A handover ceremony of the Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) Rector's Office has been held on Tuesday, 24 October, 2023, at 09:30 a.m., at the Rector's Building. Prof. Dr. Mustafa Tümer, the Acting Rector, handed over the duty to Prof. Dr. Hasan Kılıç. Also present at the handover ceremony were Dr. Erdal Özcenk, the President of the EMU Board of Trustees, and the Rector's Office Coordinators.

Prof. Dr. Mustafa Tümer expressed his gratitude to everyone who supported him during his tenure, stating that they completed the process without any disruptions. Prof. Dr. Tümer also stated that Prof. Dr. Kılıç had received the majority of EMU employees' vote of confidence and wished him success in his new undertaking.

Prof. Dr. Hasan Kılıç emphasized that in the tendency determination poll held at EMU, the oldest educational institution in the country, the opinion and trust of the EMU were evident. Highlighting his commitment to being worthy of this trust, Prof. Dr. Hasan Kılıç described this

"The Republic at Its 100th Anniversary" panel organized with the collaboration of Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) Atatürk Research and Application Center (ATAUM) and the EMU Atatürk Ideology Club took place on Monday, 23 October, 2023 at 14:30 at Rauf Raif Denktaş Culture and Congress Center with the participation of Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus (TRNC) Vice President and Parliamentary Spokesperson Zorlu Töre. Public and students showed great interest in the event which was broadcasted live by EMU TV and BRT 3.

The panel, featuring the 26th Chief of the General Staff of the Turkish Republic (Ret.) General İlker Başbuğ and Prof. Dr. İlber Ortaylı as guest speakers was attended by a number of distinguished individuals, including the Ombudsman İlkan Varol, the Head of the Civil Defense Organization Atilla Karaca, the President of the EMU Board of Trustees (VYK) President Dr. Erdal Özcenk, the Acting Rector of EMU Prof. Dr. Mustafa Tümer, the Rector of Near East University Prof. Dr. Remziye Terkan, the Mayor of Famagusta Dr. Süleyman Uluçay, VYK members, deans, faculty members, and a large number of students. Commenced with a moment of silence and the National Anthem, the panel continued with an opening speech by the President of EMU-ATAUM, Assist. Prof. Dr. Turgay Bülent Göktürk who expressed that they had gathered at this panel to celebrate the 100th anniversary of the Republic of Turkey, which Great Leader Mustafa Kemal Atatürk famously referred to as his "greatest work". Assist. Prof. Dr. Göktürk emphasized that their primary goal is to contribute to the students, who will be the future leaders of the country, in evaluating today correctly and making accurate predictions about the future.

Addressing the participants at the beginning of the event, EMU Acting Rector Prof. Dr. Tümer mentioned that they are celebrating the 100th anniversary of the Republic that the Turkish Nation achieved as a result of the national liberation struggle. Prof. Dr. Tümer expressed gratitude on behalf of the university to Prof. Dr. İlber Ortaylı and Retired General İlker Başbuğ for sharing this enthusiasm with the EMU community. Moreover, in his speech, Prof. Dr. Tümer read verses from the famous Turkish National Anthem written by Mehmet Akif Ersoy, who is also the author of the national anthem for both the Republic of Turkey and the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus. Then, he reminded the students of the words of Mustafa Kemal Atatürk, saying, "O youth, full of spirit, you are the future. In the name of the Republic, we founded it, and you will be the ones to elevate and perpetuate it," marking the celebration of the 100th anniversary of the Republic.

The Rector of Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU), Prof. Dr. Hasan Kılıç, released a celebratory message on the occasion of the 100th Anniversary of 29 October Republic Day. Prof. Dr. Kılıç's message reads as follows:

"On the 100th Anniversary of the establishment of the Republic of Turkey, I extend my best wishes to all members of the Turkish nation. A century has passed since the founding of the Republic of Turkey, which was crowned by Great Leader Mustafa Kemal Atatürk and his comrades-inarms, whoignited the flames of independence and established the Republic shoulder to shoulder with the Turkish people. EMU RANKS AMONG THE WORLD'S BEST IN THE PRESTIGIOUS TIMES HIGHER EDUCATION SUBJECT RANKINGS

The UK-based Times Higher Education (THE), one of the most widely-recognized publishers of university rankings globally announced the world's top universities by subject ranking on Thursday, 26 October, 2023.

Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) maintains its success as the only university from the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus (TRNC) to make it to the list, just like the previous year, in the field of Business and Economics, ranking within the range of 251-300 worldwide. In this category, there were four universities from the island of Cyprus and 19 from the Republic of Turkey. EMU secured the second position on the list for the whole island of Cyprus and shared the second place with Sabancı University among the universities of the Republic of Turkey. the third place in the band of 301-400. Koç University, ranking in the band of 201-250, took the first place among universities from the Republic of Turkey in the field of Business and Economics. Following EMU and Sabancı University, Bilkent University and Middle East Technical University shared

EMU has also ranked among the world's best universities in the fields of Physical Sciences and Engineering. EMU has been placed within the band of 401-500 in the Physical Sciences category and 501-600 in the Engineering category.





29 OCTOBER STATEMENT FROM EMU-ATAUM

Eastern Mediterranean University Atatürk Research and Application Center (EMU-ATAUM) Chair Assist. Prof. Dr. Turgay Bülent Göktürk released a statement on the occasion of the 100th anniversary of the 29 October Republic Day. Assist. Prof. Dr. Göktürk's statement reads as follows:

"We are experiencing the pride and enthusiasm of celebrating the 100th anniversary of the Republic of Turkey, which was founded after the victory of our great nation, a one heart force uniting against its enemies under the leadership of the eternal Commander-in-Chief Mustafa Kemal Atatürk.

Atatürk succeeded in the National Liberation Struggle, which he started with the motto "either independence or death...", together with his nation, despite all the difficulties, and after liberating the country from the imperialist occupation forces, he introduced the revolutions to bring the Turkish Nation to the level of contemporary civilizations, and he founded the Republic of Turkey, which he described as "My Greatest Work". The Great Leader believed that the Republic, a form of state based on public sovereignty, was the most appropriate form of government for the character of the Turkish nation. The Republic, which he founded with this belief, has reached today on the foundations of a secular, democratic, social state and the rule of law. Atatürk, by harmoniously and efficiently bringing together all the elements that constitute a nation in an extremely modern and advanced manner, ensured the seamless integration of efforts in achieving national goals.

Great Leader Gazi Mustafa Kemal Atatürk, at the end of his great work Great Speech, in which he describes this process, said, "With what I have said here, how a great nation whose national existence has come to an end gained its independence; I tried to explain how the said nation established a national and modern state based on the latest principles of science and technology". This result, in other words, is the Republic; He explained very clearly in his "Address to the Youth" how the Turkish youth will protect this trust. "Turkish Youth! Your first duty is to forever protect and defend the Turkish independence and the



Turkish Republic..." On this meaningful day, he said, "My humble body will surely become soil one day but the Republic of Turkey will live forever". We commemorate Gazi Mustafa Kemal Atatürk, his comrades-in-arms, and all our martyrs who died for the sake of making these lands a homeland, with our feelings of mercy, respect and gratitude, and we wish all Turkish nation a happy 29 October Republic Day. May the Republic continue sheeding light in its 100th year..."

Prof. Dr. Ülker Vancı Osam served as the Acting Rector of EMU from 11 September, 2009, to 15 October, 2009, and as Vice Rector for Social and Cultural Affairs from 16 October, 2009, to 14 October, 2014. From 2 March, 2015, to 1 March, 2019, she held the position of Dean at EMU Faculty of Education. Starting from 1 March, 2019, she continued her service as a faculty member in the Department of Foreign Language Education at EMU Faculty of Education until her retirement on 30 September 2023.
