COUNCIL OF HIGHER EDUCATION AUDIT BOARD PRESIDENT VISITS EMU RECTOR PROF. DR. HASAN KILIÇ

Council of Higher Education (YÖK), Higher Education Audit Board President Ercan Özkan and an accompanying delegation paid a courtesy visit to Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) Rector Prof. Dr. Hasan Kılıç. Various topics concerning higher education were discussed during the said visit. Potential solutions for transfer issues regarding international students, horizontal transfer procedures, and the YÖK system were discussed and assessed.

Also present during the meeting were EMU Vice Rectors Prof. Dr. Osman M. Karatepe, Prof. Dr. Salih Katırcıoğlu, Prof. Dr. Sonuç Zorlu and EMU General Secretary Derviş Ekşici.

"EMU - The University Most Aligned with YÖK Standards"

As part of the visit, EMU Rector Prof. Dr. Hasan Kılıç provided extensive information about EMU,

noting that the university has over 77.000 alumni members. Stressing that EMU is a transparent educational institution, Prof. Dr. Kılıç underlined the university's dedication to maintaining high educational standards. Pointing out that all universities must comply with unified criteria across financial, academic, and administrative areas, Prof. Dr. Kılıç also noted that, as a state university, EMU sets a strong example in this respect. Prof. Dr. Kılıç emphasized the importance of auditing academic standards and stated that EMU has encountered no difficulties in applying YÖK standards on an international scale. Prof. Dr. Kılıç remarked, "EMU is a benchmark in this respect".

Ercan Özkan, the President of YÖK Audit Board, mentioned that they work closely with YÖDAK

to monitor and oversee universities in the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus (TRNC). Özkan highlighted the noticeable improvements in the education system over the last four years and stressed the importance of utilizing EMU's extensive educational experience as the most established institution in the TRNC. Özkan also shared that the evaluation and reporting processes of universities are conducted regularly and sought insights from EMU Rector Prof. Dr. Kılıç regarding the issues faced by international students.

At the end of the said visit, EMU Rector Prof. Dr. Hasan Kılıç presented traditional Cypriot souvenirs to Higher Education Audit Board President Ercan Özkan and the visiting delegation.

EMU AGROBOTIX team from the Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) will be competing in the finals of the Teknofest TRNC 2025 organized by the Türkiye Technology Team (T3) to be held at the old terminal building of Ercan Airport between the dates of 1-4 May 2025. EMU is among the institutional stakeholders of this year's event.

EMU AGROBOTIX team supervised by EMU Faculty of Engineering, Department of Mechanical Engineering academic staff member Prof. Dr. Qasim Zeeshan will participate in Agriculture category of TEKNOFEST TRNC 2025 Research Project Competition with their project titled "Akıllı Tarım için Hibrit Mobilite AGROBOT / Hybrid Mobility AGROBOT for Smart Agriculture".

The project aimed to develop an AGROBOT with a quadcopter setup that can both roll and fly, offering omnidirectional functionality, and capable of conducting health monitoring of agricultural products from a 360-degree angle.

In their remarks, EMU AGROBOTIX Team said; "Northern Cyprus is renowned for its olive and citrus trees. However, farmers face challenges such as a lack of mechanization, labor shortages, soil drought, pests, and plant diseases. The goal of the proposed project is to address these issues by providing solutions. Our objective is to offer smart farming solutions to local producers who grow large quantities of agricultural products like olives and citrus for the production of fruit juices, pastes, jams, olives, and olive oil".

EMU RIDERS TEAM TO COMPETE IN TEKNOFEST FINALS WITH DATAHARVEST PROJECT

With their DataHarvest Project, EMU Riders team from the Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) will be competing in the finals of TEKNOFEST TRNC 2025 organized by the Türkiye Technology Team (T3). EMU is among the institutional stakeholders of this year's event.

During the finals of TEKNOFEST TRNC 2025, to be held on 1-4 May 2025 at the Old Terminal Building of Ercan Airport, EMU Riders Team will compete with their developed project featuring a digital system

designed to enhance the efficiency and intelligence of agriculture in the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus (TRNC).

Consisting of EMU students, the members of EMU Riders team are EMU Computer Engineering Department students Yusuf Eren Çakır who is the team leader, Mithatcan Sonsuz and Sümeyye Kaynak as well as Software Engineering Department students Emirkan Eşme and Arda Günsüren.

DataHarvest: New Face of Smart Farming

Making remarks on the topic, EMU Riders Team stated; "DataHarvest: The New Face of Smart Farming was created to address the growing challenges faced by agriculture. In TRNC, farming is becoming increasingly difficult due to drought and the limitations of

traditional techniques. DataHarvest provides a modern solution by using sensors placed in the field to gather data on temperature, humidity, and rainfall. This data is then transferred online, analysed by artificial intelligence, and presented to farmers in clear, easy-to-understand recommendations. The solar-powered system stands out with its open-source design and TRNC-specific solutions. Moreover, it is about 50% more affordable than similar systems, making it an accessible solution for individual farmers and small businesses. With DataHarvest, farmers gain a clearer understanding of the needs of their land. This leads to increased crop yields, reduced water waste, and enhanced environmental sustainability. DataHarvest offers a local, smart, and costeffective solution for TRNC agriculture".

