The ceremony commenced with an opening speech by EMU Rector, Prof. Dr. Hasan Kılıç, who congratulated colleagues contributing to the scientific world with their productivity and expressed pride in their achievements. Prof. Dr. Kılıç highlighted EMU as one of the country's oldest universities, stating that since its inception as the Higher Technology Institute with a cohort of 100 students in 1979, it has graduated over 75,000 students and transformed from a small building into a vast campus. Prof. Dr. Kılıç emphasized that EMU not only excels internationally but also plays a crucial role in serving the community through its endeavors.

"The Value of Information Should Be Acknowledged More"

Prof. Dr. Kılıç emphasized EMU's status as the country's reference point in higher education, recognized by top international ranking institutions as a flagship university. He underscored the significant contribution of EMU academics in the international arena, their information sharing, and accomplishments to this recognition. Highlighting the need to realign the relationship between policymakers and academia based on the value of knowledge, Prof. Dr. Kılıc noted the pivotal role universities play in a country's development, citing how developed nations utilize knowledge produced by universities to enhance their citizens' quality of life.

Prof. Dr. Kılıç also reminded the audience of the founding purpose of Bologna University, the world's oldest continuously operating university established about 1,000 years ago, also an institution which has a joint postgraduate program with

EMU Faculty of Law. He emphasized that beyond ensuring professions become more scientific, the aim was to disseminate produced knowledge to society, allowing the community to embrace and further develop this knowledge.

He extended his gratitude to all academics for their contributions to science, EMU's visibility, and promotion on behalf of the EMU family, wishing them continued success.

During the ceremony, EMU Rector Prof. Dr. Hasan Kılıç presented Certificates of Congratulations to academics listed in the Top 2% of Scientists in the World by Stanford University. Additionally, based on evaluations by the EMU Research Advisory Board, academics entitled to receive the Academic Award for 2022 were honored with Faculty/School Publication Achievement, Research Incentive, and
















GREAT SUCCESS FROM EMU FACULTY OF TOURISM DEPARTMENT OF GASTRONOMY AND CULINARY ARTS STUDENTS





Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) Faculty of Tourism, Gastronomy and Culinary Arts Department students and Tower Training and Practice Restaurant team participated in the 20th International Istanbul Gastronomy Days Competition organized by Cooks and Chefs Federation of Turkey (TASFED) on 13-16 December, 2023 in Istanbul. The EMU students and team won the biggest prize titled the Grand Prix award along with the Turkish Golden Chef of the Year cup and total of 24 medals; 15 golden, 7 silver and, 2 bronze.

Supervised by the EMU Faculty of Tourism academic staff member and World Association of Chefs' Societies (WACS) member Chef Kurtuluş Özbaşar, EMU team consisted of Research Assistant Fatma Öztunç, Part-time academic staff member Hatice Kumaş and, Gastronomy and Culinary Arts Department students Günseli Kafa, Batuhan Yiğit Bayram, Nujin Dilba Karakulak, Alikaan Yeğilmez and Hasan Çatal.

Making a statement on the topic, EMU Faculty of Tourism Vice Dean Assist. Prof. Dr. M. Güven Ardahan noted that the achievement of the team is not a coincidence but is a result of experienced teaching staff, physical infrastructure as well as the support provided by the university. Moreover, Vice Dean Assist. Prof. Dr. M. Ardahan expressed pride in the continuation of the high performance the team had shown in the previous competitions they participated in.

EMU Faculty of Tourism Dean Prof. Dr. Ali Öztüren also made a statement and said: "The event, which is Turkey's largest gastronomy competition and festival, has been held in collaboration with the World Association of Chefs' Societies (WACS) for 20 years, hosting the international gastronomy community in Turkey. The event, held in partnership with federations and associations of leading countries in the world of gastronomy, was organized with intense interest this year, as in previous years. The festival, which has played a

significant role in the integration of Turkish cuisine with world cuisine, brought global flavors to Istanbul. International Istanbul Gastronomy Days, recently awarded with the title of "Intercontinental" by the World Association of Chefs' Societies (WACS) through successful previous events, has provided an opportunity for competition at the international level for students in the Gastronomy and Culinary Arts Departments in both Turkey and Northern Cyprus, as well as for young chefs.".

Prof. Dr. Öztüren thanked Research Assistant Fatma Öztunç and Part-time academic staff member Hatice Kumaş who have made great contributions in the team's preparation process and who also participated during the competition along with the team members. Moreover, Prof. Dr. Öztüren also thanked academic staff member Kurtuluş Özbaşar who supervised the team during the process and expressed that the success achieved by the team is a sign of quality in education. Finally, Prof. Dr. Öztüren thanked EMU Rector's Office who have always provided support and, all the other individuals for their contributions.

Record Breaking Number of Medals and Cups

According to the competition results, Fatma Öztunç, Hatice Kumaş, and Nujin Dilba Karakulak from SPT1 - Grand Prix Chefs Team secured a gold medal and a cup. Additionally, Fatma Öztunç won a gold medal and a cup in SP6 - Golden Turkish

Chef of the Year category, a silver medal in SP3 - Master Fish category, and a gold medal in SP10 - Restaurant Dessert Plate category.

