The Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) Faculty of Tourism has achieved remarkable success in the 2023 EduRank

university ranking. EduRank evaluated 14,131 universities worldwide based on scientific publications and citations across

183 countries. The EMU Faculty of Tourism claimed the top place in Tourism and Hospitality within Cyprus, marking a significant achievement. At the same time, the university claimed the 24th place, highlighting its impact across Europe.

EduRank's evaluation not only considers academic achievements but also the visibility of the faculty and the popularity of its graduates. This accomplishment by the EMU Faculty of Tourism reflects not only its outstanding performance in the academic field but also its overall recognition and the impact of its graduates in the industry. EduRank incorporates non-academic prominent features and indicators of graduate popularity in its overall rankings. It does not alter data provided by universities for ranking purposes or data that could change a university's quality without actual improvements.

Prof. Dr. Ali Öztüren, Dean of the EMU Faculty of Tourism, highlighted their significant

achievement in Tourism and Hospitality, ranking 1st in Cyprus and 24th in Europe among the Best Universities. Prof. Dr. Öztüren emphasized the substantial importance of such rankings in the business world, stating that students and graduates facing competitive job markets gain significant advantages by graduating from the EMU Faculty of Tourism, which offers the top tourism and hospitality programs in Cyprus and ranks amongst the top 24 in Europe.

Prof. Dr. Öztüren also put forth that employers tend to prefer individuals graduating from higher education institutions ranked high, noting that their position in these rankings is a result of accumulated knowledge, experience, and efforts over time. Furthermore, he expressed gratitude the Faculty of Tourism academic staff members for providing high-quality education and research with high impact value contributing both to academia and the industry.

“RIGHTS TO PERSONAL DATA PROTECTION IN TRNC” WORKSHOP HOSTED BY EMU

The December meeting organized by Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) Faculty of Law in collaboration with the Personal Data Protection Board was hosted by EMU. The event took place on Friday, 1 December 2023 at 10:00 a.m. at EMU Senate Meeting Hall. Prior to the meeting, “Rights regarding the Protection of Personal Data in TRNC” workshop which focused on the protection of personal data right as well as other related rights was held. EMU Rector Prof. Dr. Hasan Kılıç, Vice Rector Prof. Dr. Mustafa Tümer, Law Faculty’s Acting Dean Assoc. Prof. Dr. Arzu Alibaba and faculty academic staff members were present in the said workshop. Welcoming everyone during his speech delivered at the beginning of the meeting, Prof. Dr. Kılıç wished that the workshop would be beneficial. Moderated by the Chair of the Personal Data Protection Board Assist. Prof. Dr. Kaan Kutlay, the workshop was held with the participation of specialists from the EMU Faculty of Law and Technopark.

Presentation on “Relation between the Right to Information and Personal Data”

EMU Faculty of Law Vice Dean and Personal Data Protection Board member Assoc. Prof. Dr. Demet Çelik Ulusoy stated that the goal of organizing the workshop is to bring together academic and technical expertise in the context of the right to personal data protection. EMU Faculty of Law academic staff member Assist. Prof. Dr. Can Azer who had contributed the preparation process of the Right to Personal Data Protection Act (ref. no. 89/2007), attended the event with

his presentation titled “Relation between the Right to Information and Personal Data”. Focusing of the rights to information and personal data protection, Assist. Prof. Dr. Azer addressed the issue of public authorities avoiding providing information by citing personal data as a reason for not sharing information and data. Conveying the connection between the right to access personal data and right to information, Assist. Prof. Dr. Azer also provided explanations on the concept of overriding public interest in the context of freedom of expression and the protection of personal data.

Discussion on “Protection of Personal Data within the scope of Right of Personality”

In the event, EMU Faculty of Law Civil Law Major academic staff member Assist. Prof. Dr. Emine Koçano Rodoslu delivered a presentation titled “Protection of Personal Data within the scope of Right of Personality”. In her speech, Assist. Prof. Dr. Rodoslu examined the protection of personal data in the context of personality rights, focusing on the law of obligations and civil law. In her presentation, Assist. Prof. Dr. Rodoslu emphasized that the right to the protection of personal data is a value of personality rights and pointed out considerations that should be taken into account in cases of conflict between the right to the protection of personal data and other values related to personality rights, such as freedom of the press and the privacy of private life. Particularly addressing the development of the right to the protection of

personal data in conjunction with freedom of the press, Assist. Prof. Dr. Rodoslu discussed the concept of overriding public interest, emphasizing that the primary legal basis for the processing of personal data is consent and elaborating on the conditions under which consent would be considered valid.

