



## EMU RECTOR PROF. DR. AYKUT HOCANIN ATTENDS THE 256<sup>TH</sup> INTERUNIVERSITY BOARD MEETING





Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) Rector Prof. Dr. Aykut Hocanin attended the 256th Interuniversity Board Meeting which was held in İzmir this year. The meeting was held at Prof. Dr. Yusuf Vardar Pre-Vocational Basic Sciences Institute Culture Center in Ege University and was attended by Republic of Türkiye Council of Higher Education (YÖK) President Prof. Dr. Erol Özvar, YÖK Deputy President Prof. Dr. H. Haldun Göktaş, Higher Education Executive Board members Prof. Dr. Naci Gündoğan and Prof. Dr. Ömer Açıkgöz, YÖK member Prof. Dr. Hüseyin Karaman, Interuniversity Board Chair Prof. Dr. Mustafa Alişarlı and rectors of the universities operating within the body of YÖK.

Delivering the opening speech of the meeting, the President of YÖK Prof. Dr. Erol Özvar noted that they will call for projects to diversify and accelerate R&D (researchdeveloment) studies for universities in the earthquake region. Moreover, Prof. Dr. Özvar stated that they will continue to support the redevelopment of the regions damaged by the earthquake, together with all internal and external stakeholders.

Following the speech, the rectors of Association of European Universities member universities and Prof. Dr. Özvar met with the rectors including EMU Rector Prof. Dr. Aykut Hocanın.

### L.N. GUMILYOV EURASIAN NATIONAL UNIVERSITY FROM KAZAKHSTAN VISITS EMU



Vice Rector of Kazahkstan L.N. Gumilyov Eurasian National University Zhanna Kurmangalieyva, Department of International Cooperation Director Anastassiya Karmelyuk and, Commercialization and Innovation Department Director Assel Jexembayeva paid a visit to Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) Rector's Office. The visit took place on Thursday, 30 March 2023 at 14:30 where EMU Rector Prof. Dr. Aykut Hocanın and Vice Rector Prof. Dr. Hasan Demirel met with L.N. Prof. Dr. Hocanin and Prof. Dr. Demirel expressed their contentedness on hosting L.N. Gumilyov Eurasian National University officials here in EMU. At the end of the visit, Prof. Dr. Hocanin presented EMU and Cypriot souvenirs to the guests.



## EMU HOSTS AN EVENT TITLED "5 WOMEN – 5 ARCHITECTS-5 VIEWS, 5 WOMEN – 5 DESIGNERS- 1 EXHIBITION"







A panel and exhibition titled '5 Women - 5 Architects - 5 Views, 5 Women - 5 Designers - 1 Exhibition was held at the Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) Faculty of Architecture on the occasion of the International Women's Day. The event, held in cooperation with the EMU Architecture Faculty Housing Education and Research Center (HERA-C) and the EMU Urban Research and Development Center (URDC), highlighted the transformative role of women in society and the importance of producing together with the slogan "Together We Are Stronger".

The panel started after the opening addresses of the HERA-C Executive Board Chair and URDC Executive Board Vice Chair Assist. Prof. Dr. Pinar Uluçay and EMU Architecture Faculty Dean Prof. Dr. Alpar Atun. EMU Vice Rector for Social and Cultural Affairs Prof. Dr. Deniz İşçioğlu, students from Lefke Gazi High School and Lapta Yavuzlar High School, EMU Architecture Faculty undergraduate and postgraduate students, faculty members and graduates also attended the event.

During the panel which took place under the moderation of Prof. Dr. Türkan Ulusu Uraz and Assist. Prof. Dr. Seyit Ermiyagil, the journeys of women architects in their professional practice were questioned within the scope of their 'places' and roles in the family and society. How the socio-cultural environment affects the daily life practices of architect women and their practice areas in the architectural profession, the roles that women undertake in the architectural profession and the concept of gender were points of focus.