Additionally, Nujin Dilba Karakulak won silver medals in JP6 - Restaurant Dessert category, and JP7 - Fish Competition and a gold medal in JP7II - Golden Young Chef of the Year categories, while Alikaan Yeğilmez won silver medals in JP8 - Pasta Competition and JP6 - Restaurant Dessert categories. Hasan Çatal secured a silver medal in JP8 - Pasta Competition and Hatice Kumaş won a gold medal SP11 - Modern Turkish Cuisine.

Günseli Kafa won a bronze medal in JP6 - Restaurant Dessert, a silver medal in JP9 - Main Course and a gold medal in JP7 - Fish Competition categories. Batuhan Yiğit Bayram earned a bronze medal in JP7 - Fish Competition and a gold medal in JP9 - Main Course category. Finally, Alikaan Yegilmez, Batuhan Yiğit Bayram, and Hasan Çatal claimed gold medals in JPT1 - Practical Team Competition and JPT2 - Best University Team of the Year Competition.

On the other hand, EMU Faculty of Tourism, Gastronomy and Culinary Arts Department students and Tower Training and Practice Restaurant team members returned to the island with their medals and trophies on Sunday, 17 December, 2023. PRESTIGIOUS SCIENTIFIC ARTICLES CONTINUE TO BE PUBLISHED

WITH THE COLLABORATION OF EMU AND UNIVERSITY OF OXFORD

The diagnosis of endometriosis, a chronical disease, is often delayed worldwide for various reasons; and this not only poses a challenge for patients and their families but also imposes a significant economic burden on healthcare systems. The data collected from the Eastern Mediterranean region is extremely limited. A study has been carried out on endometriosis with the intention of making up the insufficient data from the Eastern Mediterranean region. Researchers from the University of Oxford, Cyprus Women's Health Research Society (COHERS) and Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU), Faculty of Arts and Sciences, Department of Biological Sciences participated in the said study. The outcomes of the study were published on 9 December, 2023 in European Journal of Public Health.

According to the information provided by principal researcher of the project Dr.

Nilüfer Rahmioğlu, the study published in this highly prestigious journal represented a groundbreaking achievement. It has revealed, through the analysis of data collected from 7,646 women, that the prevalence of endometriosis is approximately 10% lower compared to global data. However, Dr. Rahmioğlu also noted that the data indicate the presence



of many undiagnosed cases within the community. In addition to this, a 7-year delay in the diagnosis of the endometriosis was observed in the community. This study showed that women receive a diagnosis from a doctor approximately 7 years after experiencing the initial symptoms of the disease.

Being one of the researchers participated in the study, EMU Faculty of Arts and Sciences, Biological Sciences Department Chair Prof. Dr. Bahar Taneri emphasized the importance of such collaborative studies and noted that the outcomes of the study shed light on the determination of public health policies, particularly in improving access to better diagnosis and treatment options for patients. EMU Law Faculty also achieved an important success by being ranked as the second-best Law Faculty in Cyprus. In

the ranking where EduRank evaluates universities worldwide based on scientific publications and number of citations, only 15 universities in Cyprus offering Law education were included.

The EMU Law Faculty proudly secured the second position across Cyprus, marking a honorable achievement. Additionally,

the faculty climbed to the 496th position in Europe, marking another significant success. EduRank stands among the most respected evaluation organizations globally as it not only focuses on academic success but also considers the faculty's visibility, career achievements of its graduates, and the publications and work of its faculty members.

Head of the Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) Department of Architecture Prof. Dr. Rafooneh Mokhtarshahi Sani has been appointed to serve on the 2023-24 NAAB International Committee by Stephen Schreiber, President of the National Architectural Accrediting Board (NAAB), one of the most important architectural education accreditation organizations in the world.

The International Committee oversees the accreditation programs and activities of architecture schools outside the United States (US). This committee also supervises programs and activities related to evaluating education references of undergraduate candidates educated abroad, concerning NAAB's architecture accreditation, and liaises with the NAAB Board regarding international partnerships.

Academic Prestige of the Department of Architecture

Outside the US, in our nearby geographical region, only three architecture schools hold NAAB ICert Accreditations: two in the Republic of Turkey and one at EMU. Based on the list of International Committee members, Prof. Dr. Rafooneh Mokthtarshahi Sani is the sole appointee from the region, emphasizing the significance of this appointment as an indicator of the



academic prestige of EMU Department of Architecture.

This prestigious appointment highlights the distinction of EMU Department of Architecture from other architectural schools in the region, signaling EMU's influential position on the international arena.


47 Projects from 22 Universities Competed

Educate yourself about early detection of lung cancer. If you smoke or used to smoke, you may be a candidate for lung cancer screening between the ages of 50 and 80. Quitting smoking may involve nicotine replacement therapy,

pharmacotherapy (medications that reduce the desire for smoking), or a combination of both.