EMU-HUNEC 2025 TEAM TO COMPETE IN THE ENVIRONMENT AND ENERGY CATEGORY OF TEKNOFEST FINALS

Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) HUNEC Team is getting ready to compete in the finals of TEKNOFEST TRNC 2025 in the category of environment and energy. EMU is among the institutional stakeholders of this year's event. In the competition to be held between May 1–4, 2025, at the Old Terminal Building of Ercan Airport where

three teams from EMU will compete in the finals. Among these teams, the EMU HUNEC 2025 team will take part in the Environmental Water Management and Conservation Solutions category with their project titled "An Innovative Fluorescence-Based (+) Chemosensory Prototype for the Sensitive Detection of Cu²⁺ Ions in Aqueous Environments: Synthesis, Modeling, and Prototyping".

Supervised by EMU Faculty of Arts and Sciences, Department of Chemistry academic staff member Prof. Dr. Huriye İcil, HUNEC 2025 team consists of Department of Chemistry PhD students Seval İkizoğlu, Elif Doğru and Süleyman Soyel and, Department of Chemistry undergraduate students Tuğba Bayırlı and Ayni Öztürk.

In their statement, HUNEC 2025 team said; Copper (Cu²⁺) ions are essential metals for both human health and the environment. However, a deficiency can result in Menkes disease, while an excess may contribute to disorders such as Alzheimer's, Wilson's, and Parkinson's diseases. For this reason, accurately detecting these ions is highly important. Despite the critical role of watersoluble chemosensors in identifying Cu2ions, which pose toxicity risks to global water systems, very few such sensors currently exist. The aim of the project is to develop a highly sensitive method for detecting Cu² ions in aqueous environments. The HUNEC 2025 team also plans to commercialize their prototype and seek patent protection as part of the project's future goals'

A PROTOCOL IS SIGNED

EMU AND ADANA ALPARSLAN TÜRKEŞ SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY UNIVERSITY SIGN A PROTOCOL FOR ORGANIZING JOINT CONGRESS

Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) and Adana Alparslan Türkeş Science and Technology University signed a protocol for organizing a joint congress. The protocol was signed on Friday, 25 April 2025 at 11:30 a.m. at EMU Rector's Office by EMU Rector Prof. Dr. Hasan Kılıç and the International Researchers, Statisticians and Young Statisticians Congress (IRSYSC) 2025 Congress Organizing Committee Chairperson Assoc. With the signed protocol, it is aimed to co-organize the annual International Researchers, Statisticians, and Young Statisticians Congress (IRSYSC) in 2025 through a collaboration between Eastern Mediterranean University and Adana Alparslan Türkeş Science and Technology University.

Prof. Dr. Kılıç expressed his hope that the congress would meet the expectations of both institutions and focus on scientific innovation.

Prof. Dr. Gündüz expressed their contentment on signing the protocol with EMU and that the said congress is a prestigious event held especially in the field of statistics in Türkiye. Providing more information about the congress, Assoc. Prof. Dr. Gündüz shared their excitement to be organizing the 9th edition of the congress in collaboration with EMU.


CHAMBER OF INTERIOR ARCH

The said exhibition was curated by EMU Art and Design Center Executive Board Member Zehra Şonya.

"Today, we will have the Chance to Explore the Works of Günay Güzelgün"

Delivering the opening speech of the event, Zehra Şonya said; "In celebration of 15 April World Art Day, we are honoured to present another event we aim to turn into a tradition. Today, we have the chance to explore the works of Günay Güzelgün". Providing information on Güzelgün's artistic career, Şonya underlined that a large number of artworks exhibited at the event would be introduced with art enthusiasts for the first time ever.

"Vivid Sketches Connecting Recollection and Memory"

Chairperson of EMU Art and Design Center, Prof. Dr. Ümit İnatçı also delivered a speech welcoming the participants. Offering reflections on Günay Güzelgün's artistic approach, Prof. Dr. İnatçı described her works as "vivid sketches that aim to connect recollection and memory" and emphasized





that these pieces can be read not just as visual art but also as a form of written expression. Interpreting the works from an artistic standpoint, Prof. Dr. İnatçı highlighted that the artist constructs a sense of existence shaped by ontological concerns, with her art bearing traces of her village, community, and cultural roots.

"Our Greatest Drawback is the Lack of Preserving the Memory of Local Artists"

Delivering a speech on behalf of EMAA, EMAA Executive Board Member and Artist Nurtane Karagil referred to Günay Güzelgün as one of the important figures in her childhood. Noting that it's rare to come across artists in everyday life in Cyprus, Karagil highlighted Günay Güzelgün as someone who brings her art into unique dimensions and spaces. She spoke about the difficulty of the creative process, saying, "It's very meaningful for us that Günay Güzelgün's creativity continues without fading." Karagil also emphasized the importance of cultural memory, stating, "As artists who have spent years trying to reach wider audiences, one of our biggest shortcomings has been our inability to preserve the memory of local artists". She concluded by expressing her gratitude to the participants and everyone who contributed to the event.

