Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) Vice a social and cultural tour was also organized in Rector for Promotion and Institutional Communication Prof. Dr. Mustafa Tümer participated in the 9th International EMI Entrepreneurship and Social Sciences Congress held in Tashkent, the capital city of Uzbekistan.

Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU), Faculty of Dentistry was represented at the Thalassaemia International Federation (TIF) 2023 Kuala Lumpur – Malaysia Conference. EMU Faculty of Dentistry Vice Dean and academic staff member "Beta-Thalassaemia Specialist" and scientist Prof. Dr. Şükrü Tüzmen delivered "Molecular Diagnostics in Beta-Thalassaemia and Sickle Cell Anemia: Experience from Past to Present" presentation at the Thalassaemia International Federation (TIF) 2023 Kuala Lumpur – Malaysia Conference.

Prof. Dr. Tüzmen was invited to the "2023 TIF International Conference on Thalassaemia and Other Haemoglobinopathies" event organized by Thalassaemia International Federation (TIF) in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia. In the said event, topics such as genetic disorder research carried out with advanced molecular methods, gene therapy, blood transfusion, diagnosis and monitoring techniques, epidemiology, hematopoietic stem cell transplantation, complications in

liver, infections, management of iron overload, lifestyle struggles of patients, new developments in treatment, thalassaemia cases nonaffiliated to transfusion and psychosocial problems were discussed.

The conference served as an important platform that brought scientists together who are experts in their fields, discussing innovations on issues such as the evaluation and interpretation of measurements within the scope of new applications, the latest professional and scientific developments, and discussing the results. Recent developments in the field of state-of-art genetic studies were shared during this phenomenal scientific conference.

Within the scope of continuing the sustainability of joint studies with the Thalassaemia International Federation (TIF) academic members and thalassaemia patients, Prof. Dr. Şükrü Tüzmen exchanged views on collaborative studies.

In this respect, Prof. Dr. Hoskara noted that they had organized four other book meetings in January, March, April and May, respectively. Stating that EMU Press intends to transform these events into a book fair, Prof. Dr. Hoskara said that the process sadly has been slowed down due to the hitches experienced in 2023. Expressing that the latest book meeting is the fifth event of the series, Prof. Dr. Hoşkara thanked especially DAU-SEN and everyone who supported and contributed to the realization of the event.

Invited to the stage as the honorary guest of the event, EMU Faculty of Architecture's retired academic personnel member Prof. Dr. Türkan Ülusu Uraz delivered an educational speech on the meaning and importance of sketches in architecture and design, sharing her valuable experiences with art-lovers and audience from the architecture sector



After the speeches, the opening session of the exhibition sponsored by DAÜ-SEN that featured Kamiar Yazdani's sketches was held. The event continued with a cocktail party where author / artist Kamiar Yazdani signed her book.

The "Lame Indecisiveness: The Story of Sketches" book by Yazdani consists of 52 sketches drawn from architectural structures mainly from Cyprus, Europe, Turkey and Iran covering the years between 2015 and 2023. The book examines the existence of lines as external realities, notion of light in architecture as well as the formation and lack of this notion. The stories that come along with the sketches aim to create much deeper meanings or concepts and, to reflect the inner and emotional anxiety of the sketch artist while drawing the sketches.

EMU CYPRUS POLICY CENTER REPRESENTED IN KYRGYZSTAN

Eastern Mediterranean University Cyprus Policy Center (EMU-CPC) was represented at the MANAS Forum 2023, held at Kyrgyz-Turkish Manas University, with the main theme of 'The Rise of Regionalism in Global Politics: the Organization of Turkic States.' Assist. Prof. Dr. Devrim Şahin, Research Specialist at EMU-CPC, and Aybaniz Huseyn, PhD student in EMU Faculty of Business and Economics, Department of Political Science and International Relations presented their joint work at the MANAS Forum 2023 held in Bishkekm the capital city of Kvrgvzstan.

In the 'Karabakh' session of the conference, Assist. Prof. Dr. Şahin and Huseyn presented their study titled 'A Regional Outlook on Turkic Movement Trends in Northern Iran,' examining the impact of regional tensions on countries in the region such as Turkey, Azerbaijan, and Iran. Assist. Prof. Dr. Şahin and Huseyn warned not only Tehran but also Ankara and Baku to avoid any form of adventurous policies emphasizing that any instability in one of these three countries could trigger adverse effects within the other two countries.

EMU-PDRAM ORGANIZES IN-SERVICE TRAINING AT SOS CHILDREN'S VILLAGE



Within the scope of the collaboration protocol between Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) and SOS Children's Village Association, EMU Psychological Counseling, Guidance and Research Center (PDRAM) organized an in-service training for mothers and aunts who are caregivers in the Family Based System at the SOS Children's Village and, the youth advisors who work at the SOS Youth House. The training titled "Psychological Health from Childhood to

Youth House. The training titled "Psychological Health from Childhood to Youth: Supporting without Stigma" was delivered by EMU-PDRAM psychologists at SOS Children's Village Emotion Workshop.

The training consisted of topics such as Psychological Health in Childhood and Youth, The Importance of Psychological Well-being on Psychological Health, Possible Developmental Difficulties Observed in Childhood and Adolescence Periods, Individual and Social Taboos Affecting the Attitude of Seeking Psychological Support, Stigma towards Seeking Psychological Support, Stereotypes, Prejudice and Discrimination, Children's Rights in Mental Health and, Caregiving Practices that Support Psychological Resilience Starting from Childhood.

At the end of the workshop, participants were presented certificates of attendance by SOS Children's Village and EMU-PRDAM. Underlining the fact that EMU's importance services towards society and non-governmental organizations, EMU-PDRAM Directorate noted that EMU-PDRAM is to continue its contributions on such platforms. Especially within the scope of the collaboration protocol signed with the SOS Children's Village, apart from such kind of in-service trainings, it has been stated that support towards children and youngsters who live at the SOS Children's Village are expected to continue in 2024.





In the said conference, EMU Arts and Sciences Faculty, Psychology Department academic staff member Prof. Dr. Ilhan Raman delivered a presentation titled "Celebrating Neurodiversity: Dyslexia".

Delivered both in English and Turkish, the conference that opened its doors to everyone was held at the Central Lecture Halls. During the

event attended by many, Prof. Dr. Raman aimed to celebrate dyslexia within the framework of neurodiversity by touching on the myths, misunderstandings and general lack of information on dyslexia which is defined as a specific learning disability. Noting her contentedness on contributing the event organized by Psychology Club students, Prof. Dr. Raman stated that the conference focused on cognitive skills and reading patterns that are assumed to be used during typical reading development compared to dyslexia. Being a Cognitive Psychologist who takes interest in the application of theoretical principles in special education

needs, Prof. Dr. Raman expressed that, starting with multidisciplinary research, the Turkish psychology world has a long way to understand what dyslexia is and to create awareness on the condition.

Meliha Önder, a retired primary school teacher who has worked in the education sector for 38 years, attended the event as a guest and shared her experiences on literacy acquisition and academic success. Önder emphasized that education starts with love which forms the basis of self-confidence and that success is a result of self-confidence.