Prof. Dr. Selen Ermiyagil Abbasoğlu, Isı Metal Çelik Ltd.'s Lead Project Manager and Executive Board Member of the Chamber of Architects Simzer Kaya, and Miro Designroom Director and Chair of the Editorial Board of the Chamber of Architects Münevver Özgür Özersay delicered presentations in the event.

Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) was named the best university in Northern Cyprus and the second best higher education and research institution in the whole island in the Physical Sciences category of the 2022 universities and institutes ranking of Nature Index. Whilst EMU Faculty of Arts and Sciences has achieved significant success in Nature Index in the last five years,

the Department of Physics, which is under the roof of the faculty, continued to be the department contributing the most to this success. Nature Index makes monthly and annual success rankings by indexing articles on Medicine, Health, Physics and Astronomy, Chemistry, Earth and Environmental Sciences published in 82 of the world's most respected academic journals. The academic staff members of the Physics Department operating under the EMU Faculty of Arts and Sciences have contributed greatly to the achieved success. All of the 7 scientific articles published in prestigious academic journals in 2022, scanned by the Nature Index and addressed to EMU, were produced by the faculty members of the Physics Department.

### EMU BECOMES CHAMPION IN BASKETBALL, WRESTLING AND FUTSAL

Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) Women's Basketball Team, Men's Wrestling Team and Men's Futsal Team operating under the EMU Sports Affairs Directorate became the champions in the interuniversity tournaments organized by Northern Cyprus University Sports Federation (KKÜSF).

EMU Women's Basketball Team was crowned champion after defeating Girne American University with a score of 72-35 on Monday, 27 March 2023 at 18:30 during a match held at Kyrenia Ertuğrul Apakan Sports Complex. Making a statement following the match, EMU Women's Basketball Team Coach Enver Tatlıcıoğlu expressed that the team has been continuing their preparations since the first semester and stated that they have clinched the success they have achieved in the regional league in the Republic of Türkiye in the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus (TRNC).

### Men's Wrestling Team Holds the Championship Award for the Last 4 Years

EMU Men's Wrestling Team obtained a total of 185 points and became the champion in the wrestling competition also organized by KKÜSF which was held at Rifat Sener Wrestling Hall. EMU Wrestling Team members İsmail Kurşun in 57 kg, Mertcan Yılmaz in 61 kg, Serhat Atlı in 74 kg, Adnan Özcevher in 86 kg and Derda Torun in 125 kg completed their matches in first place. On the other hand, Cenk Kaya in 65 kg, Ali Kurşun in 70 kg and Bahadır Özcan in 97 kg completed the competition in second place. Talking on the subject, team coach Beha Evren Karabulutoğlu stated that the EMU Men's team has been the champion in wrestling for the last four years and has not left this championship to any other team, adding that if the necessary conditions are met, their aim is to participate in international organizations, to represent the TRNC in tournaments to be held in Bulgaria and Moldova, and to achieve similar successes.

## Men's Futsal Team is the Undefeated Champion

16 teams competed in four groups in the interuniversity futsal tournament organized by KKÜSF. In the tournament where the group winners qualified for the semi-finals, EMU Futsal Men's Team, which finished first in their group, qualified for the final by beating Final International University 12-2 in the semi-finals. The final match took place on Thursday, 30 March 2023 at Nicosia Atatürk Sports Complex where EMU Men's Futsal Team defeated Near East University with a score







of 7-4. Team coaches Osman Konnolu and Beha Evren Karabulutoğlu stated that a very good team was formed in futsal and a championship that became a habit was experienced again. Konnolu and Karabulutoğlu also noted that the EMU Men's Futsal Team was aiming for a championship in the inter-university futsal tournament that is planned to be held in the Republic of Türkiye this year, but that they will not be able to participate in this tournament this year due to the earthquake disaster. They also emphasized that they want to maintain the championship habit in the Republic of Türkiye.

Making a statement on the achievements of EMU sports teams, EMU Sports Affairs Directore Cemal Konnolu congratulated all the coaches and athletes on their success. Emphasizing that EMU sports teams always take the field with the aim of becoming a champion in national and international tournaments, Konnolu stated that EMU is a school of champions.
