### “EMU is the Most Deep-Rooted University of TRNC”

Commenced with a Moment of Silence and National Anthem, the ceremony continued

with the opening speeches. Delivering the opening speech of the ceremony, EMU Rector Prof. Dr. Hasan Kılıç thanked President Tatar for being able to attend the event, despite his busy schedule, to deliver the first lecture of the academic semester. Stating that EMU is the most deep-rooted state university of the TRNC, Prof. Dr. Kılıç noted that one of its most important features is that it is an internationalized institution. Emphasizing that over 16 thousand students from more than 100 countries are receiving quality education at EMU, including newly registered students, Prof. Dr. Kılıç also stated that they are a university with academic staff from 35 different countries. Pointing out that there are very few universities in the world that are so closely integrated with countries and cities, Prof. Dr. Kılıç stated that the university is the lifeblood of the TRNC in general and the

## TRNC PRESIDENT ERSİN TATAR DELIVERS THE FIRST LECTURE AT EMU



### “EMU will always continue to Rise”

EMU Board of Trustees President Dr. Erdal Özçenk also delivered a speech, commencing with thanking President Tatar for participating in the event. ## EMU ONCE AGAIN LISTED AMONGST THE BEST IN SHANGHAI RANKING



Being recognized as one of the world's top universities by international independent rating agencies, Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) has once again secured a prominent position among the best in the world according to the 2023 World University Academic Ranking announced by China-based ShanghaiRanking.

### EMU Listed as the First in Turkey and Cyprus

In the 2023 World University Academic Ranking, EMU took the 44th place in the field of "Hospitality and Tourism Management", securing the top position in the Republic of Turkey and across Cyprus. EMU's success in being ranked as the 44th worldwide in Hospitality and Tourism Management makes it the only university from the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus (TRNC) to be included in the list.

Making statements on the topic, EMU Tourism Faculty Dean Prof. Dr. Ali Öztüren expressed that EMU went strength to strength in the Hospitality and Tourism Management ranking list in Academic Ranking of World Universities (ARWU) by the prestigious

ShanghaiRanking. Prof. Dr. Öztüren expressed great pride in EMU's Faculty of Tourism for securing the 44th position in this special ranking, which includes only the top 300 universities worldwide. Prof. Dr. Öztüren noted that this great achievement reflects the quality and the competence of the faculty and said; "This achievement is a product of the valuable work conducted by our esteemed academic personnel and postgraduate students. As the EMU Faculty of Tourism, we are dedicated to continue our success in the future and to work even harder to move forward and improve ourselves". This achievement not only signifies EMU's top position in Turkey and Cyprus but also represents a significant impact on the global ranking in the field of Hospitality and Tourism Management.

On the other hand, EMU was also the only university from Cyprus to be ranked by ShanghaiRanking's Business list. EMU appears in the 401-500 band in the field of Business.

EMU Business and Economics Faculty Dean Prof. Dr. Mustafa Besim expressed that everyone takes pride in EMU's high ranking

among world universities, highlighting that this success underscores EMU's achievements on the international stage. Prof. Dr. Besim said; "This success is the result of persistent hard work. Our faculty members, as well as our master's and doctoral students, conduct high-quality research in our faculty."

The Academic Ranking of World Universities (ARWU) was first published in June 2003 by the Graduate School of Education and the Center for World-Class Universities (CWCU) at Shanghai Jiao Tong University. It has been updated annually since then. Starting from 2009, the copyright and publishing rights for these global rankings were taken over by ShanghaiRanking Consultancy, an independent rating agency based in China. ShanghaiRanking Consultancy, which has no affiliations with any university or government institution, compiles these rankings based on six different indices that primarily consider publications and achievements in various fields. ## 30<sup>th</sup> EURHODIP CONFERENCE HOSTED BY EMU FACULTY OF TOURISM COMMENCES



The 2023 European Association of Hospitality and Tourism Schools (EURHODIP) Conference, organized under the auspices of Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) Faculty of Tourism with the theme ‘Sustainability and Innovation in Tourism and Gastronomy’, commenced on Wednesday, 1 November, 2023, at 8:00 p.m. with an opening ceremony held at Salamis Bay Conti Resort Hotel. 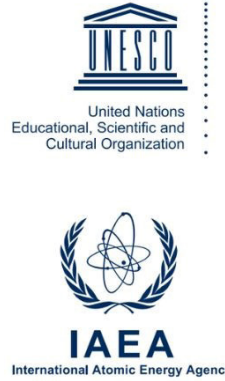

## EMU PHYSICS DEPARTMENT FACULTY MEMBER ASSOC. PROF. DR. ALI ÖVGÜN PARTICIPATED IN THE STRING THEORY, HOLOGRAPHY, AND BLACK HOLES WORKSHOP AT ITALY'S ABDUS SALAM INTERNATIONAL CENTER FOR THEORETICAL PHYSICS



Assoc. Prof. Dr. Ali Övgün from the Faculty of Arts and Sciences, Physics Department at Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU), attended the String Theory, Holography, and Black Holes Workshop held in Trieste, Italy, from 23rd to 27th October, 2023. Organized by the International Centre for Theoretical Physics (ICTP), the said event has been dedicated to the Nobel Laureate Pakistani Physicist Abdus Salam. Assoc. Prof. Dr. Övgün was among the limited number of participants to receive a scholarship from ICTP, allowing him to attend the workshop among numerous applications.

During this prestigious event, Assoc. Prof. Dr. Övgün engaged with leading scientists in the field of theoretical gravitational physics. The workshop hosted approximately 80 international scientists from around the world, including experts from prestigious institutions such as Princeton University, CERN, University of Edinburgh, King's College London, and the University of Amsterdam.

Assoc. Prof. Dr. Ali Övgün holds a significant position among the most influential academics worldwide. In 2023, as a result of a study coordinated by Stanford University involving American and Dutch scientists, Assoc. Prof. Dr. Övgün has been included among the most cited scientists globally. Additionally, he ranks among Turkey's most influential 200 scientists, establishing a significant position within his country's scientific community. Assoc. Prof. Dr. Övgün's active participation in events like the String Theory, Holography, and Black Holes Workshop not only expands the boundaries of scientific knowledge but also contributes to promoting his country and EMU, fostering international collaboration.
