A cooperation protocol has been signed between the Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) and SOS Children's Village Association. The said protocol was signed on Tuesday, 31 January, 2023 at 10:30 a.m. by EMU Rector Prof. Dr. Aykut Hocanın and Refika İnce, the National Director of the SOS Children's Village Association. Present at the signing ceremony were EMU Vice Rector for Student Affairs Prof. Dr. Hüseyin Aktuğlu, EMU Psychological Counseling Guidance and Research Center (EMU – PDRAM) Chair Dr. Ps. Fatoş Özylem, EMU – PDRAM Psychiatrist Dr. Mehmet Yaglı, SOS Children's Village Association Program Director Ahmet Akarsu and National Program Development Consultant Fatma Amcaoğlu.

With the signed cooperation protocol, the parties aim to carry out joint studies that will benefit EMU, SOS and the Turkish Cypriot Community. In his speech, EMU Rector Prof. Dr. Hocanın emphasized that EMU – PDRAM undertakes very important duties and always provides support regarding the psychological problems encountered. Stating that universities have duties in the field of service to community in addition to education and research, Prof. Dr. Hocanın underlined that in this context, the previously existing cooperation with SOS will be put into a wider framework with the said protocol. to take steps for the society to move forward in every field, Prof. Dr. Hocanın emphasized that together with the academic staff who possess specialisation in their chosen fields, they try to support every field with great care. Stating that they are always proud of the work carried out by the SOS Children's Village, Prof. Dr. Hocanın pointed out that the work done is of great importance for the children. Underlining that EMU is ready to provide scientific support, Prof. Dr. Hocanın added that he believed that the protocol would have a more systematic and regular effect in benefiting the children.

In her speech, SOS Children's Village Association National Director İnce underlined that the cooperation with EMU – PDRAM and EMU has continued for many years and emphasized that they are extremely happy to be in cooperation with an institution which possesses expertise in its field and is committed to ethical values. 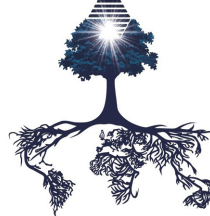

Increasing the number of its graduates every year, the number of EMU's alumni will have reached over 70,000 with the graduation of students in the 2022-2023 Academic Year Fall Semester.

Graduation Reception for Graduates and Parents

Within the framework of the 2022 – 2023 Academic Year Fall Semester Graduation organisations, a Graduation Reception will be held on Monday, 6 February, 2023, at 18.00, with the participation of EMU graduates and their parents who contributed to their success. In addition

to the graduates, academic and administrative staff will attend the reception to be held at the EMU Beach Club and share the happiness of the graduates.

Postgraduate Graduation Ceremony on 7 February

The 2022 - 2023 Academic Year Fall Semester Postgraduate Graduation Ceremony will be held on Tuesday, 7 February, 2023, at 14.00, at Rauf Raif Denktaş Culture and Congress Center. More than 300 graduates of master's and doctorate programs will receive their diplomas at the ceremony.

Graduates of Associate and Undergraduate Programs To Receive Diplomas on 8 February

Graduation Ceremonies, during which graduates of Associate and Undergraduate Programs will receive their diplomas, will be held on Wednesday, 8 February, 2023. More than 800 associate and undergraduate

degree graduates will be presented their diplomas at the ceremony to be held at the time and place designated for each Faculty.

In this context, on Wednesday, 8 February, 2023, at Rauf Raif Denktaş Culture and Congress Center, students of Faculty of Architecture will be presented their diplomas between 09.00 a.m. and 11.00 a.m., School of Tourism and Hotel Management and School of Computing and Technology between 13.00 and 15.00, and Faculty of Health Sciences and School of Health Services between 17.00 and 19.00.

During the ceremonies to be held at the Lala Mustafa Paşa Sports Center, graduates of the Faculty of Business and Economics and the School of Business and Finance will receive their diplomas between 09.00 and 11.00, graduates of the Faculty of Arts and Sciences and the Faculty of Education will be presented diplomas between 13.00 and 15.00. Graduates of the Faculty of Engineering will receive diplomas between 17.00 and 19.00.

As for the ceremonies to be held in Mustafa Afşin Ersoy Hall, graduates of the following faculties and school will be presented diplomas according to the following schedule: Faculty of Communication between 09.00 a.m. and 11.00 a.m.; Faculty of Pharmacy between 13.00 and 15.00, and Faculty of Law and School of Justice between 17.00 and 19.00.

During the ceremonies commencing with a moment of silence and the National Anthem, speeches on behalf of the graduates and protocol speeches will be delivered. EMU REPRESENTED AT TESOL

Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU), Foreign Languages and English Preparatory School academic staff Sen. Inst. Elif Çilli represented EMU at "Teaching English to Speakers of Other Languages" (TESOL) Turkey's Measurement, Evaluation, Testing & Assessment Special Interest Group (METASIG) at an event organised at Nevşehir Hacı Bektaş Veli University.

49 participants from 28 different universities took part in the event, which was held with the theme of "An Overview of Assessing Language Use". After the keynote presentations, the participants had the chance to work in small groups to share their experiences, ideas and challenges in assessing language use. At the end



of the group work, all groups shared information and exchanged ideas about the problems that were on the agenda. Çilli, who is among the founding members of TESOL Turkey METASIG 2022, stated that METASIG

will continue to organize events that will contribute to the field of language assessment in 2023 and to support its colleagues in the application of reliable, valid and practical approaches to language assessment.
