TURKEY – TRNC INTER-PARLIAMENTARY FRIENDSHIP GROUP VISITS EMU



The President of the Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) Board of Trustees Dr. Erdal Özçenk, stated that during their visit to Turkey a month ago, they were warmly welcomed, adding “All doors were opened to us who came from the sister country”. Describing EMU as the jewel of the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus (TRNC), Dr. Özçenk acknowledged that the university occasionally faces crises, with the recent crisis being influenced by high inflation, the pandemic, and the earthquake. Dr. Özçenk asserted, “We will overcome this crisis. We are tidying our home. After this, we will continue our path as usual. We do not owe a single penny to anyone”. The Co-Chair of the TRNC and TR Inter-Parliamentary Friendship Group and TRNC Member of Parliament Resmiye Canaltay,

highlighted in her speech that EMU is the most distinguished institution in Famagusta, emphasizing its importance in the development of the city. Canaltay, stating, “There is no other university like EMU, neither in the North nor in the South,” expressed her wish for EMU to reach even brighter days, mentioning the support they provide as members of the Budget Committee. Canaltay emphasized the significant importance of universities for the country, stating that the dissemination of the light of science by universities plays a crucial role in the country’s development. Orhan Erdem, the Chair of the TR-TRNC Inter-Parliamentary Friendship Group and Member of Parliament from Konya, mentioned that education is one of the wings contributing to the strengthening and take off of Northern

Cyprus. Underscoring positive steps in this regard, Erdem highlighted the university’s reaching a student population of up to 100,000. Erdem also acknowledged tourism as the other wing, affirming their continuous support for education, especially when it comes to sensitive issues related to TRNC.

At the end of the visit, where detailed information about EMU was provided, Orhan Erdem presented a gift to Prof. Dr. Kılıç, and in return, Prof. Dr. Kılıç gifted Orhan Erdem a silk embroidery panel unique to Cyprus. Also, EMU Board of Trustees Member and Political Affairs Advisor to the Presidency of the TRNC Anıl Kaya presented a gift to Ahmet Erbaş, Member of the Grand Assembly of Türkiye from Kütahya.

TRNC DEPUTY PRIME MINISTRY, MINISTRY OF TOURISM, CULTURE, YOUTH AND ENVIRONMENT AND EASTERN MEDITERRANEAN UNIVERSITY SIGNS A SCIENTIFIC COLLABORATION PROTOCOL



A scientific collaboration protocol has been signed between Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus (TRNC) Deputy Prime Ministry, Ministry of Tourism, Culture, Youth and Environment and Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) Eastern Mediterranean Cultural Heritage Research Center (EMUCHRC). The protocol aims to ensure the preservation of the cultural heritage of the island through collaboration between the Department of Antiquities and Museums and EMU, and to transfer it to future generations within a sustainable framework through scientific research.

The signing ceremony of the protocol took place in the Ministry's conference room and was attended by the Deputy Prime Minister of TRNC, Minister of

Tourism, Culture, Youth and Environment, Fikri Ataoğlu, Undersecretary Serhan Aktunç, EMU Rector Prof. Dr. Hasan Kılıç, Coordinator of the Development and Economic Cooperation Office of the Embassy of the Republic of Turkey in Nicosia, Ömer Cihan, and the President of EMU CHRC, Assoc. Prof. Dr. Bülent Kızılduman.

Within the scope of the protocol, archaeological excavations are planned to be carried out at King's Hill in the village of Kaleburnu and surface research to determine archaeological cultural assets in the Karpaz Peninsula. The collaboration between the Department of Antiquities and Museums and EMU aims particularly at identifying and documenting the neglected architectural values of the Ottoman period on the island.

“A Unique and Informative Experience”

Delivering a speech during the event, EMU Art Coordinator and “Denktaş in the Memories of EMU” Exhibition Curator Zehra Şonya expressed that it has been a unique and informative experience to hold an exhibition for an unforgettable leader. Stating that there has been exhibitions about Founding President Rauf Raif Denktaş in the past, Şonya said that they have examined these exhibitions and they adopted a different concept with an archival approach to avoid similarities and repetitions. Through this approach, they aimed to make the contributions of Rauf Raif Denktaş to this university more visible with photographs and documents, ensuring a distinct perspective.

“We Remember with Love, Respect, Gratitude and Longing”

EMU Vice Rector for Student Affairs Prof. Dr. Sonuç Zorlu also delivered a speech and stated that as the Vice Rector’s office take care to organize such important events at the Social and Cultural Activities Directorate. Prof. Dr. Zorlu mentioned that they wanted to commemorate late Founding President Rauf Raif Denktaş with an exhibition on his 12th death anniversary. Thanking everyone who contributed in the organization of the exhibition, Prof. Dr. Zorlu expressed the hope that such events would continue to increase and, emphasized their desire to create awareness and show gratitude, stating that they remember the Founding President Rauf Raif Denktaş with love, respect, gratitude, and longing.

“Denktaş, the Great Leader of the Challenging Years”

Commencing his speech by pointing out the exhibition about Founding President Rauf Raif Denktaş was being held at the building named after him, Rauf Raif Denktaş Culture and Congress Center, Famagusta Mayor Dr. Süleyman Uluçay emphasized that Denktaş was a leader with significant contributions to the existential struggle of the Turkish Cypriot Community. Noting the importance of such efforts in better explaining the Existential Struggle of the Turkish Cypriot Community and its leaders to the youth and aiming to narrate the events of that period, Dr. Uluçay shared an interesting anecdote from the construction of the Baykal Tunnel used for the evacuation of the civilian population during the 1974 Peace Operation, and discussed the challenges faced during the Existential Struggle between 1963-1974. He conveyed their respectful acknowledgment of the great leader of those challenging years, the Founding President Rauf Raif Denktaş. Emphasizing EMU as a crucial institution in the higher education sector of the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus, Dr. Uluçay acknowledged that although EMU faces some difficulties due to the disadvantages of being a state university, it contributes significantly not only to Famagusta but also to the entire country. Dr. Uluçay called on all authorities to support EMU as an exemplary organization academically and administratively and, expressed their commitment in Famagusta to uphold EMU and the significant struggle in the Existential Struggle.

Prof. Dr. Eda Becer, faculty member at the Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) Faculty of Pharmacy, participated as an invited speaker in the January meeting of the 2023-2024 Seminar Series organized by the

Department of Medical Biology at Istanbul University-Cerrahpaşa, Cerrahpaşa Faculty of Medicine. The online meeting attracted significant interest with Prof. Dr. Eda Becer's presentation titled 'What Plants Say through the Eyes of a Biochemist.' The meeting was attended by faculty members, as well as master's and doctoral students from the Department of Medical Biology.

During the meeting, Prof. Dr. Eda Becer provided information about the historical use of medicinal plants, the potential use of plants in preventing and treating cancer, neurodegenerative diseases, and other illnesses. Prof. Dr. Becer's research on the use of plants in cancer treatment received great attention during the meeting. Additionally, examples of research

on in vitro neurodegenerative diseases and various disease models were presented, facilitating knowledge exchange with faculty members from the Cerrahpaşa Faculty of Medicine.

The meeting included discussions on global commercial market analyses of medicinal and aromatic plants, as well as Turkey's position in this market. Researchers who attended the meeting exchanged information on the safe use of herbal products and Traditional and Complementary Medicine (T&CM) centers. The meeting emphasized once again the importance of the responsibilities of academicians in plant-derived drug research, highlighting their significant contribution to public health.
