural Heritage – Traces of the History,' edited by Prof. Dr. Kağan Günçe and Assoc. Prof. Dr. Damla Mısırlısoy. These two precious books, believed to serve both 'Cultural Heritage' and the 'Conservation Science Field,' will

undoubtedly serve as academic bridges between the past, present, and future.

Cultural Heritage Studies from Room Scale to Urban Scale

'Architectural Science and Cultural Heritage – Historic Matter' and 'Architectural Science and Cultural Heritage – Traces of the History' cover cultural heritage studies ranging from room scale to urban scale. The books provide guidance in both academic and practical aspects of the field. Each chapter in both books carefully discusses the universal values that give cultural heritage its heritage quality and allows for a detailed and in-depth exploration of the subject. Through the lens of 'concrete cultural heritage,' both books depict the manifestations of values, beliefs, knowledge, and traditions that have survived from the past to the present.

"Shedding Light on New Academic Studies"

Prof. Dr. Kağan Günçe assured that the chapters included in the book projects 'Architectural Science and Cultural Heritage



– Historic Matter' and 'Architectural Science and Cultural Heritage – Traces of the History' will contribute to cultural heritage topics and undoubtedly shed light on new academic studies in this field. Prof. Dr. Kağan Günçe also extended his heartfelt thanks to coeditors Assoc. Prof. Dr. Hale Kozlu and Assoc. Prof. Dr. Damla Mısırlısoy, the chapter author academics who collaborated with them to include their valuable academic work in these books, and the esteemed referees who evaluated these works.

EMU DEPARTMENT OF MATHEMATICS ACADEMIC STAFF MEMBER ASSOC. PROF. DR. ARRAN FERNANDEZ PARTICIPATED IN HEIDELBERG LAUREATE FORUM, AN EVENT FOR WHICH ONLY 200 YOUNG RESEARCHERS ARE SELECTED

Assoc. Prof. Dr. Arran Fernandez, a faculty member at Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU), Faculty of Arts and Sciences, Department of Mathematics participated in the Heidelberg Laureate Forum. This prestigious event carefully selects and invites only 200 young researchers from thousands of applicants around the world in the fields of Mathematics and Computer Science, who are either graduate/doctoral students or have completed their PhD in the last five years. Assoc. Prof. Dr. Fernandez spent a week at this esteemed event, meeting some of the world's most significant scientists in the fields of Mathematics and Computer Science

Assoc. Prof. Dr. Fernandez, who himself has been recognized as one of the world's most cited scientists in the "World's Most Influential Scientists" list published in October, led by a team of U.S. and Dutch scientists coordinated by Stanford University in the USA, represented EMU at the said forum and met with scientists who hold awards equivalent to the Nobel Prize in Mathematics and Computer Science, such as the Abel Prize, ACM A.M. Turing Award,

ACM Programming Award, Fields Medal, IMU Abacus Medal, and Nevanlinna Prize.

Exchange of Ideas with Fields Medalists

At the 10th Heidelberg Laureate Forum, Assoc. Prof. Dr. Fernandez participated in small group interaction sessions with 1994 Fields Medal recipient Efim Zelmanov and 1990 Fields Medal recipient Shigefumi Mori and gained insights into the history of mathematics and the careers of world-class mathematicians. Assoc. Prof. Dr. Fernandez also exchanged ideas with other leading figures in the world of mathematics and computer science, including 2022 Fields Medal recipient Maryna Viazovska and 1986 Fields Medal recipient Gerd Faltings.

Key Figures in Science Attended the Forum

Important figures in the scientific world, such as the President of the International Mathematical Union Hiraku Nakajima, zbMATH Chief Editor Klaus Hulek, President of the Max Planck Society Patrick Cramer, and pioneer researcher in Wavelets Ingrid Daubechies, attended the forum. The opening ceremony of the forum also featured

Jens Brandenburg, Parliamentary Secretary for the Federal Ministry of Education and Research of Germany; Petra Olschowski, Minister of Science, Research and the Arts for the State of Baden-Württemberg; Deputy Mayor of Heidelberg Jürgen Odszuck; and Rector of Heidelberg University Bernhard Fitel

Selected Among 10 Young Researchers

Assoc. Prof. Dr. Fernandez was selected among 10 young researchers to participate in the "HLF Spotlight Series," a podcast series focusing on the lives and careers of young mathematicians. Assoc. Prof. Dr. Fernandez also participated in the "Poster Flash" event among 30 young researchers. He presented a scientific poster related to his research and gave a two-minute talk titled "General Classes of Operators in Fractional Calculus and their Relations."

A certificate ceremony was held for the students of the EMU Tourism Faculty Gastronomy and Culinary Arts Department who completed their summer internships in Italy as part of the collaboration protocol signed between the Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) and ICIF - Italian Culinary Institute For Foreigners, one of Italy's leading institutions.