"One of the Wings is Science, the other is Art"

In his address, EMU Rector Prof. Dr. Hasan Kılıç emphasized that a special event was being held in celebration of World Art Day.





Noting the importance of the exhibition in filling the artistic gap in Cyprus, Prof. Dr. Kılıç underscored that EMU is making significant strides not only in the scientific field but also in the arts. Comparing a university to a bird with two wings, one for science and the other for art, Prof. Dr. Kılıç shared that he was a student of Günay Güzelgün, which made the event particularly meaningful for him. Prof. Dr. Kılıç highlighted the university's commitment to the arts, stating, "We've been increasing efforts in areas that we felt were lacking. The recent Poet's Day event is an example of this. We believe that interest in art and artistic activities should grow". He concluded by reaffirming that the EMU Art and Design Center will continue to play a crucial role in addressing the artistic void.

Following the opening speeches, the event continued with EMU Rector Prof. Dr. Hasan Kılıç presenting Günay Güzelgün a bouquet and the opening of the exhibition for the visitors.

PROF. DR. OSMAN M. KARATEPE RELEASED A STATEMENT ON BEHALF OF EMU-ATAUM ON 23 APRIL

On behalf of Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) Atatürk Research and Application Center (ATAUM), Prof. Dr. Osman M. Karatepe released a statement on the occasion of 23 April – National Sovereignty and Children's Day. The statement reads as follows:

"23 April 1920, the inauguration date of the Grand National Assembly of Türkiye (TBMM), was declared National Sovereignty and Children's Day by Gazi Mustafa Kemal Atatürk who dedicated this day to children all around the world as a symbol of the value attributed to their rights and well-being. Observed annually as a national holiday in both Türkiye and the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus, this date also marks the formal declaration of the establishment of a new state founded on the principle of national sovereignty.

This special day was originally observed as a "National Holiday" between the 23rd of April 1920 and 1st of November 1922. With the abolition of the sultanate, it was





renamed as the "National Sovereignty Day." In 1927, following a proposal by the Himaye-i Etfal Society—known today as the Social Services and Child Protection Agency under the Prime Ministry—23rd of April was also designated as "Children's Day", thus establishing its identity as a celebration dedicated to children.

In 1935, this day referred to with various names has begun to be celebrated as the "23 April National Sovereignty and Children's Day". Atatürk attached great significance to these celebrations and actively took part in the ceremonies throughout his lifetime. By dedicating this momentous day in Turkish history to the children he cherished, he ensured its remembrance and celebration each year.

As we celebrate the 105th anniversary of the Grand National Assembly of Türkiye, we honour the cherished memory of our Great Leader Gazi Mustafa Kemal Atatürk, his comrades-in-arms, and our martyrs with profound respect, love, and longing. On the occasion of 23 April, National Sovereignty and Children's Day, we extend our heartfelt wishes to all children around the world, hoping that this meaningful day brings health, happiness, and peace to every child across the globe".

ELIO CASSARÀ PAINTING EXHIBITION

The 'Elio Cassarà Exhibition' featuring Italian painter Cassarà's art work, organized in collaborations with Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) and Sicily Contemporary Art Museum "Museum" will open its doors to art enthusiasts on Friday, 2 May 2025 at 07:30 p.m. at Ayhan Mentes Exhibition Hall located in the Rauf Raif Denktaş Culture and Congress Center. To be held in coordination of EMU Art and Design Center, the inauguration of the event will be carried out by EMU Rector Prof. Dr. Hasan Kılıç. The exhibition consisting of late period work of the artist will be open for visits until 12 May 2025.

First Time in Cyprus Born in 1974 in the town of Mazara del Vallo, Italy, Elio Cassarà has primarily pursued his artistic career in Italy, Germany, and Russia. His works are featured in various public and private collections, as well as museums across

several cities, especially in Italy. Now, for the first time, the artist is holding an exhibition in Cyprus.

The artist's works, known for their vibrant light effects and the expressive force of colours in landscape depiction, have an abstract artistic style. The critical essay featured in the exhibition catalogue has been authored by art historian and critic Tommaso Evangelista.

"An Inner Poetics"

The Curator of the exhibition and the Chairperson of EMU Arts and Design Center Ümit İnatçı made remarks about the event, saying; "In Elio Cassarà's work, we observe how crystallized, irregular clusters of colour, detached from objects, attempt to form their own physical structures within white, the



ultimate expression of colour. Various chromatic areas, ranging from large to small, solid colour planes, and transparent vibrating focuses appear to both merge into and shine through the white. While these painted forms present themselves as visual phenomena, they also evolve into a poetics of internal, spiritual oscillations".
