“As an EMU graduate, Make A Difference”

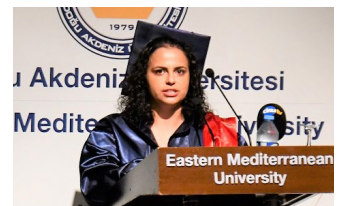
Speaking at the opening of the ceremony, EMU