A Proud Achievement

Speaking at the ceremony held at the Barista Café on 10 October, 2023, the Dean of the DAU Tourism Faculty, Prof. Dr. Hasan Kılıç, noted that the faculty, which started offering education in the 2010-2011 Academic Year with 25 students in the 2-year Associate Degree Program in Culinary Arts, has continued with around 600 students in Turkish and English Gastronomy and Culinary Arts undergraduate programs, as well as Associate Degree programs in Culinary Arts, Pastry, and Bakery. Prof. Dr. Kılıç expressed that the students receive quality education from international teaching staff in the faculty's 6 practice kitchens, practice restaurant, amphitheater kitchen, barista café, and mixology laboratory, and he emphasized that this is a proud achievement.

Internships at Michelin Star Restaurants

As a result of efforts initiated by the faculty administration to enable students to reach better positions in the globalizing world, Prof. Dr. Kılıç mentioned that an agreement was made with ICIF - Italian Culinary Institute For Foreigners in February 2015. Prof. Dr. Kılıç stated that within the framework of this agreement, they bid farewell to their first group of students to Italy in the summer of 2015. Prof. Dr. Kılıç further explained that at this stage, the summer internships and education of 22 students have been reinforced with a 2-week basic Italian cuisine education at ICIF and subsequent internships at Michelinstarred and luxury restaurants.

Job Offers for EMU Tourism Faculty Students on Internship

Students who spoke at the ceremony mentioned that they learned the intricacies of Italian cuisine during their internships and education and expressed their satisfaction with the internships conducted by chefs and managers. They also mentioned that they received job offers after graduation. The ceremony concluded with a cocktail reception following the distribution of certificates.

In his statement regarding the program, Tourism Faculty Dean Prof. Dr. Hasan Kılıç explained that the City & Guilds program at the "Level 2" level



provides job opportunities worldwide for students with culinary arts knowledge. He emphasized that DAU Tourism Faculty offers this education to all students in the Gastronomy and Culinary Arts Program and the Culinary Arts Program during the first two years of their education, and successful students take exams based in the UK to obtain their success certificates. Prof. Dr. Kılıç highlighted that this practice is considered a quality assurance in education and is highly regarded as a prestigious standard.

City & Guilds currently offers vocational training opportunities in more than 27 fields and hundreds of subfields. EMU holds the distinction of being one of the approved center with accreditation protocols in the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus (TRNC).





EMU INTERIOR ARCHITECTURE DEPARTMENT SUPPORTS MUSEUM PROJECT AT EMU



Within the scope of this year's Graduation Project, Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) Faculty of Architecture, Department of Interior Architecture, 2023 – 2024 Academic Year Fall Semester INAR 492 / ITAS 402 Interior Architecture Workshop VI course launched "Contemporary Museum Interior and Neighborhood Design" project towards EMU art collection.

Launched with the aim of contributing to the collection, preservation and promotion of Turkish Cypriot artists' artwork whether locally or abroad, EMU art collection consists of 423 artwork from 26 artists as of February 2019. In parallel with the development of the museum, it is aimed to expand the collection as well. Within the scope of the said course, a technical visit to the museum area located at the Rauf Raif Denktas Culture and Congress Center

was organized with the intention of introducing the Turkish Cypriot artists and their styles. The students visited the "Portraits, Styles and Stories" exhibition which has been on exhibition for a year. Students who had the chance to observe the work of Cypriot artists expressed their contentedness on being a part of the museum project.

The aim of the exhibition visit was to make the students' mindsets visible by using contemporary education models in connection with examining the styles and techniques of local artists. It was also stated that educational programs including workshops for children, young people and adults were developed through the exhibition. The students of these two courses, which are carried out in parallel in the English and Turkish medium programs of Interior Architecture Department, met

with EMU Art Coordinator and artist Zehra Şonya who provided information on the art collection and Cypriot artists. Regarding the museum structure during the visit; how each phase of the museum should be combined with creative design elements was discussed with the students and all technical and practical details, from lighting to materials, were emphasized.

Moreover, an interview with Cypriot artist Hüseyin Özinal was held at EMU, Department of Interior Architecture, in order for students to understand the different disciplines inherent in museum design and to get information from those disciplines. The aim of the conversation was for students to understand the different disciplines inherent in museum design and to obtain information about those disciplines. In this context, students will learn about the areas that Özinal opened up for himself as an artist through the museums and exhibitions he visited in different cities; They had the chance to hear from the artist about their own knowledge, way of seeing and experiences.

The technical visit and the talk were organized by course instructors; Prof. Dr. Özlem Olgaç Türker, Assist. Prof. Dr. Seyit Ermiyagil and research assistants Gülde Kasım and Şevin Emektar. With such different collaborative learning methods, graduate students and professionals also experienced interactive and practice-based learning methods by working as a team towards a common goal.
