# TOTAL OF 30 EMU SCHOLARS - 25 OF WHOM ARE TURKISH CYPRIOTS - FEATURED ON THE 'MOST INFLUENTIAL SCIENTISTS IN THE WORLD' LIST, BOTH IN SINGLE YEAR AND CAREER LONG DATABASES

On 19 September 2025, 30 academics from Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) were named among the world's most highly cited researchers in the "Most Influential Scientists in the World" list. This recognition came from a study led by Stanford University in the USA, with a team of American and Dutch scientists. The fact that nearly all of these EMU researchers are citizens of the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus (TRNC) makes this accomplishment a tremendous source of pride for both the university, as a public institution, and the country.

The list was compiled using Scopus data with support from Elsevier B.V., a leading academic publisher. A total of 236,314 researchers worldwide ranked among the top 2%. Compared to last year, this year saw an increase of 40,062 scientists on the list. It includes both researchers with the highest citations in a 'Single Year' (2024 calendar year) and those with the highest citations over their entire careers 'Career Long'.

The total number of researchers from universities in the Republic of Türkiye on the list increased by 55 from last year, reaching 1,589. Similarly, the number of researchers from Southern Cyprus grew by 28, bringing the total to 120.

#### 5 EMU Academics Listed within Top 100 in their Fields: Prof. Dr. Karatepe – 12th Most Influential Scientist in the World in the Field of Tourism

Prof. Dr. Osman M. Karatepe achieved significant recognition in the list of the world's most influential scientists, ranking 12th globally in the 'Career Long' category in Tourism. This accomplishment earned Prof. Dr. Karatepe the top spot in his field in both Türkiye and the TRNC. Furthermore, in the 2025 'Single Year' list, Prof. Dr. Karatepe was ranked 14th worldwide in his field. In the overall annual ranking across all disciplines, he placed 2,377th globally and 12th among Turkish scientists.

Another EMU academic to achieve a top 100 global ranking in their field on the list of the world's most influential scientists is Assoc. Prof. Dr. Ali Övgün. In the 'Single Year' list for 'Nuclear & Particle Physics', Assoc. Prof. Dr. Övgün ranked 83rd worldwide, a remarkable accomplishment that earned him the top position in his field in both Türkiye and the TRNC. Assoc. Prof. Dr. Övgün is also featured in the 'Career Long' list, where he again holds the number one spot in his field in Türkiye and the TRNC.



# FUTURE DOCTORS RECEIVE THEIR WHITE COATS AT EMU

Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU), Dr. Fazıl Küçük Medicine Faculty and Marmara University International Joint Medicine Program's 2025-2026 Opening and White Coat Ceremony was held on Monday, 22 September 2025 at 10:00 a.m. at Rauf Raif Denktaş Culture and Congress Center

The ceremony was attended by President of EMU Board of Trustees (VYK) Dr. Erdal Özcenk, EMU Rector Prof. Dr. Hasan Kılıç, VYK Members Beyhan Gürgöze and İsmail Güneş Güneşoğlu, Vice Rectors Prof. Dr. Osman M. 


# EMU AND DAU-SEN SIGNS SUPPLEMENTARY PROTOCOL ON RENEWABLE ENERGY

In addition to the agreement signed on 1 July 2022, between Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) and the EMU Academic Staff Union (DAU-SEN), a supplementary protocol was signed covering the installation of renewable energy systems and related arrangements at the DAU-SEN Local located in the Department of Mechanical Engineering. The signing ceremony was recently held at the Rector's Office, where the agreement was signed by EMU Rector Prof. Dr. Hasan Kılıç and Chair of DAU-SEN Assoc. Prof. Dr. Ercan Hoskara.

Present during the signing session were; EMU Vice Rector for Academic Affairs Prof. Dr. Osman M. Karatepe, Director of the EMU Institute for Advanced Technology Research and Development Assoc. Prof. Dr. Davut Solyalı and EMU Rector's Office Coordinator Assoc. Prof. Dr. Tolga Çelik.

Under this supplementary protocol, DAU-SEN will establish a renewable energy system integrated into the Electric Vehicle Development Building to fully meet the annual electricity consumption of the DAU-SEN Local located in EMU Department of Mechanical Engineering. It was also stated that, in addition to the installation, DAU-SEN will contribute to the production of a prototype electric vehicle charging unit at the EMU Electric Vehicle Development Center.

# EMU CAMPUS CARRIES OUT EXTENSIVE PREPARATIONS FOR THE NEW ACADEMIC YEAR

Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) is undertaking an extensive preparation process across the campus to welcome students for the 2025–2026 Academic Year. Ahead of the new academic year, painting, maintenance, and landscaping activities are continuing at various locations across the campus without pause.

Within the framework of the work carried out by the EMU Technical Affairs Directorate, Environment Affairs Directorate and Cleaning Services Unit, painting and maintenance work is being conducted in academic and administrative buildings, social areas, and sports facilities, while landscaping improvements are taking place in green spaces. In addition, cleaning efforts across the entire campus have been intensified to ensure a more comfortable and hygienic environment for students and staff.



### "Campus Undergoes Regular Maintenance and Landscape Work"

Murat Aytekin, a foreperson at the EMU Environment Affairs Directorate, made remarks on the work being carried around the EMU campus, stating that the campus undergoes regular maintenance and landscape work. Noting that the campus produces nearly 100,000 saplings annually, Aytekin said that regular weeding and pruning are consistently carried out. Highlighting preparations for the upcoming academic year, he emphasized that cleaning efforts are being prioritized. Aytekin also pointed out that tall trees along roads, which could pose risks to students, have been trimmed, and irrigation of green areas continues.

Zehra Çelikel, a foreperson at the EMU Cleaning Services

Unit, stated that the Unit employs 112 personnel members who are assigned to various buildings and faculties, alongside contracted personnel who work exclusively in the dormitories. Çelikel emphasized that all employees receive annual training on cleaning and hygiene, and that daily inspections are conducted to prioritize the health of students and staff. Moreover, Çelikel added that campus waste is regularly collected, roads are cleaned with vehicles, and the overall goal is to maintain a hygienic environment. She concluded by stating that the campus is fully prepared for the new academic year with a hygienic and clean setting.

EMU Construction, Technical and Plumbing Works Unit Director Sami Ömer noted that the most intensive preparations for the new academic year are being carried out in the dormitories. Alongside dorm maintenance, the infrastructure team is actively working on tasks such as road painting, sidewalk repairs, and renewing the




#### A Close Look into EMU through the Campus Tour
