"EMU is the Source of Pride for this Country"

Addressing everyone at the meeting, TRNC President Ersin Tatar touched on the recent financial struggles of EMU, attributing its causes to the pandemic period, high cost of living, the Russia-Ukraine war, and the impact of the February 6 earthquake, which resulted in difficulties in student enrollment. President Tatar

stated, "EMU, in my opinion, has experienced some of its worst times, and extraordinary efforts have been made to overcome these challenges". President Tatar expressed gratitude to those who contributed to achieving consensus on issues such as funding from the state, balance sheet arrangements, and making some sacrifices. Emphasizing EMU's significance as a pride of the country, President Tatar mentioned encountering EMU graduates holding ministerial, parliamentary, and institutional positions in various countries. President Tatar expressed his hope for the preservation and strengthening of EMU's brand value. Tatar stated that EMU has left its toughest days behind and expressed his wish for its continued growth, contributing more to Famagusta and the TRNC

Also delivering a speech during the visit, EMU VYK President Dr. Erdal Özcenk mentioned the financial crisis that the EMU has been struggling with for a time and, thanked President Tatar for always supporting the university during such difficult time. Expressing that EMU is the locomotive of higher education in TRNC, Dr. Özcenk said: "Firstly, as the employees, we must take good care of this locomotive. Moreover, we should feel the strength and support of our government. We have felt this

support from our government and our President in the recent times".

EMU Will Take Its Rightful Place

In his speech, EMU Rector Prof. Dr. Hasan Kılıc stated that for the first time in EMU history, a protocol was signed with the consensus of all stakeholders, emphasizing the importance they attach to the government's support. Noting that they closely follow the sensitivity of President Tatar, Prof. Dr. Kılıc said that the protocol entrusted them with a responsibility, and with this responsibility, they aim to bring the university not only with its problems but also with its successes to a position where it is wellrepresented abroad. Prof. Dr. Kılıç underlined that EMU is a university supported by all segments of society, conveying that they will act with this responsibility and consciousness, and with the support of the President and the government, they will take the university to where it deserves.

At the end of the visit, EMU Rector Prof. Dr. Hasan Kılıç presented President Ersin Tatar a silver plate for the governments contributions in overcoming the financial crisis of our University.

INTER VOCATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL KNOWLEDGE AND SKILL COMPETITION HOSTED BY EMU













Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) hosted Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus (TRNC) Inter Vocational High School Knowledge and Skill Competition organized in collaboration with Vocational and Technical Education Department operating under the TRNC Ministry of National Education. 

"SUSTAINABLE GASTRONOMY" WORKSHOP HELD IN COLLABORATIONS OF TOURISM CLUB AND FAMAGUSTA RAVELIN CLUB

In collaboration with Tourism Club operating under the Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU), Social and Cultural Activities Directorate and, the Famagusta Ravelin Club, a workshop was organized with the purpose of supporting sustainable gastronomy and tourism with zero-waste concept.

In the first event, moderated by EMU Faculty of Tourism academic staff member and Chef Münevver Gürel, a gastronomy workshop was organized focusing on the use of lemon. In the said event, participant made lemonade with lemon juice and, lemon jam with lemon peels. With the said event, it was aimed to contribute to reducing food waste and to enhance environmental awareness among participants. Emphasis was placed on using every part of the lemon to minimize waste during the event. Participants gained practical experience in sustainable cooking practices. At the end of the workshop, attention was given to transforming surplus production into marketable products, with the aim of showcasing these products at the Tourism Club stand during the upcoming EMU Tourism Week.

On the other hand, in the second event organized within the scope of the workshop, participants



went to "ayrelli" (a type of wild asparagus found in Cyprus) picking accompanied by a guide. The event consisted the introduction of the product, appropriate cooking techniques and tasting. The aim of this workshop was to raise awareness about wild food sources and to promote eco-friendly tourism activities. The event focused on integrating wild food sources into ecotourism and provided information about local ecosystems and biodiversity.

The events encouraged the reevaluation of surplus products and the ethical harvesting of wild asparagus, contributing to the reduction of food waste and the conservation of natural resources. Participants gained knowledge and skills about sustainable gastronomy practices that they can apply in their daily lives and professional endeavors, thereby increasing awareness about integrating zero waste principles into culinary tourism experiences.

SPECIAL EDUCATION CLUB MEMBERS RECEIVE TRAINING ON ADULT AND CHILD-ORIENTED BASIC LIFE SUPPORT AND FIRST AID



Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU), Health Sciences Faculty, Department of Nursing academic staff member Assoc. Prof. Dr. Gülten Sucu Dağ and senior instructor Dr. Gülcan Dürüst Sakallı provided "Adult and Child-Oriented Basic Life Support and First Aid Training" for EMU Special Education Club member students. The theoretical part of the training, which was carried out in two phases as theoretical and applied, covered topics such as Basic Life Support for Adults-Children-Infants, Airway Obstruction, First Aid Practices for Bleeding and Injuries, and First Aid for individuals experiencing epilepsy seizures. Following the theoretical portion of the training, participants engaged in hands-on practice sessions using models to apply the learned topics.