“Data Transfer and Data Security”

During the workshop, Necdet İcil, the Chair of the Board of Directors of the Technopark, who made significant contributions to the preparation of Law (ref. no. 89/2007), provided information to the Personal Data Protection Board on “Data Transfer and Data Security” topics. İcil drew attention to the circumstances under which data transfer occurs and explained the legislative process of Law (ref. no. 89/2007). In his speech, referencing European Union regulations, İcil highlighted the lack of adequate attention to data security. He emphasized the importance of data protection officers and spoke about impermeability tests and data security systems in relation to data security. Following the workshop, the Personal Data Protection Board held its regular December meeting hosted by EMU. The workshop began with an opening speech by Assist. Prof. Dr. Kaan Kutlay, the Chair of the Personal Data Protection Board. The former chair of the board, Hürol Mear, and Assist. Prof. Dr. Raziye Nevzat, a former member of the board, also participated in the meeting to exchange views with the new chair and members.



FACULTY OF TOURISM STUDENTS ENHANCE THEIR KNOWLEDGE IN ROBOTICS, ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE, AND SERVICE AUTOMATION

Students enrolled in the Council of Higher Education (YÖK) approved Distance Education (Online) Master's Program in Hotel Management at the Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) Faculty of Tourism expanded their knowledge by participating in a prestigious online seminar. As part of the Tourism 4.0 course, Prof. Dr. Stanislav Ivanov, upon invitation by Assoc. Prof. Dr. Seden Doğan, delivered a comprehensive presentation on Robotics, Artificial Intelligence, and Service Automation (RAISA), imparting crucial information to the students. Engaging in an interactive Q&A session,

Prof. Dr. Ivanov directly addressed the students, offering them the opportunity to become pioneers in technology through this experience.

In her opening speech at the beginning of the class, Assoc. Prof. Dr. Seden Doğan mentioned that they had prepared an interactive platform for students to explore the future technology. 3 DECEMBER INTERNATIONAL DAY OF PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES MESSAGE FROM RECTOR PROF. DR. HASAN KILIÇ

Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) Rector Prof. Dr. Hasan Kılıç released a statement on the occasion of 3 December – International Day of Persons with Disabilities. Prof. Dr. Kılıç's statement reads as follows:

“In 1992, United Nations attributed 3rd of December as the International Day of Persons with Disabilities with the aim of understanding the perceptions of people with disabilities and their struggles in order to create public consciousness and awareness.

Unfortunately, the studies on the life quality of these individuals are insufficient in our country. People with disabilities face many difficulties and cannot adapt to life due to the present conditions. This is an issue that we should all focus on and provide solutions for the problems. Of course, it is important to create awareness on the 3rd of December for these members of our society. However, we need to work every day to improve the quality of

life of individuals with disabilities and to eliminate their problems and existing inequalities.

EMU, as an institution that closely follows the latest developments all around the world, had done numerous work in order to obtain a more disabled-friendly campus during the previous administrations' service periods. Moreover, EMU organized many seminars, events, workshops with the aim of creating public awareness and educating the community on such topics. As a state university, it is one of our duties to lead the society and show the right path on such important topics like this one. We started to create the necessary infrastructure a long time ago to create an environment where persons with disabilities can easily access every point on our campus by eliminating their obstacles.

Moving our university forward is among our most important goals. In previous administration periods, the

The Atatürk Research Center, a pioneering institution in the field of the Republic's History

studies, has announced that this valuable work titled 'History of the Republic of Turkey,' which is the result of intense effort and labor, is a gift to the 100th anniversary of the Republic of Turkey.

Initiated in 2015, the work saw the participation of Assist. Prof. Dr. Turgay Bülent Göktürk, the Head of the EMU Atatürk Research and Application Center, who contributed by preparing sections on Turkish-Greek Relations, the Cyprus Issue, and the Aegean Problem. Assist. Prof. Dr. Göktürk

mentioned in his statement that being part of the three-volume book on the history of the Republic published by the Atatürk Research Center, which continues its work decisively in the formation of modern Turkey following the path shown by Atatürk, is the most comprehensive work put forth for the centenary of the Republic. Assist. Prof. Dr. Göktürk also emphasized the honor of having contributed to such a meaningful work and expressed that he would always carry this pride.

THE AWARD-WINNING PROFESSOR FROM FLORIDA UNIVERSITY, WHICH IS AMONG THE TOP 5 STATE UNIVERSITIES IN THE USA, MEETING WITH THE FACULTY OF ARCHITECTURE STUDENTS

Within the scope of the "Design and Construct" workshop organized by the EMU Faculty of Architecture Interdisciplinary Studies in Built Environment Center (ISBE), renowned architect and academic Prof. Dr. Charlie Hailey from Florida University is meeting with EMU students.

Prof. Dr. Hailey, who has received numerous awards including "Teacher/Scientist of the Year Award" and is the author of six important books introducing multidisciplinary approaches to the built environment, will be the first Fulbright Specialist to visit Cyprus in 15 years.

As part of the project, Prof. Dr. Charlie Hailey will design an 'outdoor learning module' for ecological literacy with the students of the Faculty of Architecture. This module, once designed, will be constructed with the students and donated to Yeniboğaziçi Primary School as part of the faculty's social

responsibility mission. The project, titled "Experiential Learning: Design for Public Benefit," authored by Assoc. Prof. Dr. Ceren Boğaç, who is also a board member of the ISBE Center, has been accepted by the United States Fulbright Specialist Program. Scheduled to take place from December 4th to 14th, 2023, the workshop aims to provide a unique 'design-and-implement' experience for the Faculty of Architecture students.

Sharing information about the project, Assoc. Prof. Dr. Boğaç stated, "The aim of this workshop is to actively involve students in the learning process by allowing them to apply their design knowledge to real-world scenarios, bridging the gap between theory and practice. Additionally, we aim to develop a comprehensive understanding of design for public benefit. This project also aims to promote ecological literacy and sustainability, creating a successful model that can be

expanded and adopted in other educational institutions." Expressing gratitude to the ISBE Executive Board Members, as well as the Faculty Dean, technical staff, and EMU administration for their support, Assoc. Prof. Dr. Boğaç added that as a center, they will continue to provide significant experiences and opportunities to the students of the Faculty of Architecture through similar international collaborations and projects.

ISBE Center President Prof. Dr. Kokan Grchev highlighted that this workshop, which creates an interdisciplinary platform for critical and conceptual discussions among various disciplines within the structure, integrating research as a method of teaching and practice, aiming to expand the boundaries of knowledge in the built environment through communication and collaboration, reflects the vision, mission, and goals of the center. Prof. Dr. Grchev stated, "The



project aims not only to embrace an interdisciplinary approach combined with innovation and a culture of experimentation but also to benefit a wide spectrum of society, not just in the field of architecture."

Dean of the EMU Faculty of Architecture Prof. Dr. Resmiye Alpar Atun emphasized the importance of international collaborations in line with the inevitable unity of change and design. She highlighted that this project serves as a stepping stone for future collaborations, ensuring that steps will be taken for students to acquire all the necessary skills to become graduates who are integrated with the world, able to embrace change, and carry it to further points.

'DIABETES AND EXERCISE' SEMINAR AND WORKSHOP TO BE HELD AT EMU

Within the cooperation of Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) Community Involvement Center and the Faculty of Health Sciences, a seminar and a workshop on 'Diabetes and Exercise' will be held on the occasion of 5 December – International Volunteer Day.

The event will take place on Tuesday, 5 December, 2023 at 02:30 p.m. at EMU Faculty of Tourism (TH 107 seminar room). EMU Faculty of Health Sciences Dean Prof. Dr. Mehtap Malkoç will deliver the opening speech of the event where specialist physiotherapist Ayşen Karaman will do a workshop titled "Exercises for Diabetes".

According to the statement released by EMU Faculty of Health Sciences; Prediabetes, defined as the stage preceding the development of diabetes, a serious chronic disease that is on the rise globally and in our country, refers to situations where the blood sugar level is above the normal range but has not yet reached the diagnostic thresholds for diabetes. Exercise acts as a very effective medicine in patients with prediabetes and diabetes who constitute a significant risk group. Center for Application and Research for Healthy

Life (SAYMER) operating under EMU Faculty of Health Sciences offers services with experts in their fields with the intention of contributing public health. As a result of the assessments in this context, off-charge clinical pilates sessions will be organized for prediabetic individuals (people with borderline blood sugar) in order to prevent the development of diabetes. Moreover, individuals who do not have diabetes will also be able to participate in the free pilates trial session on the occasion of the special day.

EMU Community Involvement Center Chair Assist. Prof. Dr. Nazenin Ruso Kandemir stated that huge steps are being taken in terms of public health with the cooperation of EMU and added that they are waiting for everyone who wants to take a step towards a healthy life to this seminar, where critical information that will shape health will be shared.
